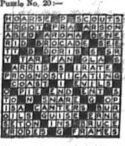

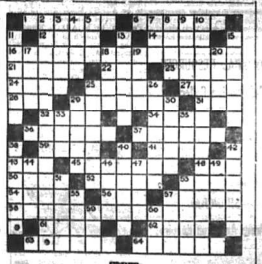

Now the show is over, poultry breeders must consider what lessons they have learned from the exhibitors and how to profit by them in the future. It is a most interesting and profitable business to exhibit birds of all breeds for one important part, and therefore every exhibitor is free to realize what points one's birds are worth. It is all a matter of the exhibitor's own birds of the same breed, but of different strains, and compare the stock with that of other breeders. 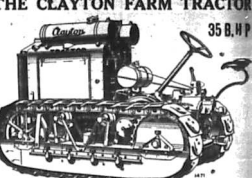
