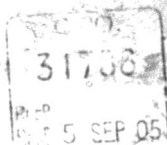

With reference to Your Lordship's despatch No. 91 of this series of the 17th. Instant, on the subject of the troubles in German East Africa, I have the honour to report that the decision of the Imperial Government is announced to despatch 150 Marines and several machine guns to East Africa, and that besides the Cruiser "Pustard", which is already on the spot, the Cruiser "Seeadler" has been ordered thither from the South Sea and another small Cruiser, probably the "Thetis", from the Far East.
