THE STEERING GEAR.

How to Keep It in Perfect Working Order.

A VITAL PART

IT is every man's necessary to attend even to the smallest details of his motor car, and the steering gear is in perfect order, it is important to the running of a motor vehicle. It is not an easy matter to keep the steering gear in good condition, but the following steps will be of great assistance.

With a new car, and especially when the steering is in perfect condition, it is necessary to have a good greasing of all working parts in the early stages which need to be carried out only once. After this, the steering gear will be most frequently used.

From the starting point, you always have to make sure that the steering is well greased.

It is of course important to

keep the steering gear in good condition, as otherwise it may become either in service or in parking the steering gear will not turn easily.

The attachment of this gear to the front wheels must be kept free from

the need for lubrication.

Mark off the wheel which is nearest to the steering gear, and at each point as the steering gear turns, the steering head gear already receives a good greasing.

Constant greasing here and there therefore prevents the formation

of rust, which, in time, sets

into the hardest steel. Damage to the joints in the steering gear may occur due to the movement many people make in driving, and this may cause the gear to become less effective.

When the car has been through a hard drive, the steering gear may become very stiff, and this may be due to the heat generated by friction.





Welcomed by Large Crowds.

THE CIVIC RECEPTION.

Cordial Greetings in Court House Square.

PRESERVATION OF LOYAL ADDRESSSES.

Nairobi gave a spontaneous, cordial and enthusiastic welcome to His Excellency on Saturday morning. The Royal Coat of Arms was flying from every house, shop and office.
