Sir:-

I am directed by Secretary Sir E. Grey to acknowledge the receipt of your letter 18935/1910 of the 3rd ultimo respecting the mainland properties of the Sultan of Zanzibar.

I am to inform you in reply that Sir E. Grey concurs in the course proposed by the Earl of Crewe for determining what properties may be held to belong to His Highness in his private capacity and what can be recognised as public lands.

In informing His Majesty's Agent and Consul-General of Lord Crewe's proposal, Sir E. Grey will instruct Mr. Clarke to take steps for the appointment by the Zanzibar Government of a judicial or legal officer who together with the officer appointed by the Government of the East Africa Protectorate will be charged with the task of examining those portions of Mr. Hallis's report which the Governor of the
