BRAKEBROOKS SUGGESTS ON BRANCH LINE POLICY.

A comprehensive statement on the finance and working of the Railways was provided in the Legislative Council on Thursday by the Acting General Manager.

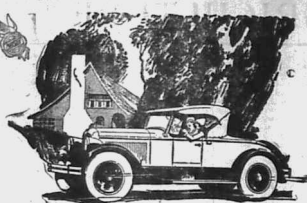
