AMERICAN CARS

New Types Placed on the Market.

SOME OF THE MODELS.

Despite the introduction of a number of new car types at the end of August or the beginning of September, the automotive industry of the United States brought forward several new types on the occasion of the show in New York recently.

In America today it is plain to see Mr. H. Maxwell Bliss on the "Gleason Bench" that the car of the future is being exploited to a still greater extent as regards the improved, smaller engines and gears.

Bliss announces a "Junior six" model with a 100 cubic inch Continental engine developing 40 h.p. at 2800 r.p.m., giving its maximum torque of 100 lb. ft. at 800 r.p.m. This small car is available with one type of body only called a coach type.

FLEXIBLE GLASS.

Austrian Invention Being Exploited.

REMARKABLE PROPERTIES.

The manufacture of flexible glass, known by the name of "Austrian glass," is being developed in England. By special permission of the Motor Council, the following particulars are gathered from the inventor's copyright notice in that journal.

This new material has many of the properties of ordinary glass but is more pliable and is not so brittle. It is described as "organic glass" and is perfectly transparent and colourless. It is sufficiently hard to be used for automobile windshields, and is flexible enough to bend under stress by a method called "work breaking."

Furthermore, it can be broken with the bare hands without risk because the edges of the fracture are not sharp or jagged, but are smooth. It does not break off in sharp splinters. Another important property is that the specific gravity is only about half that of glass in other words, a given sheet of the new material is only half the weight of a sheet of glass corresponding in size and thickness.

Tyre Sizes.
AMERICAN EFFORT TOWARD UNIFORMITY.

There is a renewed proposal of the standardization and uniformity of the United States sizes of balloon tyres through the activities of the "Booster for American Engineers." A questionnaire on the subject was sent to all automobile manufacturers, and in response thirty well-known corporations have expressed themselves as favouring a definite standardization programme on balloon and semi-balloon tyres.

Among suggestions made for improving the situation, were that the tread pattern and the rubber mixture be improved, that the number of plies of fabric in the tyre be standard or modified on the tyre, that there should be more plies and a composition be chosen for high pressure and extremely low pressure, that the tyre section weight be standardized as well as size, that the wheel diameter be standardized at 30 inches, and that the reaction in use from the standardized size be limited to 1 per cent instead of the present 10 per cent.

For such applications, we understand that the substitution is only just leaving the laboratory stage and is not likely to be available commercially for some little time to come. We were unable to obtain exact data regarding costs of manufacture, but were assured that it will be possible to produce and market "organic glass" as a commercially suitable price.

MOTORIZING TOPICS

THIS YEAR'S CAR.

Design Improvements in American Models.

A RECORD OUTPUT.

New models for 1923 have been announced by most of the motor-car builders in America, and it is possible to state briefly the general tendencies with regard to design for this year, save an exchange. Owing to the reduced cost of new clothing, there is little difference in the production costs of four and six seat having the same piston displacement.

Due to this there is a tendency to increase the number of small sizes on the market. On the other hand, some new very high-powered cars are to be made, with engines having high compression ratios and other modifications so as to give the maximum power from a given piston displacement, as that is from a given B.A.C. rating.

Designers reason that with such a reserve of power the engine will only be asked to work almost at comparatively infrequent intervals, for during ordinary road driving will half the rated power be required. This being so, they reckon they can afford to risk the use of a higher compression ratio for the few minutes during which a speed burst or a service hill climb lasts.

This means that the engine during these touring periods is working more efficiently, and so the petrol consumption is reduced. This follows the plan adopted for airplane engines, which usually employ a compression pressure which is much too high for ground work but which will ensure the best allowance when, say 10,000 feet in the air.

SWEET RUNNING ENGINES.

The standard of sweet running recently attained by the engine in certain cars in the medium and lower classes, which attribute has been used extensively in advertising, has made designers strive to attain vibrationless engines. In most cases heavier crank

shafts have been used and are designed to give a low centre of gravity, and the oil cylinders, 2 1/2 inch diameter or what are known as "anti-vibration" shafts are now installed. Lighter reciprocating parts are also being used, and a return has again been made to the minimum alloy for the purpose of a savings of weight. In order to reduce cast-iron pistons has been used in lighter lines.

CHASSIS ADVANCES.

