Telegram from M'Case Jangbar

Reference to my immediately preceding telegram report has been received from the missionaries in the Tumbi country, that the rising, though checked in the Akua Dondi Divera districts. They declare that the hostile feeling is increasing round M'Case and in other districts. The Government have been assisted, on the other hand, by some of the Wa Nyamwezi. It is believed that the discontent is chiefly owing to the fact that natives are forced to supply labour on the roads and Government plantations without sufficient remuneration, if any at all is received.
