South African Defence

Fortification of Table Bay.

Necessity for a Military College.

Reuter's Special to "E. A. Standard" London.
Reuter's correspondent at Cape Town reports that in the Assembly General Smith emphasised the necessity of organizing South African defence before participating in any Imperial plan. He said that the Government intended to fortify Table Bay and hoped that within a year it would be so strong as any place in the world. The importance of Durban as a seaport station was even more prominent and a scheme was being formulated with reference to it. He advocated a system of annual training similar to Lord Kitchener's Australian scheme and further expressed his belief that a military college was necessary.

Admiral Henderson is said to reply that the keynote of his report contained the sentence that any action which attacked the support of the Empire as a unit to Australia as it is to the whole of the Empire.

Reuter at Sydney states that the Commonwealth Government is appointing a British officer to organize an extensive wireless telegraphy system, which was recommended by Admiral Henderson.

Reuter's at Amsterdam reports that the Government has expelled from Holland an Englishman named Tinsley, who is the representative of the Canadian Uranium Steamship Company, for attempting to land a number of returning Russian emigrants, rejected by America and whom the German authorities prohibited from passing through Germany. These sixty unfortunate are being handled about from one country to another and none are willing to admit them.

Negotiations with Turkey

Reuter is informed that negotiations between Turkey and Germany with reference to the Bagdad Railway have made good progress. It is expected that they will be concluded in a few days, upon which direct negotiations will be opened between Turkey and Britain with reference to the Bagdad-Persian Gulf section. The Ottoman Minister of Finance has announced that a German company will build the railway as far as Bagdad.

A Building Accident. The Commonwealth

Indian Mason Killed.

A very serious accident occurred about 11 a.m. on Sunday at the building which is being erected for Messrs. Mackintosh Bros. resulting in the death of one Indian mason. The work of a mason working on the second floor had just been put in. We understand that two masons were on the scaffolding at the time the work was completed. The formwork being descended took them to take down the scaffolding. It is alleged that the two masons instead of doing so, started prying out the wood of the scaffolding. As the work had only just been completed the cement was not set and the keystone was displaced. The stones then toppled over and one mason, who could neither have jumped over or was knocked over, became covered with the falling debris. From the effect of his injuries he died last night, we hear, at 7 o'clock. The second Indian mason was with few bruises.

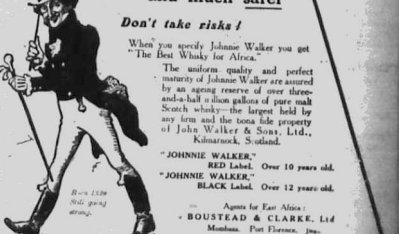

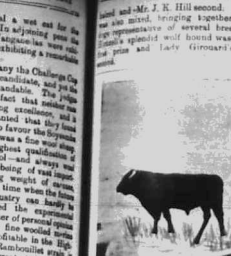

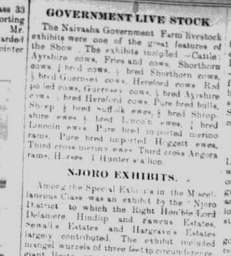

In the Commons. Naval Estimates Debate.

Additional Ships and Personnel.
(Speaker's Special to "E. A. Standard.")

The naval estimates amount to £41,392,600 (an increase of £3,788,800). No new construction £1,738,616 is for frigates, which are the first step towards the new fleet, while the five armoured cruisers, three protected cruisers, two torpedo cruisers, a destroyer, a depot ship and a hospital ship are included in the estimates. Mr. McKenna in his annual statement certain questions affecting the administration and organization of the Dominion naval force. He has discussed with the Dominion Government and they hoped to have more details outside the Imperial Conference.

Further Details of Grey's Speech.

In the debate arising out of the naval estimates as reported in a previous issue, Mr. Edward Grey's speech is being published in full. He spoke ably and impressively of the tremendous expenditure on armaments, the burden of which on the working classes was such that they would revolt. He emphasized that the country's moral relations were seriously damaged by the recent negotiations at Potsdam. The Government regarded relations with these three friends and chief powers as essential. They entirely repudiated Count Schenkelski's friendly reference to the British as the "strongest nation in the world." Mr. Grey's recent reference to the last five years of peace which much have brought ten groups of people into existence who have been gradually disappearing. Mr. Grey concluded, "It is our policy to be staunch to every stage of war, and to get into and out of it as quickly as possible."

Army Estimates.

Shortage of Officers.
(Speaker's Special to "E. A. Standard.")

Mr. Haldane when introducing the Army Estimates proposed any scheme of compulsory service which would interfere with the recruiting for the regular army. The establishment was more completely filled, he decided, except the Royal Engineers, which were filled by officers at the Commission. He then urged the working out of the most serious problem of the army supply, and the doing of this at the stage of officers. It is proposed to adopt a system of nomination for officers by headquarters who would be required to say whether the nomination shows the real capacity of Englishmen for the work. The preliminary examination is to be abolished and each case recommended will be considered.

Approval of Arbitration.

Grey Urged to Hasten Negotiations
(Speaker's Special to "E. A. Standard.")

Mr. Edward Grey's arbitration statement has evoked a chorus of approval from all parties and sections of the press. Mr. Grey is urged to hasten negotiations with President Tal. The "Evening Standard" considers that it is not a hasty demand that Britain and the United States should conclude a treaty with a negative arbitration agreement into a positive alliance, such as to assist the other. Even an attack upon them, with their combined arms, would become ridiculous and there would be some reduction of a real reduction in the armaments of the powers.

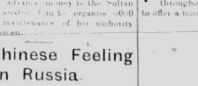
