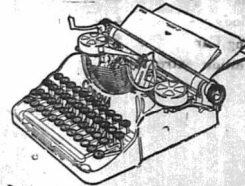

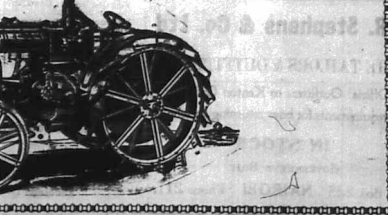

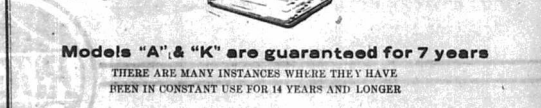

Celebration of Kabaka's 30th Birthday.

JINJA PLAGUE DEATHS.

[First One Own Countryman.]
Kampala, Aug. 30. The weather conditions are cold and dull for the greater part of every day. Violent storms are occurring and the majority of us are heavily drenched in the incessant drizzle and cold in the head and influenza are very prevalent.

As long as these rains last we must expect the roads to be "hard-going" but the main roads in Uganda are standing well up to the exceptional strain. One part of the main road entering Kampala from Jinja must be very carefully watched. Immediately after crossing the light railway line, a division of about 300 yards has been deemed to allow the main road to be properly laid. It was only meant for a temporary measure and is now full of large holes, especially on the sides of the road, many of which are covered with growing grass. Motorists cannot fall to recognize this division and the utmost care should be exercised on such traffic prone areas over the road. We are hoping the main road will be ready before many months have passed.

UGANDA PLANTERS.

The Uganda Planters' Association held a special general meeting on Monday last for the purpose of electing a President, consequent upon the resignation of Mr. H. A. Cannon. The new President is Mr. Hugh Lamb, an old resident of Uganda and Master from the Malindi district. The Association elsewhere a General Meeting was held at which a variety of subjects were discussed. The Association decided to join the new East African Bond and to nominate, in conjunction with the Uganda Club and the Chamber of Commerce, Uganda Cotton Growers' Association. The new East African Bond is a financial instrument of the Board, Messrs. Cotton, Bell, Smith and

Standard were appointed to represent the Association on the Uganda Planters' Board.

A pleasing feature of the meeting was the reading of a message from Dr. William Small, lately Governor of Mysore, who has been transferred to Ceylon. The Association had made him a personal gift of a silver ashtray, suitably inscribed, as a token of their appreciation of the interest he had taken of valuable work done by Dr. Small during his stay in Uganda. Dr. Small is expected to be in London in the near future.

PLAGUE.

Flapras is always with us in some place or Uganda. There is a serious outbreak at Jinja which seems to be confined to the bazaar area. The medical authorities promptly took the usual measures and everyone, European, Indian and native, having business in the bazaar are being inoculated. Up to the present about 30 persons, Indian and native have died, of which 15 were Europeans. It is hoped for the prevention of the spreading of the disease.

KABAKA'S BIRTHDAY.

The thirtieth birthday of His Highness Sir David Omon, K.C.M.G., King of Buganda, was celebrated by the usual observances of tea with His Highness followed by exhibition of wrestling, an event in which the Buganda are very proficient and of which they are justly proud. The took place on Saturday last and there was a very large attendance of all classes of the community. On Sunday His Highness attended services at the Cathedral in state with his Ministers. From early dawn on Saturday until well into the following night the King's drummers could be heard and the Royal procession streamed on Sunday morning through the streets of the town, an honour only accorded to royalty.
