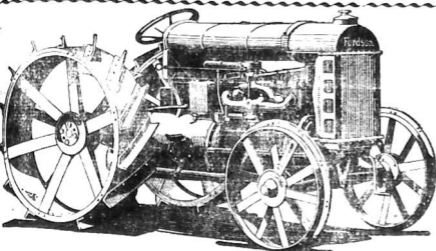

GERMAN PRESIDENT.

Seven Candidates.

[REUTERS AGENCY'S AGENCY.]

Berlin, March 29. Though millions of German men and women will for the first time in their lives to-morrow put a cross on the ballot paper for the President of the Republic, nobody expects any of the seven candidates to obtain an absolute majority for the requisite election but the voting will give a clear idea as to whether the candidate to be elected at the second ballot on April 26 will be a Republican or a Monarchist. Even if a pro-monarchist candidate like the Vice-Chancellor Herr Janner is elected on April 26, this does not mean the immediate restoration of the monarchy but merely the popular disaffection with the Republican regime.

LORD RAWLINSON.

Death of Commander-in-Chief.

London, March 27. The death is announced of General Lord Rawlinson, Commander-in-Chief in India, following an operation for appendicitis.

[The late Lord Rawlinson, G.C.B., G.C.V.O., was 60 years of age when died. He entered the Army in 1884, and served as Aide-de-Camp to Lord Roberts in India, served in Burma, Sudan, and South Africa campaigns with distinction. He was Commandant of the Staff College from 1905 to 1906, then commanded the 2nd Brigade at Aldershot, and later the 2nd Division on Salisbury Plain. He acted greatly to his military record by his fine work on the Western front in the war and was promoted Knight Grand Cross of the Victorian Order, in August, 1917. He was appointed to command the 4th Army in France in 1918, and to the Aldershot Command in 1919. He received a peerage and £20,000, for his war services and was created G.C.B. in 1919.]

ent parts of the country, but fundamentally the problem is the same, that of ensuring that the development on the farms shall be conducted upon lines of permanent stability, that the best use is made of the labourers available and that the labourers themselves are properly and adequately cared for. It is in the interest of every farmer that such conditions should be maintained on every farm and public opinion rightly insists that every endeavour be made to bring them about and maintain them. Such public opinion requires organization. It should be able to insist upon effect being given to its principles. Government assistance may be required and would no doubt be forthcoming in support of such organized opinion, but the direction of procedure upon farms can never be a purely Government function other than by way of checking abuses within the limits of the law. A central organization devoted exclusively to the examination of labour problems would contribute to the benefit of every employer of labour in the country. It would grapple with the facts as they were ascertained; it would be in close touch with all farms and with all native areas; it would tend to facts rather than theories, but at the same time it would be able to bring all relevant facts to bear on the theories discussed. The formation of such a body would mean a real advance in the consideration of this vital problem and we trust that the new labour will witness a new era in this direction.

MUMTAZ BEGUM.

The Trial Resumed.

[REUTERS AGENCY'S AGENCY.]

Bombay, March 27. On the resumption of the Mumbaz Hill trial, sensational evidence was given by Alibhai Wani, a taxi driver, uncle to Mumbaz Begum, in regard to the alleged plot to abduct Mumbaz. He said he went to Indore as he was told he was wanted by the Maharajah. He was told by two of the accused that Mumbaz was to be taken to Indore and he was asked to assist, and was promised the half of the six other accused. He returned to Bombay and warned Mumbaz that he was being shadowed. Mumbaz dismissed his watchman because he was informed that he had accepted a bribe of 2,000 rupees to leave the doors of the bungalow unfastened.

Alibhai denied that he was a conspirator but he said the accused had given him their confidence and he wanted to find out what was happening, as he was a relation of Mumbaz, and he pretended to be in their confidence and promised to what the conspirators asked. He only got half rupees as he lost customers because he did not ply for hire. The accused Phans gave him money and promised that the Maharajah would give him more.

Mulgaonkar, the co-manager of the Indore State property at Bombay, gave evidence as to the accounts and receipts at the Maharajah's houses in Bombay at the time of the crime, and of a telegram sent to the Maharajah's aide-de-camp in regard to the tragedy. The Prime Minister of Indore, before the outrage had occurred, that nobody should stay in the Maharajah's houses in Bombay without permission.

During the course of the evidence yesterday, Mumbaz Begum is an unrepentant murderer, said her child had been murdered, and accused regarding the fact that the child had died.

THE FIGHT DESCRIBED.

Bombay, March 28. On the resumption of the Mumbaz Hill trial, Const. Bailey, of the 7th Gurkhas gave a dramatic description of the fight at the top of the hill. The officers were armed with golf clubs, eventually depriving Mumbaz's assistants, who were being revolver. Const. Bailey grappling a man who was endeavouring to drag the woman from the motor car. The man fired at Bailey, and Bailey then struck up the man's arm with a golf club, and the man burned and had feet maimed and damaged.

Bailey then took a club over another man's head, and a general melee followed except that one man escaped, firing as he ran. An officer picked up a revolver, a bullet and a jacket. Bailey subsequently went to Indore and identified two of the accused.

CAR CAUSERIE.

Disatisfaction with Repairs.

MOTOR-CYCLE DEVELOPMENT.

I have been seriously considering the question of repairs to cars and endeavouring to ascertain why it is that so many people appear dissatisfied with this, that or the other garage. It is only occasionally that one hears a motorist just express unqualified satisfaction with his treatment at the hands of a mechanic. There are some instances in which the work done is not good due to the inexperience of the mechanic employed but the general run of complaints themselves derives to a great measure from both on the part of the garage and the motorist.

