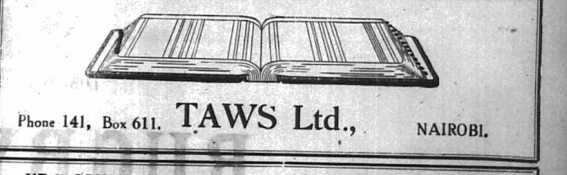

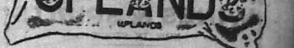

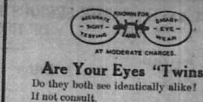

There will assemble this morning in the Memorial Hall, Nairobi, a Conference on Agriculture, Entomology, Mycology and the Cotton Industry where work will be done of the very greatest interest and importance to the present and future of Africa. The Conference will be attended by delegates from not only the British African States, including the self-governing Dominions of the Union of South Africa and South Rhodesia, but by experts from the other portions of the Continent under the control of Foreign Governments. The international character of the meeting to be opened this morning by the Governor of Kenya, the Agricultural Conference of the British Empire and the youngest centre of unity and solidarity in the Continent is to be held evidence of the ability and energy of the people, a result of the progress of the continent among the nations of the earth has as effect upon the territory that internationally the development of Africa, the Continent of the Twentieth Century, is being regarded with a serious interest and experience the common problems of all frontiers of nations, and a forecast, we hope, of the future of the continent, that co-operation in the future development of this practically unattached Continent. MOTURING TOPICS

ELECTRIC TROUBLES.

Common Faults and Their Detection.

ELIMINATION PROCESSES.

In general the trouble in motor vehicle starting and lighting malfunctions may be classed under the following heads:
1. Battery trouble.
2. Lighting circuit trouble.
3. Generator trouble.
4. Starting circuit trouble.
5. Motor trouble.
6. Switch trouble.

Trouble in starting and lighting systems should be located by a process of elimination. Much time, trouble, and annoyance will be avoided if the always logical at the proper end. Inspection should start at the battery, working along the wiring towards the generator or motor—never in the reverse direction. The present-day starting battery is a high development of the battery maker's art and much superior to storage batteries of previous days, but it will remain the proper starting point for running down electrical troubles.

BATTERY TESTS.

The test for battery condition is simple and easily made. The best and most reliable way is to read the specific gravity of the cells which will indicate whether the battery is fully charged. A fully charged battery has a specific gravity of 1.280 to 1.300. A battery reading one 1.200 is all that is capable of giving satisfactory service. Batteries are low when half-charged, and in need of some charging. When the gravity shows 1.150 the battery is "run down" and should be fully charged immediately.

Battery connections should be tight and clean, and lightly greased to prevent corrosion. Corrosion leaves material which is not a good electrical conductor and therefore makes a high-resistance connection.

If the battery continually refuses to stay charged in spite of recharging from an outside source, it should be temporarily replaced by another battery. When this is in good condition. If this comes the trouble, the original battery should be sent to an electrical service station to be put right. If the new battery is continually discharged the indication is that

current is being taken out by lights, radios, electric fans, and other accessories, or by short circuits, causing the output of the generator. If the dashboard ammeter is in good condition and shows a charging current in the neighborhood of 10 amperes, most of the time when the car is in use, the trouble probably lies in a short circuit or a worn-out battery.

STARTING FAULTS.

Two distinct circuits, if not electrically connected, may be taken from the battery of a "two-wire" system. One circuit goes to the motor and the other goes to the starting motor and is used only at the time of starting.

Problems in the lighting circuit are also usually to the following causes: open circuits, loose connections, and short circuits. The most common causes of open circuits are loose connections, faulty lamp sockets and connections, switches and fuses. If all the lamps fail to light, the trouble obviously is in wiring common to all of the lamps, which usually burns out at the same time. However, the trouble will be found in a loose connection or link in between the switch and battery, or in the contacts of the switch. If only one lamp or the lamp on only one circuit fails to light, the trouble is in the wiring that circuit only. Exchanging lamps with another circuit which lights properly will indicate where the fault is: in the lamp or in the wiring. In the same way an exchange of fuses at the switch will indicate whether the fuse has burned out. All switch and generator connections should be examined to see that they are tight.

LOCATING "SHORTS."

To determine whether or not there is a short circuit in a two-wire wiring system a voltmeter or ammeter test should be made for disconnecting one terminal from the battery and inserting the instrument in circuit. If the meter shows current flowing when connected in series with the battery and all remaining switches off, there is a "short" in the system. To locate this, begin by breaking connections farthest away from the battery. When the meter comes to indicate the short circuit will be immediately before the disconnected terminal and that shown in the dashboard ammeter will indicate discharge when all switches are open or there is a short between it and the lamps. It will not indicate, however, if the

"short" is between itself and the battery and the discharge will be seen on the battery's ammeter, and the strength in all right, the contacts of the magnetic coil may probably stick together, and the battery is discharging into the generator.

GENERATOR COMPLAINTS.

The two most common generator complaints are inability to generate sufficient current and sudden stoppage of the generator. In the case of a generator a separate fault in failing to deliver a correct charging current is likely to be due to a broken lead or to a broken contact. The maker of the brushes are both upset the commutator by spring tension. They should have a good bearing on the surface of the commutator and should be held by sufficient spring tension to give good electrical contact.

Commutators should be kept clean and smooth, free from dirt and grease. They should not be oiled, as the brushes contain sufficient graphite for lubrication purposes.

Other generator troubles which cut down output are of infrequent occurrence and usually are beyond the power of the ordinary driver. They are usually corrected by electrical experts.

What has been said above regarding generator troubles and commutators applies to starting motors as well.

STARTING.

With the usual automatic starter drive systems a simple push-button starting switch is used. This is not very liable to development. The contacts should come together so as to have the utmost resistance very close when the button is depressed so that the spring should be strong enough to break the circuit promptly when pressure on the button is released, so that the motor will immediately stop running.

If the starting button does not work with the drawback, the several things in the motor should be looked at. The brushes should be examined and checked and replaced with padding.

If the engine fails to turn over, the reason may be due either to the oil being too heavy or the capacity of the battery reduced by the lower temperature. In such cases it is well to get out the starting handle and crank the engine by hand to save the battery.

A Chrysler Record.

MOTORIST BEATS TRAIN TIME ON 60-MILE TRIP.

What is said to be a motorist record for England and Scotland was set recently by J. D. B. Ingalls, a motorist, who was driving his latest model Chrysler car on the "Edinburgh Express" of April 25.

Leaving the Marine Arch, London, on five o'clock on Wednesday morning of last week at a Chrysler "six-cylinder" car, Mr. Ingalls, an Edinburgh motorist, arrived at Aberdeen, 347 miles away, in 22 1/2 hours, actual running time, having completed the drive in 12 1/2 hours, actual running time, apart from certain necessary stoppages. The journey by rail takes between twelve and thirteen hours. The total stoppage here of only 12 minutes, mainly for the purpose of great refreshments.

GENERAL CYCLE DEMAND.

In spite of the increased output this year of over 120,000 Raleigh bicycles, the demand for all-steel cycles has been so great that it has been impossible to supply the demand for all. Mr. George Constantinescu, the famous inventor, has devised a car without clutch and gear box which automatically selects the gear necessary by manipulation of the steering handle and controls the clutch. This contrivance has undergone a road test successfully.
