(2) Nothing in any rules made under this Order shall affect the right of the holder of a currency note to obtain payment thereof in accordance with the provisions of the Order of 1905.

2.—(1) Rules made under this Order shall come into force in East Africa on such day as may be fixed by the Governor of East Africa by proclamation, and subject as hereinafter provided shall extend only to East Africa:

Provided that the Commissioner of Uganda may by proclamation made with the approval of a Secretary of State provide that any such rules shall extend to Uganda, and if a proclamation is made to that effect those rules shall as from the date fixed by the proclamation extend to Uganda.

(2) All rules made under this Order shall be judicially noticed, and shall have effect as if contained in this Order.

3. This Order shall be read as one with the Order of 1905 as amended by the Order of 1906, and may be cited as the East Africa and Uganda (Currency) Order, 1910.

And the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury and the Right Honourable the Earl of Crew, K.G., one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, are to give the necessary directions herein.
