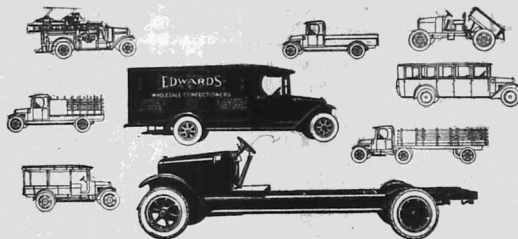

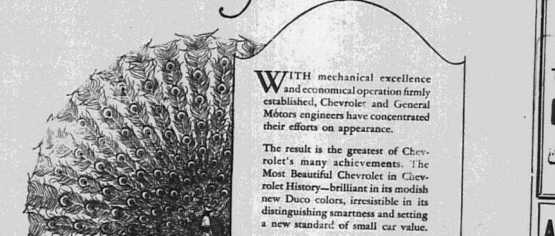

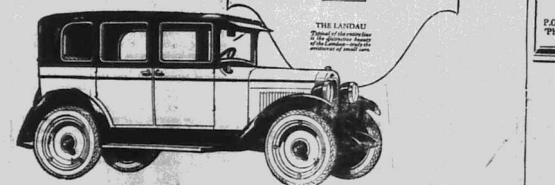

NEW DECORATOR COMES TO KENYA.

The "Cornwall" at Work.

BIG POSSIBILITIES.

In the past it has always been considered that a small population was only feasible for the maintenance of a large amount of capital. One reason for this was to be found in the fact that the expense of the machinery required for despoiling was such that, unless the factory could be kept running throughout the greater part of the year little or no margin of profit would be made. And so to keep the factory running it was necessary to incur a very large expense. This could only be undertaken by persons who were prepared willing to install an expensive factory, and also the means of conveyance, the leaves, after cutting, to this factory.

The fact has now occurred by the advent of the "Cornwall" Portable Fibre Decorticator Machine. An exhibition of the work of which this machine was capable was given to the Press on the 7th inst. at Mr. Scott's farm, near the station from Nairobi. Mr. Stanley Anderson, the inventor and patentee, was present and explained the working of the machine.

METHOD OF WORKING.

The machine itself is of simple but effective design. It is sturdy constructed with very few parts which are easily accessible. The method of operation is as follows: A rope passes the butt end of the leaves between the feed rollers and thence up and down the leaf towards and towards the drum which is about 2 feet in diameter and 14 inches deep. The rate of feeding is about 20 leaves per minute. The leaf is decorticated between the blades and the upper breast block. The speed at which the drum travels is such that the blades form a strong current of air above the lower breast block and this turns the decorticated portion of the leaf into the whole of the fibre in the leaf passes out through the lower rollers on to a travelling belt from whence it is taken up by another native. Any excess of sufficient horse power is capable of driving the tractor, all bearings are totally

omitted, thus rendering it impossible for the fibre to get into the bearings and cause stoppage. The main shaft carrying the drum is provided at one end with fast and loose pulleys for suitable drive, while a patent chain drive is actuated from the other end and transmitted by further chains and sprocket wheels to the rollers. At the very most eight boys are all that could be required for the complete operation of this small portable factory.

ADVANTAGES.

Amongst the advantages which are claimed for this machine the following stand out prominently: An enormous saving in transport is effected when the machine is taken to the station of the leaves, having to be taken to the central factory. With the use of the portable machine it is possible to save, not only the cost

of the transport system itself but also the running and maintenance expense. As the plant in the new estate consists of about 80 per cent. water, which is accountable to be a great asset for the weight of the leaf, it will readily be seen what a vast amount is being wasted on the cost of transport. With the portable machine the expense, falls to the ground during the process of decortication and it is afterwards decorticated and is afterwards pressed off the field as a fertilizer. No water is required during the process of decortication but it is suggested that the fibre may be taken to a central drying ground, adjacent to the plantation, where it can be washed and dried. By this means it is the fibre which is transported and not the leaf. It is claimed that one of these machines will turn out approximately three tons of fibre a week and that

the percentage of fibre obtained will be greater than by the usual method. On the estate mentioned, it was found that from 1000 leaves treated the waste of fibre in the machine amounted to only three pounds, whereas by the usual fibre produced in a miller type machine it would amount to 1000 lbs. in this Colony, and it is noticeable that it is the best of the best. The machines are hand and patented of many years' hand and patented by Mr. Anderson, who is himself a practical planter. They have been thoroughly tested out in the field and improvements have been made from time to time until now the Elliott's articles have been placed on the market. CENTURY OF LORD LISTER. The Saviour of Countless Lives.

ANTISEPTIC SUBURBY.

There is a village at Upton Park, in Essex, which was the home of a wealthy and enlightened Quaker merchant, to whom, therein, in a hundred years ago, was born a son, destined to become, and to remain for ever one of the "gigantes of our island and State," to be remembered with loving affection by mankind, save him, when perhaps Britain is one grain of salt at the bottom of the North Sea.

