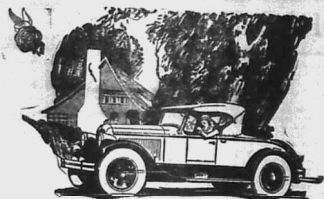

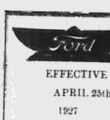
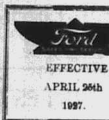

### The Housing of the Native.

It is inevitable that Kenya will make mistakes in approaching the problem of the housing of the African whose employment, industrial or other circumstances bring him into the town. There are several reasons why Kenya is bound to err but by the most important is because the latest method of housing the African has not yet been local adaptation, sociologists, psychologists and humanitarians in the most advanced countries are only beginning to grasp the problem. We published yesterday an article which from the pen of the late Mr. H. H. Brindley who in his lifetime accumulated a vast knowledge of the social conditions in that great and most modern of African cities, Johannesburg. Mr. Brindley contained himself very judiciously with pointing out the facts, in a simple manner he traced the defects, socially, morally, intellectually and physically, which emanate from the old order of things, from the unsatisfactory "location" method, or, as it is more accurately and properly named, segregated or petty owned and managed native townships. He treated with a firm hand the whole of the work, showing the cause of the present, the extent, the nature of the conditions, which have been permitted to grow in Johannesburg. The golden city of the Rand outstripped in the pace of its development the rapidity of the growth of the housing of the

problem, and time is the greatest enemy of Kenya. The main index of this Colony as its growth is measured is agricultural; it is a comparatively steady and the advances of its development on the creation of popular contented society is not sudden or violent. The discovery of gold on the Rand has given the industry a great impetus which ensued within that the life of the industry was dependent entirely upon the partnership of the African worker.

# DISEASE MENACE TO THE COFFEE, AND MAIZE INDUSTRY.

## Recommendations to Government.

### FOUR NEW OFFICERS AND THREE MOBILE FIELD STATIONS.

#### Urgent Need for Action.

#### HEALTHY SOIL CONTROLLABLE; STALK BORER UNLIKELY TO BE BRAGIATED.

A special committee appointed on May 12 to advise Government upon immediate steps necessary to deal with the maize bug and stalk borer pests lost no time in presenting its report.

The Committee recommends the inclusion in the 1925 Budget of provision for two entomologists, one coffee officer, one plantation inspector and three mobile units as a matter of urgency. It is recommended that money should be made available now for the two entomologists and two of the field stations at a cost of K1,750.

#### Special Committee's Report.

Before the start of the session of the Legislative Council there was held on the table the report of the committee appointed to consider the resolution moved by the Hon. Sir John South in regard to the menace to the coffee and maize industries threatened by maize bug and stalk borer.

The Committee consisted of the Hon. Conway Harvey, L.L.C.M. the Hon. F. O. Kirkwood and L.L.C.M. the Hon. G. C. Hudson with the Director of Agriculture as chairman.

The Committee held four meetings between May 12 and May 17 and in the short time at its disposal advised a number of witnesses competent to speak on behalf of such industries. The following extracts are taken from the Report:

**Maizebug.**

The maize pests brought to the notice of the Committee with regard to this pest were as follows:—

1. The large amount of damage that is inflicted on particular plantations and the fact that the incidence on individual plantations may be so serious as to cause serious loss in former years, yet the pest is becoming more and more common.
2. The fact that such control measures as have been evolved are, if properly carried out, effective in checking the ravages of the maize bug to an appreciable extent.
3. The difficulty encountered in dealing with such an adaptable enemy as the pest and the need for continuous investigation with a view to developing improved methods of control.
4. The very generally occurring feeling that other pests and diseases have not yet been taken up by the State and that the organization should be such as to control in advance of the pest.
5. The value of preventive measures for conducting research work on the pest in the locality of the outbreak.
6. The paucity of staff at present available for the services under consideration.

Witnesses continuously demanded of considerably extended facilities for the Agricultural Department for further research, investigation and similar problems.

We are alive to the fact that research work of the kind required to control such pests as Maize bug and stalk borer is difficult, laborious and costly. It is essential that further research be carried out on both these pests. Although much work has been done in other countries on the stalk borer, recommendations are suggested in this Colony that further research of such research has been laid during the past years, should be carried on.

We therefore recommend that as a minimum provision be included in the 1925 Estimates for the services of one or two new appointments, viz.—

Two Entomologists, One Coffee Officer,

# On Plantation Inspector, and for three Mobile Field Stations.

Owing to the fact that there is no provision for the services of a plantation inspector against the existing pest and to the fact that the Government has no means for the control of the pest, it is recommended that the Government should provide for the services of one or two new appointments, viz.—

Two Entomologists, One Coffee Officer,

**FIELD STATIONS.**

We are of opinion that not only mobile units, but also permanent stations should be established to provide services of these officers with the best possible effect.

We recommend that early consideration be given by Government to the appointment of the additional Coffee Officer and Plantation Inspector and that the services of the Coffee Officer and Plantation Inspector be provided immediately.

 Exports Increased by £125,000;  
 Imports by £88,000.

**THE MAIN CROPS.**  
 Diamond Exports Increased But Gold Falls.

The Tanganyika Trade Report for the year 1927 has just been issued by the Comptroller of Customs. The year has shown further progress in the Tanganyika trade, and with those of 1925, the Tanganyika trade has increased in value from £2,091,315 to £2,826,278, an advance of 44 per cent. The import (excluding specie) increased from £2,863,917 to £3,120,422, or 10 per cent. For the first time, the balance trade is shown as an excess of Imports. This balance amounts to £125,000, the result of the increased imports of Government material for fuel and other works. Government imports alone increased from £429,987 to £558,716, an advance of 29.7 per cent. The total trade for the Territory during the last four years exclusive of bullion and specie, but including Goods in Transit, is shown in the following table:

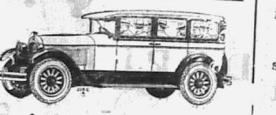

LABOUR COMMISSION REPORT.

Article 2. THE NEEDS OF THE AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY EXAMINED. Estimated Increases to 1929.

TWO MAIN PERIODS IN EACH YEAR TO BE FACED. The following section of the Labour Commission's report deals with the needs of the agricultural industry and discusses that, on the basis of statistics collected and making allowance for development, the agricultural industry will require about 35,000 extra units of labour in 1929.

Whereas the demand between April and September this year is 8,715 for the same period of 1928 it will be 50,494 both in 1928 and 1929. In the period October 1927 to March 1928 the demand is estimated at 17,155 and in the same period of 1928-1929 at 12,000.

The first and second crops of agricultural products and a seasonable increase in settlement, we have referred to the figures set out in the following table, we estimate as follows: 1. Cotton. That the area under this crop will increase from the 31st day of 1928, total of 68,000 acres, by 14,500 acres approximately to the 31st day of 1929, and by a further 2,000 acres in 1929 and 4,000 acres in 1930. 2,000 acres will be required from 1928 to 1930 to maintain the cultivation of the area in bearing state, and 2,500 to maintain the young stock in bearing state. In addition 1,000 units of labour will be employed on clearing and preparing new land for cotton.
