CAR INSURANCE

Careful Drivers Pay for the Road-hog.

STUDY IN PSYCHOLOGY.

From time to time loud complaints are heard on the subject of the high cost of insuring private and commercial cars, says writer in the Motor.

That the cost is high can hardly be denied, and the various causes that tend and the various causes investigating. In this connection it is well to mind the large sums of money motorists pay yearly for the financial security which thereby accrues to them. If we consider that on an average the cost of insurance is more or less fixed about the same amount for an ordinary medium-size car as the license, the emergency fund sum one way or another is equal.

So we arrive at the conclusion that a motorist is insuring against a risk of accident due to speed either on the part of himself or someone else. It is then but logical to deduce that the risk insured is really a factor of the daring or recklessness of the motorists themselves.

All this, that insurance is the chief contributory cause of the danger of driving on our roads to-day. And it is the recklessness, or

thorough, or sheer light-mindedness of the law who are just natural reasons that the high cost of insurance for the million or more of motorists in the country prefers to tax themselves, for their own financial protection, this enormous sum each year.

The remedy—there is no single remedy with this motor-hog problem, and they alone can be made to pay for the road-hog by their own financial protection, this enormous sum each year.

THE TAXPAYER'S DRIVER.

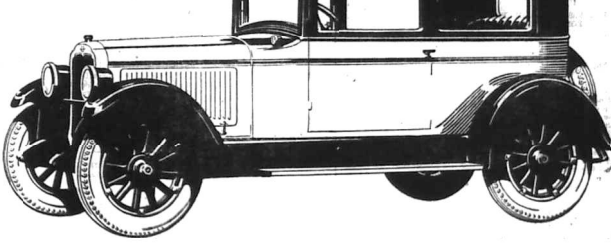

We believe that the general public, at this rate in Kenya will be willing to offer further support by purchasing again in the present circumstances, but they will expect a limit to be placed to their support of sacrifice. Bread is an essential commodity and its price affects the poorer classes of the community more now directly than it has done in the past. We have never had any quarrel with the principle of protection as a legitimate means of encouraging local industry and of retaining capital in the country, but we must admit that any section of the population, whether they are interested in growing wheat or in manufacturing and selling bread,

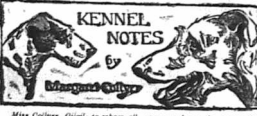

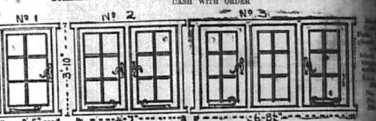

**MOTERING TOPICS**

**THE CARBURRETTOR.**

Care and Maintenance of the "Zemith".

HINTS TO THE OWNER.

A great number of cars fitted with Zemith carburetors of one type or another. The carburetor looks like everything else, a certain amount of attention to its correct adjustment will insure most effect on an engine than many people are inclined to credit, for, besides making all the difference between power at the lever of the carburetor can make an engine rough or smooth within certain limits.

The most popular type of Zemith is a simple float-valve instrument. This is very easy to look after, the adjustment is simple, the float-valve, float, needle, and cone which are the carburetor's governing mechanism, are arranged in a cylindrical case which is a chamber underneath the float chamber, and can be withdrawn when the petrol pipe has been unstoppered, taking great care not to lose the float washer round the pipe—and the setting for the petrol pipe is secured also.

Whatever care is used in fitting the petrol a certain amount of dirt, water and flaked paint from the petrol can find its way down the petrol pipe, and it is this which should be removed at regular intervals in the garage inspection.

**DISASSEMBLING.**

When the filter is replaced and the petrol pipe setting has been secured, the filter should be held with one spanner while the petrol pipe nut being done up with another, for if both turn together the petrol pipe may be broken. Fuel passing through the filter enters the float chamber through a hole at the bottom of the latter, this hole being drilled in a detachable block forming the setting for the needle of the float chamber.

It should then be moved to one side and the needle in it fitted in any other way, carried to the float chamber, and the float valve set in its position. It will bring the float away with it.

When the needle and float have been taken out of the float chamber the latter can be carefully cleaned with a rag which is not likely to leave pieces of fluff or cotton behind it. The horizontal lever of the needle setting will be in the position of the float chamber, and this can be unlocked with a bolt-washer of a new setting is required. Remember that the setting cannot be made tight by grinding the needle with any form of power accessory. If flow is a constant leak another setting of the needle is necessary. The needle itself has a collar added in position.

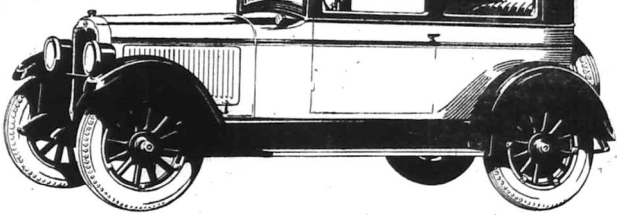