The boy was put to surgery—whose identity means little-work: but he had a heart and a head as well—more sensitive as a surgeon—and by good luck. The eyes in his head were powerfully reinforced by the use of the compound microscope, which his father had previously invented. Thus armed, the young surgeon set himself to the old problem, seriously aggravated by the recent introduction of anaesthetics and the consequent multiplication of surgical operations—why do wounds become inflamed and septic, with blood-poisoning and death to show the ghastly result?

CHEMIST OF GENIUS.

In Paris a young chemist of genius, also a user of the microscope, had shown that "members," as he called them, produce fermentation and putrefaction. Lister saw the resemblance between fermentation, with its colour and warmth, and surgical inflammation, and he was led to the idea of sterilizing by Lister's patients, and it did.

From the first attempt to use what he called an "antiseptic," carbolic acid, his results in the amputation of compound fractures surpassed all past records. Today his followers, no longer content to sterilize the limb to save the life, save limb and life as well, by the refinements which the past half century or more has brought to the methods inaugurated in 1865.

Thirty years ago it was my privilege, as a surgeon, to enter the surgical theatre in Edinburgh, to

which Lister had been called, years ago, from Glasgow, and while he had worked out his deadly doctrine of the value of his method. How thrilling to hear from my father, who had been his chief assistant, how Lister had used the antiseptic spray, first, before operations, and still more so on the day when he was to be laid in the falling days of protest

THROW UP LICENSE.

As a protest against the system of road control now in existence, which necessitates these proceedings, I have decided to surrender my license herewith. The action is taken in a letter sent to the Kingston-on-Thames Licensing Board by Messrs. J. "German Frightfulness." UBOATS AND POISON GAS DECLARED LEGAL.

"Frightfulness" without restriction is justified, according to the League Committee. Where reports are received that a vessel is being used as the means of inflicting injury on the sea, it is the duty of the League to take action. The U-boat warfare, as put in a report for the "Lingling" Committee, is a violation of international law. The Committee expresses the opinion that the policy of reprisals of war was not treated by any army in accordance with the law.

The Committee was divided as regards the deportation of 70,000 Soviet writers, but finds that the stated reasons of Belgian officials do not accord with the League Convention. Another Committee is examining the violation of Belgian neutrality.

SAWDUST SUGAR. Roger Bush wrote wood is forecast by a report made recently by Dr. W. H. Ormrod to the Society of Chemical Industry, in England. "Dread accident" is treated in a carefully designed chemical plant with hydrochloric acid," explains Dr. E. Z. Freg. "This treatment converts the substance of the wood into a mixture of sugars, one of which is ordinary glucose, or, more sugar, a material which is perfectly suitable for human food. Not all of the sugar produced by Dr. Ormrod is fit for human food, but all of the sugar produced by it. The by-products of impure sugar to be fermented into alcohol, which will be used for motor fuel, in the opinion of chemists who heard the report, the new process is very likely to prove commercially profitable, but to result in a way to dispose of waste sawdust and other waste wood, as well as in a significant increase of the world's food supply."

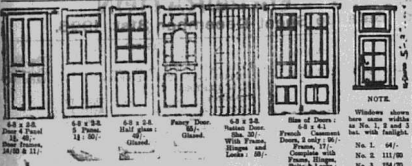

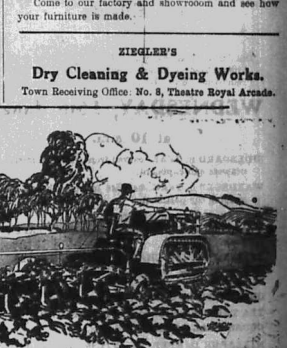

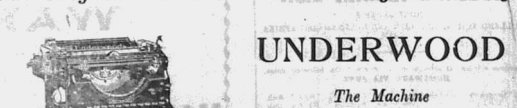

NATIVE AGRICULTURE.

Work of the Training Schools and Farms.

LABOUR SAVING.

Satisfactory Progress in use of Modern Methods.

A further section of the annual report of the Director of Agriculture deals with the progress of native agriculture. The Agricultural Officers of the Department have, during the period under review and under circumstances, aided mainly in an advisory capacity to the Administration, direct contact with native workers being seldom necessary through the organization of the training schools and farms. The effect has been primarily educational, directed through the training farms, and more generally by means of demonstration plots in various localities. Mass sowing of seed have been made, and training in holo preparation has been given. Under the office of Veterinary Services reference is made to cattle inoculations, etc.

