Telegram from M'Care Zanzibar Sept 12 1905

No 44.

In reference to my immediately preceding telegram report has been received from the missionary societies that the rising, though checked in the Lambe country, has spread southwards to the Akua Donde Tewera districts. They declare that the hostile feeling is increasing round Ar es Salaam and in other districts. The Government have been assisted, on the other hand, by some of the wa Nyamwezi.

It is believed that the discontent is chiefly owing to the fact that natives are forced to supply labour on the roads and Government plantations without sufficient remuneration, if any at all is received.
