His Excellency's Review.

A Tale of Progress

Appeal for Co-operation

At the Coronation subscription Banquet held at the Railway Institute, Nairobi, on the evening of July 28th, His Excellency gave an able review of the progress made in British East Africa during the first year of His Majesty's reign.

After Lord Cromworth had proposed the toast of His Majesty King George V, which toast was received with loyal enthusiasm, the Hon. G. K. Watts, C.M.G., proposed "The Land we Live in." Mr. Watts spoke briefly putting in a good word for our valuable assets. He referred to the signs of energy which was being exhibited by the Colonies, particularly the establishment of two daily papers which he hoped would give such news as would tend to fit British East Africa with White Settlers of the right sort.

His Excellency who arose and cheering said:

His Excellency's Review

Gentlemen: May I be the first to extend a hearty welcome to this assembly. At the time of the coronation it was not possible for all of you to be present at the coronation and for the general rejoicings. That this was due to any lack of enthusiasm has been clearly shown to-night. We have read with deep interest the reports of the progress and splendid successes of the participants on the occasion of His Majesty's coronation of the enthusiasm of his subjects, the assurance that our King is one of the heroes of his countrymen. Success can be achieved in our own country. Our dreams are connected, has effected in its first year great and practical changes in the development of the Imperial Ideal. This is perhaps not an overstatement upon which to enlarge upon the many difficulties which he before us in our own evolution, but it certainly is one where we might profitably review the progress of the last year—the first of His Majesty's reign.

The great outstanding feature of the year is the recognition by the Imperial authorities that the time had come for further progress in the development of the country, the material development of increased shipping facilities and the construction of a system of roads to the Uganda Railway. It had been felt that for some years past the development of the country was being greatly retarded owing to lack of funds for important works. It was therefore with the greatest satisfaction I was able to announce that the Imperial Government had granted the Imperial Loan of £2,000,000. These funds are to be devoted to these projects, all of which have been strongly advocated in the country for several years.

First and foremost will be the provision of an efficient water supply for the town and suburbs of Mombasa. We have been considerably hampered in coming to a decision in the past owing to the fact that it was thought that no suitable supply could be found except at an excessive distance from the town. Water was known to exist in the Shimba Hills. Mr. Macpherson and his assistants had been widely reported and a project was proposed which contemplated the utilization of the Van or East River. This would have entailed an expenditure of quite £200,000—a sum which did not appear practicable in view of the present financial position. When the question of a water supply was first mooted, and a report forwarded to experts in 1909, it was estimated that the quantity of water required in 1910 would be about 300,000 gallons per day. A committee composed of officials and non-officials which sat in 1909, considerably increased this estimate and recorded their opinion that a provision of 600,000 gallons per day should be made for a population 50 per cent. less than that of a population 50 per cent. less. The water in the hills had to be all pumped and delivered by some means to the town. The quantity of water available in the hills was estimated to be about 100 million gallons per day in the driest weather. 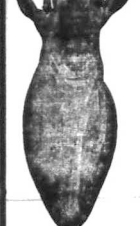

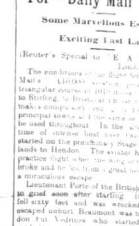

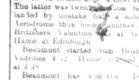
