and of a draft circular  
of the proposed  
new rates are enclosed,  
together with two copies to  
the latter, comparing the  
proposed effects of the  
existing bear rates,  
the proposed bear rates,  
and the rates of the  
substantive species, the

3. It will be seen that the proposed  
rates will effect  
some saving as compared  
with the existing railway  
rates, while, ~~the~~  
as compared with the  
Post-office bear rates,  
the new rates will be about  
the same, the expense of  
mailing full pay instead  
of half pay being  
merely balanced by the

reduction in the carriage  
allowance.

4. In view, therefore, of the 707  
reasons urged by Mr.  
Curie in favour of his  
proposed rates, and that  
he has no hesitation in recommending  
them for the  
approval of T. L. and  
of the Comtee. in view,  
he would further observe  
that, for similar reasons,  
and for the sake of uniformity,  
they should also be  
applied to the substantive  
species in the other  
branches of the Post-office  
service.
