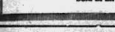

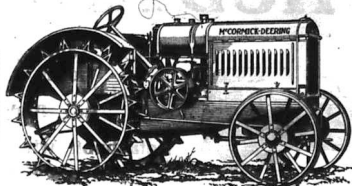

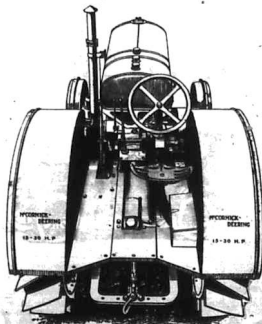

SMALLPOX PROPHYLAXIS.

PREPARATION OF VACCINE LYMPH.

Calf Lymph was first used to immunize people against small-pox by Jenner in 1786. Before this date there had been a widespread belief amongst the (Glossier)-shire farmers that those who attracted cowpox were not attacked by small-pox. Jenner having experimentally found the belief to be true started vaccination on a large scale and in spite of ridicule persisted in his efforts to stamp out small-pox.

In his day and for many years afterwards the lymph was distributed and carried about on quilts and boxes which had been dipped into the pus of a calf and then allowed to dry. These were used as points. The next method to be tried was "arm-to-arm vaccination," lymph being taken directly from the arm of a successfully vaccinated person. These methods became obsolete for obvious reasons when the science of bacteriology developed.

The present day method of preparing calf lymph vaccine is a great advance on the older methods, but is still essentially unscientific, as the actual organism causing small-pox or cowpox has never been isolated. Calves are vaccinated on the abdomen by making long incisions not deep enough to draw blood and inoculating these with lymph taken from another animal suffering from cowpox, or with lymph from a patient suffering from small-pox, modified by many passages through calves. The calves are then put into stalls of a special type, and remain there for five days. At the end of this period the lines of incision are covered with vesicles which are glycerine in a machine manufactured for the purpose. A liquid residue which contains the virus of cowpox, and in addition many germs from the skin of the calf, and other places. These extraneous germs have to be killed without injuring the virus present. This is accomplished by passing chloroform vapour through the glycerinated lymph for about half an hour, succeeded by a current of sterilized air to remove the chloroform vapour. The glycerinated lymph is stored in bulk at a low temperature (freezing point) for several weeks. Then a careful bacteriological examination is made to find if any harmful germs are present. These examinations are repeated at intervals and if satisfactory the lymph is ready for use in three to six months after its preparation. Tests are performed to ensure the potency or sterility of the glycerinated lymph, which is then filled into capillary tubes in a vacuum jar. Each tube is carefully sealed and is ready to be used for vaccinating one person.

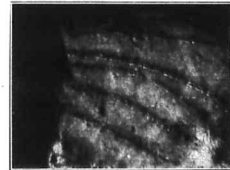

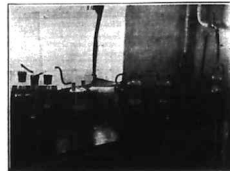

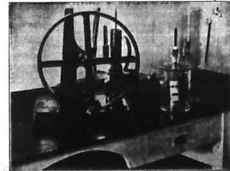
