In opening Legislative Council yesterday His Excellency the Governor stated that the Defence Force Bill would be postponed for consideration by the country during the Election next month. He also stated that the Government was appreciative of the support of the Council in considering amendments which Government thought necessary to meet the changed conditions of the country with the help of that Council. His Excellency personally approved the principle of compulsion and stated that such support also represented the attitude of the Government.

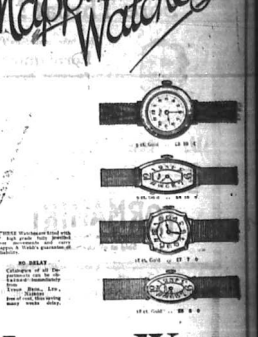
