ANSWERS TO CORRESPONDENTS. Mrs. G. HOWLAND, KANAKA, writes that she is anxious to start a garden, but knows nothing of them in this country and is unable to obtain any information as to no one in the district keeps them.

There is generally speaking plenty of green grass for some of the mountain, the year and plenty of water always. Ducks do well, and Mrs. Howland wishes to know whether geese would do equally well, or whether there are diseases which make it inadvisable to keep them.

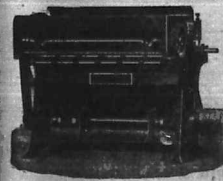
