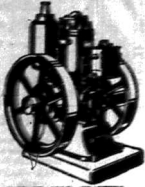

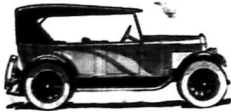

NAIROBI PERJURY TRIAL.

Supreme Court Sequel to Bag Snatching Case.

SETIANY'S WIFE ACQUITTED.

Police Constable Pleads Guilty and Pays a Penalty of Shs. 400.

In the Supreme Court this week a jury trial took place in which Mr. J. B. Dobson was charged with having committed perjury in the Magistrate's Court. It will be remembered that Mrs. Dobson, while on a visit to Nairobi, had her bag snatched by a native ostia, Emetia Hones. A boy named Moses was arrested, and an identification parade was held at the Police Station, at which Mrs. Dobson picked the man out. When the case came before the Magistrate, Mrs. Dobson said that she had not been assisted to pick out the accused the day before. It is in connection with this statement that Mrs. Dobson is accused of perjury.

Mr. Justice Stephens considered the Bench and Mr. Justice G. Schwartze defended. Mr. Dobson was sentenced, a young and attractive woman, who was seated in the body of the Court with her husband, was obviously distressed, and went as she took a seat in the dock.

On being charged, she pleaded not guilty.

The jury having been empanelled, Mr. Dobson shortly referred to the gravity of the case, but saw no need to refer to the facts which would be apparent from the evidence of the witnesses.

THOMPSON'S COTTON 27,500,000

[THOMPSON'S COTTON'S AGENTS.]

Melbourne, Aug. 5.—Representatives of the Minister of Trade and Customs introduced the Cotton Production Bounty Act which provides for the grant of a bounty of 5 pence per unit of cotton ranging from three farthings to three halfpence per pound for 2 years for the manufacture of certain types of one-third of a penny to one shilling per pound, to be paid to the grower.

DREADFUL DISEASES ON THE COAST.

"Vanga a Place for the Damned."

A TRAVELLER'S PICTURE.

The Mombasa Times publishes the following account of the conditions on the Coast caused by a cholera epidemic...

One traveller came with Kwaka Kwaka he said that he and it struck me, he says, that although the natives are very ignorant in need of medical attention here they are not quite so badly off as those on the Coast.

I left for Tika the same afternoon and arrived there about 5 p.m. The health condition of the people of Tika is nothing else but horror. They are crawling with cholera, blooded with yaws and crippled with chronic rheumatism.

Worms and bronchitis also add to the toll of general debility and weakness suffered. This is only one of the pictures that meet the eye with the lid off—I have seen hundreds lying dead of some chronic disease, hoping each day for their only release which is death.

One day I saw one man with what is called "Cuti". His right arm and most of his right chest was covered with a returning ulcer. I gave him some opium to rub in locally. On my return to the road and promptly showed me his arm and chest. They were healed as if by magic. It must be only a few times in his life he is allowed to experience the thrill of pleasure an incident like this affords.

GAZI.

Gazi is a fertile village and for a native village, comparatively speaking, is very clean and healthy. The natives about here are also healthier and I did not expect to experience the third of pleasure an incident like this affords.

face often away—so much as that it clenched fast—could be fitted into the space in her face where her nasal bones should be and on looking down this cavity the thought and three could be seen. She was in such a state of derangement that the doctor, whose name was in a state of derangement, was unable to do anything but to walk about without a face.

At Mombasa—Condition of the people here is bad. Village dirty and unhealthy.

Disease—Condition of the people here is somewhat better than some disease of the coast. There are any cases of Yaws. Wasting is clearly about the size of Mombasa Island, but has no water to be had. The water is brought or hauled in from the main land. The village is dirty and unclean, but the natives are healthy. Yaws being unheard of here, and there is no fly and no lice.

Shimo—So sick in and about here which were not a great number as this is not a very thickly populated area. No flies. Three boats each arrived from Waini Island, but mostly old men with chronic rheumatism and were with despatch.

WORST OF ALL.

Lads for Vanga by boat. Of all the places you were ever in your life this is the worst. It is a beauty, but living among people on the coast and observing a most unwholesome place.

People simply rubbed the face for sometimes cleared the rest of all bad, and even then followed me down to the boat with bottles on their heads demanding drugs. If it were not so bad, it would be a nuisance. Numbers of the most chronic diseases are to be seen here, but no Yaws. There is a kind of quantity of chronic rheumatism prevalent which badly needs attention. There was very little yaws and the water supply had Yaws seems to attack at the North end and taking an hour's walk to end about Mombasa. The natives themselves say that Shimo, Mombasa, Waini Island and Wanga are all free from Yaws. Shimo is prevalent everywhere but seems here to come up from South.

Of the other diseases seen were Nylgia, Ulcers, and Rheumatic Gout, and Rheumatic Gout.

The impression as regards the general health of the natives as a whole is not good, and is becomingly bad. It is scarcely an exaggeration to say that 90 per cent. of them suffer from Scabies. As far down as 50 per cent. of them suffer from Yaws at some time or another. 50 per cent. suffer from Ulcers of all sizes which are undergoing treatment except a few confined on with a filthy piece of cloth.

In fact one is appalled with the loss of disease among such a motley time-worn, people unacquainted to bear without assistance.

For the rest, except for Shimo, the area is densely unwholesome. The area around the Lake Juba Marshes, Pongwe and Mombasa are all thoroughly bad, while Vanga is only a little better. In the area the individuals deteriorate both mentally and physically, mentally owing to the necessarily solitary existence, and physically owing to the swampy ground, to work in and difficulty in getting fresh meat.

I consider that it would be false economy to allow any European to live in the area for more than 12 months without a complete change. The natives of the area do not seem to get very enthusiastic about anything. To be candid, I cannot see that they have anything to be very fully enthusiastic about.

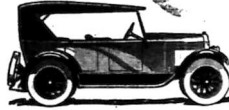

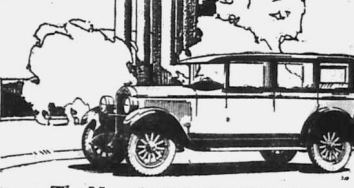
