I have the honour to bring to your notice, in this view of recommendation for a compassionate gratuity, the servant Mr. Andula bin Saleh, who has served 11 years in the ~~Government~~ in the Native Department and who has now been obliged, owing to ill-health, to retire from Government Service.

M. Andula retired on the 1st May and with the two months' leave, to which he was entitled on that date, his period of service was brought up to 11 years; he was transferred from the Imperial British East Africa Company's service on July 1st 1905.

I would observe that his retirement is solely due to ill-health, and his salary has been less than £100 per annum; he was ~~actually~~ originally paid £45 per month in 1899-10. His case would therefore supersede, be suitable for a compassionate
