Telegram. The Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the
Secretary of State for the Colonies.

Received, Colonial Office, 2.29 p.m. 7th November, 1910.

No. 209. Your telegram 25th October. Reports just received officer
in charge of Turkana point to serious danger of general
break along border possibly affecting materially numbers in
district unless absolutely I am not hampered by Uganda district dealing
with situation. Present position is that after pacification we
were administering Turkana; they were raided by Uganda Bak
Karamojo, who committed horrible atrocities, massacred large
numbers; reprisals took place, a great many raiders killed
during retreat. Kraals raided may have been in territory of
Uganda technically speaking, but of course that makes no differ-
ence whatever. These tribes do not respect boundary at present.
Turkana now ask for ~~us~~ join in attacking ^{us} ~~Uganda~~ ^{sab} or at any rate
protection from such raids in future. Quite unable to comply
unless I have free hand; could only result in weakness of our
prestige. Position of our officer rendered dangerous. Would
ask that administration of Uganda send one company of troops
with military officer accompanied by administrative officer
take charge district; could be sent via Nakuru Baringo to the
scene (of) disturbance where we would be glad to co-operate;
proposal made to be preferred but if Uganda unwilling (?) would
be prepared to arrange with our troops establish district there
but it must be included in jurisdiction of our district covering
the whole of our territory as well as possible. In regard to

urgently required owing to my departure.
