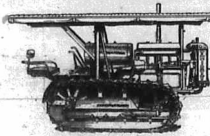

Conditions of Settlement.

An important principle has been established by the Secretary of State for the Colonies in the published way that both general observations come to the knowledge of the general public. The change from the records of the House of Commons of an answer to a casual question by a Labour Member who apparently had in mind only a descriptive line of criticism, reveals a distribution of responsibility in the matter of what settlement not hitherto accepted by the people of the Colony. The Secretary of State for the Colonies declares that as regards Kenya and Northern Rhodesia the question of migration in the ordinary sense does not arise. He has added that it is entirely of pace of the policy of the British Government to discourage the settlement of suitable British people, but it is proposed for the first time to consider how they and under what conditions they should be encouraged. The answer seems to give to the Legislative Council and the people of Kenya a more direct control over the question of settlement, or at least the excuse for a more active interest in it, than has been apparent before. Such a principle undoubtedly prevailed when the Governor of the Colony, with the advice of the Legislative Council, proposed the H. M. S. Settlement Scheme in 1921 since that date Kenya has made a further step forward in the direction of self-government, has accepted all the terms of a Protectorate, and has a Crown Colony and has substituted official representation of the economy of white settlers of the present system of agriculture by a non-White Settlement, based on the terms based on any proposal in the past three is no proposal to substitute those on any conditions offered by Government with the exception of the special conditions laid down under the H. M. S. Settlement Scheme which had a national approval by the Government is apparently more a position to declare what its final resources are except to ensure the creation of a set of circumstances which would perhaps face the Government of the country through its Legislative Council as to the real interests of Kenya and the H. It has never been considered feasible or desirable for an unrepresented nation, to be allowed to control or to ensure any white settlement on any desirable basis of policy and the addition of the white settlement has been made, in the main, in the most casual manner. 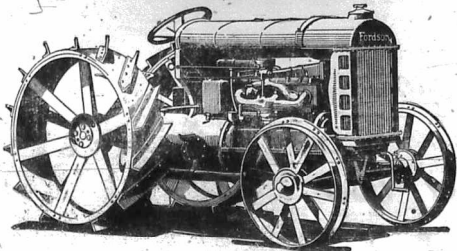

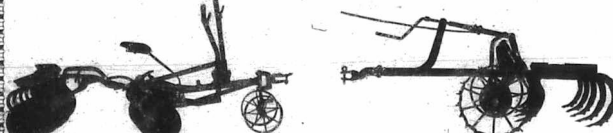

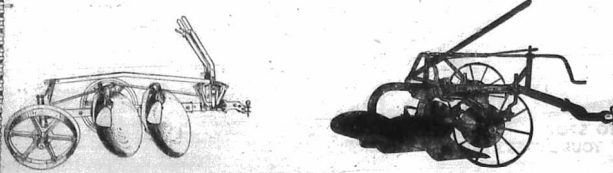

Kikuluwa.

Very few people know with certainty where to find the native village of Kikuluwa. They are aware of Pangani and they know the centre of official revenues and light which has been called Pwani but they are only vaguely conscious that a little native settlement is situated near Nambali. Kikuluwa is a black spot right in the heart of the European residential area, a small location behind Chumbe Estate, and it has presented problems to the Police and to the Administration for a number of years. With the proper development of the district and the town planning of Nambali-Kikuluwa must inevitably disappear and if the present of the Police in any criterion of its character would be better than some definite plan has been made to solve the problem. The settlement presented to the Nairobi Municipal Council on the subject of Municipal control of Native Village distribution, the Hon. Commissioner, Nambali made an uncomplimentary reference to Kikuluwa in a comparison between Pwani and that village. "He stated" that in the letter before him it was indicated that the village was not at all one that native liquor was the only kind of trade. Now the Nairobi Magistrate suggests in all seriousness that this village is a spot which can be visited in safety on a Sunday when the work of Police officers is done.

Only recently a man who had stolen a revolver was found in Kikuluwa armed with at least two daggers and in our column this morning we saw a man fighting in which forty Abasians took part. We understood that the liquor license in Kikuluwa is the hands of an Mghala Native who pays to Government the sum of £7.10 per annum for the sole privilege of retaining liquor. What is it a responsible man or whether there is any shopkeeper here to license and to support. Apparently there are so many applicants for this desirable and profitable position that the Government adopts the second and hallowed system of balloting for the successful applicant following the custom from a hat and handing over to the successful one first without any adequate guarantee of his reliability.
