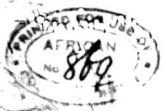

Referring to my telegram No. 97 Mackenzie and Poulkes applications appears to include portions of Arabuko and Sekoki forest. Their boundary therefore should be made to coincide with N.E. boundary of forests. Only scrub on rest of area. Considerable native rights exist which must be reserved.
