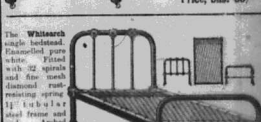

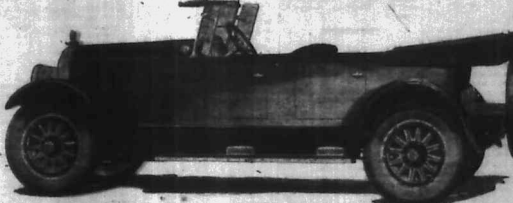

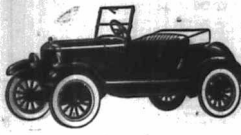

NAIROBI PLOT SIZES.

The study project made recently against the conditions under which it was proposed to sell by auction a number of plots in Nairobi for residential purposes by Abdulla has had the result of considerable opposition and the postponement of the date of sale. The provisions that a purchaser should give the plot within two years has been deleted; the style of building, instead of being one story, is now to be dwelling houses only to be built on one plot, greater size may now be made of the area of land and other minor details.

If the site of the plots remains unimproved and it is now not possible to spread the acquisition price over a period of years, the small man will still be unable to take an interest in the scheme and the development of the area must be left to unimproved plots, if they do not meet the acre plots for their own use, are left in position to erect more than one house for sale or sub-selling. 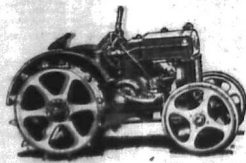

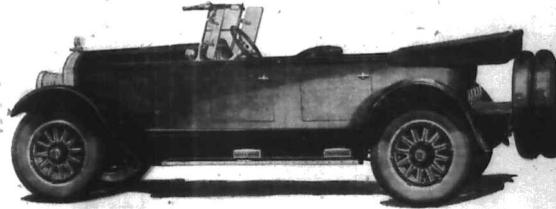

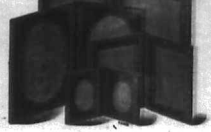

It is the most rapid route in 1929 the total cost of the 1929-30 year was £1,000,543 and the domestic exports from Kenya alone valued at twice that sum and the whole trade of the two countries, according to reports and statistics, at £22,000,000 last year. During the whole of that period of economic expansion there has been the labor problem with us.