RECORD CAR OUTPUT.

Over a million three hundred and twenty-five thousand cars and trucks in America for 1923. The wholesale value of this production is just over 2000 million dollars. The previous record year, as 1923, when the total production was 1,225,000 cars and trucks, valued at \$1,200,000,000.

The above figures have just been issued by the President of the National Automobile Chamber of Commerce, so that their accuracy is beyond question. Twelve half a million vehicles, or nearly three million cars were sold, five hundred and fifty thousand, as compared with three hundred and eighty thousand last year. It is reckoned that by 1928 the American factories will be exporting one million vehicles yearly.

THE RUBBER INDUSTRY.

New Process for Which Big Claims Are Made.

"CANNED" MILK.

A rubber factory that looks like a dairy and usually works with a "milk" — the pure liquid rubber; a mystery method that not only cuts out several expensive processes and produces finished products which are still pure rubber and retain all the virgin strength and durability and therefore a longer life by years than either of the systems in general use; this (according to a London correspondent of a South African paper) is to be British, latest move in the rubber war — a fight that is daily being made more and more evident. The American interests intend still to be as bitter as ever in such a contest.

The mystery factory is at Willingdon, all details that Mr. Philip Rodolowich's revolutionary discovery for vulcanising pure and natural liquid rubber latex, just as it is drawn from the tree, is not only a success, but is a commercial proposition that is destined to create the highest sensation the rubber industry has ever known.

Even to this trade the Willingdon secret of the "Vulva" Products, Ltd. has long been a mystery. It was now being decided to come out into the open, at a time when the rubber industry of Britain is facing the Philip Rodolowich's accepted as perhaps the leading consulting rubber chemist, but until now his process has not been tried out on a large commercial scale. The Vulva Company has taken the precaution of securing complete international patent rights, so that Britain will have the first "call" in the rubber fight with the new process. Naturally, the secret process is quite valuable, and the process will be granted to British rubber manufacturers by arrangement.

The new method is called "Canned" Rubber, and is the work of J. Philip Rodolowich, managing director of the Vulva Company, in an interview outlining the nature of the discovery, "It has been through-

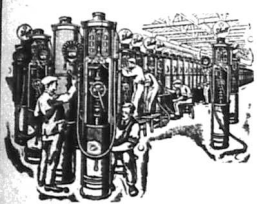

MOTURING TOPICS

MOTOR INSURANCE.

Information Points to be Remembered.

THE RESPONSIBILITY.

"The African Insurance Record" extracts from a paper on "Motor Insurance," read by Mr. E. H. Thompson, of the *Midway Passenger Insurance Company*, before the Nairobi (English) Insurance Institute, calls attention to a matter of which many motorists are ignorant.

This is the need to have a special clause in the ordinary insurance policy passed in respect of private cars to cover periods during which they may be used for some business or non-private purpose.

A private motor car is insured against risks to be apprehended while it is being used for private purposes. Should it be used for any other, such as the conveyance of orders to the post, or even the transport of some garden produce to market, it is not insured. In these days insurance companies are entering a disposition to look more sharply into such matters, and therefore the careful motorist will be glad to have the following tips:

"PRIVATE" CARS.

A private car is one used by its owner for private or for professional purposes—*for driving to the place of business, or for the purpose of making personal business calls or personal visits to the scene of his business operations.*

There are exceptions to this definition, the chief being cars used for commercial travelling or by commercial travellers or commission agents, or by or for the owner's employees. These are rateable as "commercial cars."
It is important to note that the description "private car" does not refer to the type of car, but to the purpose for which it is used.

"VALUED" AND "MARKET" VALUE POLICIES.

A "valued" policy is one which provides for the sum stated in the

schedule of the policy, and agreed between the insured and the insurer as representing the value of the property which is to be insured, or effected or renewed, to be paid in the event of a total loss.

Sometimes there is a discrepancy of opinion as to the actual value of the vehicle, which may be regarded as a total loss or covered every case. It is difficult to lay down after repair a vehicle would have been worth, it is possible an arbitrator might rule a total loss.

A market value policy is one which provides, in the event of a total loss, that the sum payable be the actual market value of the vehicle at the time of the loss. Its value is assessed by having regard to what a buyer would have to pay in the open market for a vehicle of similar make, year, power, age and condition. In actual practice there is always an element of guess and talk, in settling loss claims under "market value" policies.

