Sir:-

With reference to your letter 51821/1910 of the 21st September regarding the claims of the German East Africa Company to land in the Protectorate of Mombasa. With your directed by Secretary Sir Edward Grey to state, for the information of the Earl of Crewe, that in the last note which was received from the German Ambassador in 1907 on this question, His Excellency stated that the German East Africa Company had declined to submit their claim to the Court at Mombasa and had requested the German Government to put it forward diplomatically. Count Metternich further stated that the claim was being examined and that he would address a further communication to Sir E. Grey on the subject.

No communication has since been received from His Excellency and Sir E. Grey proposes, subject to the concurrence of Lord Crewe, to inform Count
