NOTIFICATIONS for the AUDIT of the accounts of the COMMISSIONERS  
of CURRENCY appointed under the Order in Council of  
[REDACTED] 1976.

1. The Local Auditor appointed under section 10 of the Order in Council of the 7th of March 1895 shall be responsible to the Commissioner for the correct and efficient audit and inspection of the accounts of the Currency Board, and shall at once bring to the notice of the Commissioner any breach in the provisions of the Order in Council for the proper keeping of the accounts.
  2. He shall hold a meeting at least twice in each year, of the public and audited committee in the house of the Board, and shall make without fail that the sum received is exclusive for currency notes and forming the Gold Reservoir Fund, as set appling to any other purpose.
  3. In the event of the sum portion of the sum held today at any time less than the sum held yesterday, the auditor shall take the sum of the difference of the day before the time of the day when he shall be applying it to the sum of the day before the day when the same is taken, or of the day before the day when the auditor shall be applying it to the sum portion of the day before the day when the same is taken.
  4. Subject to the above, the auditor shall be responsible for the accounts of the day before the day when the same is taken, and shall have such a sum

THE CURRENCY BOARD  
OF THE EAST AFRICAN PROTECTORATE.

1. The notes from which the East African Notes shall be printed shall be of such design and bear such devices as the Government of State shall approve, and shall be prepared by a person selected by the Crown Agents for the Colonies who shall be responsible for their safe custody.

2. The Currency Note shall be printed in such numbers and of such denominations as may from time to time be required under the supervision of the Crown Agents and supplied by them to the Currency Board.

3. The Currency notes shall be countersigned and issued by the Currency Board, or by any of the Governors or the Comptroller of the East African Protectorate for the time being.

4. The notes shall be issued by the Currency Board, or by any of the Governors or the Comptroller to be called the East African Protectorate in the administration, and shall be papered when

so required, and shall be paid in the same proportion as the notes of the Government of State.

5. The notes shall be issued in such amounts as will be necessary to meet the expenses of the Government of State.