"Look Her Over."
Many of those who have suffered some mishap to their cars are not nearly definite enough in the instructions which they give. There is too often an instruction given to repair or replace a certain specified part with some such casual request as "just look her over." Such instructions may mean anything or nothing and the proprietor must be extended to the sympathy of the repairing establishment which receives them. In the first place the damage to the car may be greater than a cursory inspection would reveal and when the initial stripping of the part affected has been performed other damage may be revealed.

If the firm concerned has supplied an initial estimate it will probably only refer to the rectification of the obvious trouble, whereas the thorough repair of the engine or chassis may amount to even more than twice the amount of the estimate. Much trouble to both parties concerned would be saved in cases of this kind were the repairer, before proceeding with the work, to advise the owner and obtain his consent in writing. The owner on his part should be careful not to rely on mere verbal instructions but always to conform them in writing. So far as an instruction "just to look over" a car is concerned this is always dangerous, both for the owner's pocket and for the reputation of the repairer, both of which can be safeguarded by the repairer obtaining in advance the written consent of the owner for the executing of any work which becomes apparent as the job proceeds. Delay may cost, but satisfaction for both will result.

Foolish Motorists.
Last week I mentioned the question of road courtesies in relation to foolish motorists. Two glaring examples of the utter lack of knowledge of some motorists have been brought to my notice this week. In one case a man tried for nearly an hour to start his motor cycle and then employed boys to push the machine 15 miles into Nairobi. On examination it was found that the H.T. wire to the plug had become disconnected and that was all the trouble. In the other case an urgent message was sent 15 miles into Nairobi for a break-down car and two mechanics to tow a Ford car. It was stated that the back axle was broken. When the car was examined it was found to be equipped with a Beuchet's axle and the driver had omitted to engage the gear 111. It makes one wonder does it not?

2,000 Miles Non-Stop.
In order to prove the suitability of the 350 c.c. motor cycle for serious side-car work, the firm of Triumph and Deaves has sent off one of its machines on an attempt to cover 2,000 miles without an engine stop, under A.C.U. observations. The machine is a standard 350 c.c. Bradshaw-engined O.K. In addition to proving that a high c.c. side-car outfit is capable

of traversing the length and breadth of Great Britain, the manufacturers wish to increase the confidence of the public in overhead-valve gear, as they have faith in this type of unit, and think that the test will help to overcome much existing prejudice. Attached to the machine is an O.K. touring side-car.

Carbon Deposit.

The motorist hears and probably reads a lot concerning carbon depositing in his engine combustion chamber, and he is led to think that it is an unmitigated evil. That is not so, because there may be times when a slight deposit of carbon will assist in preventing overheating by reason of the fact that carbon is a bad heat conductor, and so shields the piston head and combustion chamber. But there is in the situation, that the carbon which assists in this fashion is not to be regarded as over-lubrication but of too rich a mixture. The one is of a hard and somewhat dense character, the other is not unlike soot in appearance and composition. Over-lubrication has to be very bad on a touring car before it affects the plugs, but an over-rich mixture will soot up the plug points in half a mile. The perfect explosive mixture is one that has a slight excess of air, and in which the petrol vapor is completely diffused. If there is a high excess of air the engine will run hot, as there will then be an excess of oxygen.

Correct Mixture.

The mixture may be quite correct and perfect for combustion as it leaves the carburetor, but, thanks to faulty leads or other hindrances, the mixture may become very rich or very lean before it reaches the cylinder. The force of the engine inspiration will carry this petrol into the combustion chamber, when, so rapid is the explosion the petrol remains only partly consumed and the residue is deposited on the walls of the combustion chamber as soot or carbon. It is to prevent this soot-laying arrangements are provided, but by trapping a portion of the richest gases and allowing the main carburetor lead through the trap.

Pre-ignition.

It might be thought that with the great heat generated in a combustion chamber over-liquid petrol would be instantly and effectively vaporized. But ignition occurs at a high compression, the physical effect of which is to raise the depression point and so the natural effect of the heat is partly cancelled, combustion is imperfect, and a carbon deposit results. The power of a highly compressed gas to ignite is so great that pre-ignition in motor engines, whilst others ascribe it to some catalytic action in the carbon deposit which arises in even the most efficient engines. Pre-ignition must not be confused with "knocking" caused by a too-advanced ignition point for the speed of the crank-shaft. Changing to a lower gear or retarding the ignition will cure knocking, but changing to a lower gear will accentuate pre-ignition, the only immediate remedy for which is to reduce the throttle opening.

A Sleeve-valve Two-stroke.

The patent specification of a new type of two-stroke motor cycle engine has recently been published in England, the patentee being the well-known designer Mr. Granville Bradshaw. Between the piston and the cylinder is a single sleeve, which extends beyond the top of the cylinder and the barrel somewhat after the fashion of a Bert-MacColler sleeve valve. All the lower end of the sleeve is increased in size to form a pump piston. The sleeve contains ports, by which the exhaust and inlet are supplied

and is used to pump the fresh gas to 50 degrees above the piston. The sleeve is so arranged that the gas is drawn into the cylinder through a port in the sleeve. The pump piston is driven by the cam on the side of the cylinder. This occurs after the piston has moved through the normal part of the expansion stroke, the piston being back again to the start of the compression stroke. With this sleeve-valve arrangement the cooling of the gas should be greater than in the ordinary two-stroke design as the gas is cooled by the sleeve over the port. The engine shows in this particular a slight advantage and is effectively balanced by weights on the sleeve and by a balanced piston of the combustion chamber, which causes the sleeve to rotate in the opposite direction to that of the piston. The sleeve is formed on the sleeve web.
