MOTURING TOPICS

CYCLE EQUIPMENT.

Useful Accessories and How to Fit Them.

MATTER OF CHOICE.

The word "accessory" is in its own right a term which is applicable to motor cycle.

The motor cycle which has few provisions to spare and intends providing his machine with some of the innumerable items of equipment on the market must therefore exercise a certain amount of discretion in his choice and learn to differentiate between those which are useful and those which are merely ornamental.

To these two categories may be added a third, to include useful and without which a motor cycle would have an incomplete appearance.

The question of expense with the large majority of motor cyclists is a primary factor in his choice, and whereas the man who chooses to purchase whatever he please and suffers no inconvenience should be intruded into buying a number of accessories occasionally on his pocket, so to speak, needs to use his powers of restraint and to limit to only those things which will definitely and proportionately increase the pleasure of riding.

**THE SPOTLIGHT.**  
How it Should Be Fixed on the Car.

A SIMPLE PROCESS

Concealing electrical accessories from the single wire or grounded motor car is comparatively a simple process, when one gets to know "how" to do it. Most electrical accessories have switches at their own, the spot light usually having a switch in the handle, while a cigar lighter makes its circuit when it is pulled from the socket.

Practically all cars equipped with the single wire or grounded wire system, and this also makes the wiring of accessories simple. The first thing to do is to decide as to the position of the desired accessory, and then mount it. Convenience is the thing to be sought, usually in this, and in the case of a spot light the best position is on the one on the dash nearest the driver. It might seem a little inconspicuous not to mount the lighter nearest the position of the other fuses in the seat, but he has nothing else to do but reach over, and get it, while the driver has to stand to harness, and can't afford to let another one interfere with that.

ON WHICH SIDE?

Some drivers prefer their spot light on their own side, where they can adjust it while driving, and others mount it on the left or right, according to the wiring system, of the vehicle, adjust it to the side of the road, and place its driving position. A wrong connecting driver somewhat less than when mounted on the right hand it cannot be used to read appropriate license numbers.

For my own part I prefer it mounted down below the head light, on the front of the car, and directed on the left-hand edge of the road. In this position it gives the maximum light where it is most wanted and it cannot glare into an opposing car's eyes. For marking signs and that sort of thing, it has no equal spot light on the wind-shield frame. However, it's all a matter of choice.

CONSIDERING THE SPOTLIGHT

Having mounted the position of the wire is connected to the frame. The proper way to do this is to remove the post and washer from a convenient bolt on

the frame of the car, and the bolt as well if possible, clear off the rust, and paint from the bolt and nut. Then screw the bolt and tighten it with a file or screw driver, and the electric wire is kept around the bolt—then place the washer back with the light side toward the wire, replace nut and tighten.

This makes a good clear connection, and the wire will give you plenty of "kick" for a long time. A light coil of suitable over the post is an additional protection against corrosion, but care should be taken not to put on such a coil that shall be in contact between the wire and frame or washer and run the connection.

The clear wire can be connected and it will usually be found convenient to connect it to one side of the ammeter, and if the wire is connected to one of the two terminals the current consumed by the accessory will register on the ammeter, that is, if the accessory is connected to the lead opposite to the battery lead on the instrument, but if on to the other it will not register.

Switch on your spotlight, and the end of the wire on the terminal. Doesn't show any reading? All right, try it on the other, and it shows now. There's your light, and that's all there is to it. It doesn't register on one side, try the other terminal until the light shows up, and all is O.K. Be sure your accessory switch is on when you operate.

A spotlight and a parking light may sometimes conveniently be connected to one side of the starting switch, but be sure to connect it to the battery side of the switch, where the battery wire is in this case, of course, has current taken by the light will not register on the ammeter.

There is another way to connect a spotlight that has some advantage. The spot is usually treated on the left-hand side of the road, as in the case of a car, and when the headlights are on the "down" beam of the spotlight when it switches from light to dim does not run through the dimmer wire in connection to the terminal that supplies current for the dim lights or for the small side lights, as on some cars a set of switches from light to dim will turn

on the spotlight at the same time as the Ford this connection may be made at the connection block or manifold at the front of the dash. On the other type the connection block has five terminals, and the first is connected to the second one from the left, the wire carrying a yellow wire if it can be traced, and second, the light to be turned on. The battery of all cars, you must connect it to the dim side and not connect to the terminal on the other side. The wire for the block has six terminals and the third from the left is the driver battery terminal, also carrying yellow wire, also to the dim control, before but now carrying dim wire. Suppose you get your terminal and connect it to the dim control, and in which? That's easy! In that case the lighting switch is turned to "dim" position, and the end of the wire connected to the terminal on the block at right will be found that will light the spot. To make sure of the right terminal, which is "bright" and use as spot power. If it does O.K. if it does not, try it again, until you hit the terminal.

EXAMINE THE SWITCH

When you get a spotlight, examine the switch thoroughly, and see that it is well made. For the switch is usually the weakest part of the installation, and most of the spotlights that are not working have defective switches. Look at the switch carefully before it is installed, and see that it stays in good condition.

Most accessories connected by means of flexible cords and the will break and short circuits. See that the wire applied to the body or fastened to the frame firmly. Wire leading inside the car can be worn to the upholstery. This is usually the cause and easiest way to fix them. Under the car they can be repaired, if they break.

If cable is used slip a piece of cloth or rubber tubing over it wherever it touches the frame of the dash or metal body, so as to prevent rattles that may prove difficult to find at some future time. The connection of all electrical accessories—except the battery—should be in the "dotted" state.

Rubber "Revolution".

FRICKS, WHICH MAKES IT CHEAPER AND STRONGER

The important practical effect of a new American invention for treating rubber is discussed in an interview with Sir George Herbert Fricks, managing director of the Fricks Rubber Company, London, and who has been invited to visit Kenya to develop this method of producing more useful and durable articles.

Usually the "latex" or milks produced which is removed from the rubber tree is converted on the electric wire into a hard substance for shipment abroad. At the factory the latex undergoes a lengthy process to make it plastic. The new process rubber, ready for use in its natural form, is usually made through the medium of electric current, as depicted in the illustration in the diagram. The first machine means to the deposit of latex on electric plates coated with a calcium salt. The process is repeated until the plates are covered with a layer of latex, and the plates are then separated, giving superior quality and economy in the use of rubber.