Under a "market value" policy the company has the option of replacing the vehicle or any part thereof. It is an option without exception when dealing with "total loss" claims because a replaced vehicle is liable to be replaced without any complaint, except to the insured who has been disappointed at not receiving a cash settlement.

THE INSURED'S WARRANTY.

The proposal form contains questions which the proposer is required to answer. They ask the make of car, how long, date of manufacture, whether proposed for or renewal of such insurance has been declined, or an increased premium been required, whether any policy has been cancelled or terms of an insurance revised, and so on.

The proposer warrants that the particulars and statements are true, correct and complete and contains all information known to him as affecting the risk to be insured, and agrees that the proposal shall be the basis of any contract entered into. It is important to note that the proposer warrants that the statements are true and complete at the date of the proposal.

"VALUED" AND "MARKET" VALUE POLICIES.

with a claim if made under the policy.

The following statements of law, as given in the *Howe v. Lord* cases, illustrate the point:

In *"Anderson v. Fitzgerald"* Lord Lush said: "Nothing can be more reasonable than that the insured should be bound to disclose to the insurer all the facts which are material to the risk, and if he chooses to do so, to require that unless insured shall answer certain questions truthfully, the policy or contract which he is entering into shall be void, it is perfectly open to them to do so and, if they do not, they will then avoid the policy."

In *"Thompson v. Watson"* (1881) Lord Watson said: "When the truth of a particular statement is made the subject of warranty, no question can arise as to its materiality or immateriality to the risk, it being the very purpose of the warranty to exclude controversy on the point."

In the recent case of *"Haywood, Ltd. v. Bannan"* (1922) Viscount Haldane said: "If the respondent can show that he contracted to get an accurate answer to the questions and to make the validity of the policy conditional on that answer being accurate, whether of material importance or not, the fulfilment of this contract is a condition of applicants being able to recover."

In the same case, Lord Blackburn said: "When a contract is entered into, it is not to be construed, if immaterial, the contract will stand; if material, and the insured has been guilty of a breach of disclosure, the contract is void."

Where an answer is evasive the company is put upon inquiry, and the case of the policy without taking pains to discover what should be the correct answer might lead to a waiver of further information on the point in question.

Where a question has been deliberately left unanswered with intention to mislead, this amounts to concealment, or non-disclosure, which would probably avoid the contract.

MUTUAL GOOD FAITH.

There must be the utmost good faith on the part of the proposer in answering the questions; he has a duty of disclosure to discharge. This doctrine is expressed in the phrase "utrumque boni fidei" (the duty of both parties). A full and accurate disclosure of all facts material to the risk must be made by the proposer.

The insurance company, on its part, must also state an accurate and possible the precise nature and

extent of the contract to which it is prepared to enter.

It is important to note that it is a duty on an insured to answer all the questions on the proposal form, and to supply material information. In practice, however, it is common to find questions on the proposal form framed so tightly that it is impossible to answer them in the strictest sense of the law. It is best to meet such a situation by stating that fact as material, but not to be asked.

It is reasonable to say would regard the facts as material, it must be considered material. Materiality is a question to be decided, if necessary, by a jury or arbitrator as representing reasonable men.

THE WHOLE TRUTH.

Frequently we get proposal forms completed in a most satisfactory manner. Answers to questions are accurate, shrewdly capable of more than one construction. If such a proposal is accepted without question, and subsequently it is discovered there has been a degree of concealment, what is the position in the event of a claim?

Where an answer does not reveal the whole of the truth, the nature of the omission has to be considered. If immaterial, the contract will stand; if material, and the insured has been guilty of a breach of disclosure, the contract is void.

If the answer is evasive the company is put upon inquiry, and the case of the policy without taking pains to discover what should be the correct answer might lead to a waiver of further information on the point in question.

Where a question has been deliberately left unanswered with intention to mislead, this amounts to concealment, or non-disclosure, which would probably avoid the contract.

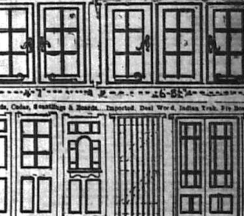

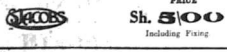
