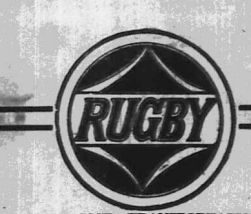

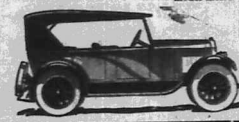

For a boy of Kenya to open the hunting field or the race course, on no judge of a child up against life or death, of a woman's notice. I have had much experience of both, and great trevise to do what this boy did. May I be permitted to say that I should feel so proud if he were a boy of mine. Y. of you of what you are actually out of your pocket. There are more dice at Madisson and I am sure any one of tick fever I am sure you are not suffering from. I have had a dog of this kind for a long period but was a case of Blue liquid. He has had the fever carried on the introduction of the use of the staff. I do not know. He was brightly handsome and when I examined, his blood microscopically it was full of parasites. The condition of the blood indicated this he could not possibly live another 24 hours. I injected him with Trypanblue of one and he recovered. I have and I would suggest that a supply of Blue liquid should be placed in the hands of the Veterinary Research officer. He should be tested for tick fever before the use of this medicine, as throughout the course of the tick fever the probable effects of the liquid on the parasites should be noted regularly under microscope. If it is proved microscopically that this staff can destroy the parasites, I should not simply frighten them away, unless after treatment in cases) then it could not be proved for tick fever attack. The medicine is not quite correct microscopically. Perhaps you are aware that the fever is not fatal amongst dogs bred in the country up to about 80 per cent, even if

they are not treated with any remedy with only a few drops of the morning and feeding. Before the Veterinary Officer of Kenya, I used to treat such dogs and cats and look for the spraying etc, and the brown spots to be quite negligible. tain. The reduction in the average population of the prison was contributing factors to the above recovery curve. At Kiliman Prison there was a considerable rise in the daily diet rate and in the number of deaths, attributable to the fact that the prison was overcrowded all for a time.

The thirty-five deaths from natural causes were due to the following diseases:

In addition 11 convicts were arrested by hanging (8 at Nairobi and 3 at Kiliman).

HOUSES OF DETENTION.

In the scheme of office provision for vagrants and destitute persons the prisons are used as Houses of Detention as compared with the Vagrancy Ordinance 1920. There was a very considerable reduction in the number of vagrants committed to prison during 1928, when compared with previous years, the total being only as compared with 1110 in 1924 and 128 in 1928. The bulk of these were natives of Kenya or neighboring territories, who were returned to their respective towns. There were only 5 (4 male and 1 female) European vagrants, as against 10 in 1924, and 10 male vagrants.

LEGISLATION.

Considerable progress was made during 1928 in the enactment of legislation and the promulgation of rules affecting the Prisons Department.

The Prisons Amendment Ordinance, No. 13 of 1928, provided for alterations in titles of Prisons Staff and amendments to the principal Ordinance were made to admit of stricter discipline of persons committed to prison for civil debt. This was effected by Rules made by His Excellency the Governor, which were published in the Official Gazette in October.

Regulations by His Excellency the Governor for Classification of Prisoners were published in the Official Gazette in May, following the same General Order as for the prisons in

A SEA ROMANCE.

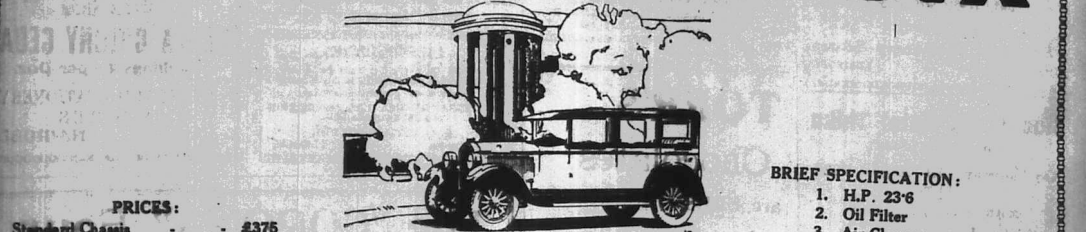

MOTURING TOPICS

FOUR-WHEEL BRAKES.
Design and Efficient Results.

It is a more matter of æsthetic to prove that about 75 per cent. of the brakes of present motor cars are still "foot" brakes. When we would like to hold on, however, to estimate the "foot" brake as a brake, we are designated from the start to go down to the most primitive, and not the policy of limiting the use of foot-braking systems available in certain circumstances. To quote some figures, there are many non-driven small cars with four wheels which require from 110ft. to 120ft. as a stopping distance in a speed of 40 m.p.h.; this is not good when one considers that such effective four-wheel brakes will stop a car in 100ft. from the speed of 40 m.p.h. and that such stopping distance should require only 20ft. This distance is about 100ft. as a rule.

It is to be granted that the average four-wheel braking system, as used to-day, is not particularly effective. It may still be argued to prove that this is all to be good. MINERAL WEALTH OF UGANDA.

Revelations in Geological Survey Departments Report.

HOW TIN WAS FOUND.

Problems of Petroleum Development in the Albertine Region.

The promise in Uganda of promising indications of petroleum, the discovery of tin and the most valuable work performed on behalf of the Protectorate by its Geological Survey Department, are features of the 1925 Report which has just been performed.

During the year, additional work had been performed in collection of data for the compilation of a provisional geological map of Uganda and part of Tanganyika for inclusion in the International Geological Map of Africa.

It may be said, this Report remarks that the question of its proving mineral in this part of Africa has excited a good deal of interest, and because of this, arrangements were made to send the Board of Trade, for representative of oil companies to interview Mr. Weyland (Director of Geological Survey) when he was in England. Up to the end of the period under review, however, no active steps had been taken on the part of any company to secure rights in the Albertine area.

The potential field is demonstrated the district, likely enough, to appear their lead of being situated within the line running through the East Indies, the Mediterranean region and northern North America, which marks the most productive fields at present known are distributed.

Valley and it would appear that a hole sized about a quarter of a mile in length, and about 500 feet or less. The same may be said of a hole which might be seen through the lake bed to the west of the Kibera swamp. On a scale of 1000 to 1, the geological character from that of Kibera, and it is supposed to be of a different higher horizon. The only other known occurrence on the Congo shore of the lake is suggested to give the name of a similar horizon to that which feeds the Kibera swamp. The Kibera oil-field is situated in the lowest exposed beds of the lower series and only represents a minor or less positive horizon, and if it does it is likely to be the northern part of the deposit, such as the Waa. It is likely to be very much smaller.

COST OF PROOF.

It is not possible to compute the depth because the thickness of the two sedimentary deposits (the Kibera and Kibera series) cannot be measured. On the other hand, if the northern swamp does their supplies from reservoirs in the factor facts, as is supposed, then at least one oil horizon may exist in the Albertine area to a depth of five, and likely enough very much less, than 2,000 feet, and may possibly be brought in by being through the Waa down.

There is, of course, but one way through to prove as a matter of fact that is by boring on the most convenient site, and that is inconveniently situated. The cost of boring the Albertine field to a depth cannot be estimated but it would be not more than £100,000 for this purpose.

It is one possibility only in Uganda, a definite oil field, which is at Kibera in the Swaha (Continued on page 5).
