My Lord,

I-have had under consideration the question as to whether the Junior Officers of the Frotecterate Civil Service should not be required to undergo some examination in Law.

- 2. After consultation with the Judges of the High Court and the Grewn Advocate we are agreed that it would be a great advantage if some such examination were enforced, and it is proposed that this should be in the Penal Codes in procedure both Civil and Criminal and in the elementary rules of evidence.
- 2. I would suggest that the passing of this examination be made compulsory in the case of newly appointed Assistant Collectors, who would be required to satisfy the examiners during