The distribution of the seed engaged in Native Agriculture was as follows: Nyanza: Two Agricultural Officers regularly, and one part time, with 16 native instructors. One Stock Inspector (Veterinary), with instructors in holo preparation. Kiambu: Two Agricultural Officers regularly, and one part time, with 18 native instructors. One Agricultural Officer with 10 native instructors. The Agricultural Officers do not leave the greater part of the year, and one post was vacant. At the schools for agricultural training, the average number of pupils was 60 at Kiambu and 50 at the Stock Agricultural Laboratories. During the year 14 pupils who have completed their training have been found employment as native instructors in the reserves.

In addition a considerable number as a Veterinary staff were employed in the reserves. Particular mention will be given under Veterinary.

WEATHER CONDITIONS.

Nyanza: The rainfall was much above the average with but a very slight fall between the long and the short rains. Crops suffered as a consequence and yields have been low. Forer amongst the inhabitants refrained the amount of work done particularly towards the end of the year. These factors have reduced the output of marketable

crops, and in some areas a food shortage may result. Kiambu: Satisfactory rainfall was experienced in March and April. On the whole the conditions were favourable. Coast: With the exception of certain parts of Digo and Kilifi districts the rainfall was sufficient and a fairly good season was experienced. On the whole the year was not above the average and an increased output of native products is not expected.

ISSUE OF SEED.

These were again made in most reserves and an effort was made to induce natives to purchase seed for themselves. As yet, however, natives do not feel inclined to purchase seed for use on their own farms. Local Native Councils have, however, provided funds for the purchase of seed for distribution within their own areas primarily to suggest the Government's contribution.

The surplus of seed produced at Nakuru and the Stock Agricultural Laboratories, together with the production from the demonstration plots was issued free. That these seed issues are making their influence felt in native crops is manifest, though it is realized that in some cases surplus use is made of it and there is some wastage.

IMPLEMENTES.

Progress in the use of labour-saving appliances has been notable particularly in the Nyanza Province, though in other areas the movement has also been started. In Nyanza 67 ploughs, 27 grass mowers and 22 sets of mill stones were procured in 1928 by the more intelligent natives. There are great opportunities for native enterprise to effect large savings in "man power" by providing small ex-carts for the transport of their produce, to rail and market, and some progress along these lines is being made, notably in the Kiambu Province. It is the wish of the Native Councils to organize the service

and thus effect great savings. There is great scope for the owners and portable the implements and transport vehicles. In native reserves, the natives themselves are slow to take advantage of them. Influence exerted in past years through different agencies is beginning to show results, but encouragement is still required, and the natives may have to be persuaded to acquire permanent the use of these implements to his individual effort.

MAIZE.

In order to realize a good type of maize in an extensive area the Government has now selected the main lines of seed of "Flat White" was made in Nairobian. With the advent of the railway through the Kiambu country, in which some maize of this type were made in previous years, a new source of considerable quantities were exported therefrom, but both here and in Kiambu districts, were very poor. On account of the wet season the mature crop was in excess of the limit for export purposes, and with attendant risks of rejection and costs of conditioning buyers offered lower prices to the native producer. An attempt was made to reduce the quantity of maize offered for grading by the proclamation of a rule under "The Crops and Livestock Production Ordinance of 1928" whereby maize from Kiambu could not be transported by rail before the 1st September. It is supposed that the rule was not entirely successful in its object as the "wet" maize was held up at the trading centre, and in consequence a simple matter for the small trader to overcome, the difficulty either by refusing to buy "wet" maize from the native grower, or to expose the grain to the sun for a few days before bringing it up for sale to the Coast.

On the Coast farms were made in the Digo and Kilifi districts, and good yields were reported.

COTTON.

Twenty tons of selected Uganda seed issued from the Gin Ginnery in Central Kavirato. Bags of local seed were made from other ginneries and buying centres. Natives do not take the seed freely and require urging to do so. Unless Administrative Officers consistently point out the utility of the crop and advise natives to plant, they are prone to neglect it. That effort has been made early and continued until the planting season closes. Again at this stage of development it is realized that natives should be encouraged to realize the high yield cotton cheaply and regularly.

COOKING IN GLASS

It is also the advantage over metal, and even earthenware, in that it never loses its innocuous, never discolors, and after years of use, shows no signs of wear. It is also the result of all overtures to keep cooking clean.

Another advantage, in addition to the fact that the transparency enables the actual cooking process to be observed from start to finish, is the fact that foods have been found actually to take better in glassware. Poultry must be browned over, and in the case of most puddings or stews, the liquid is clear, and more tender. A third point in favour of glassware is that food may be baked and served in the same dish. This in this medium retains its heat longer than other materials. ALMOND CREAM FILLING.
1 cup sugar, 1/2 cup corn flour, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1 egg, 2 cups washed milk, 1/2 teaspoon almond extract.
Mix dry ingredients; add slightly beaten egg and stir into thickening the washed milk. Cook about 15 minutes in double boiler, stirring constantly until thickened. Cool slightly and flavor. Sweetened whipped cream may be used instead of this filling.
1 cup water and butter in saucepan until it boils up well, add all at once four sifted with salt and stir vigorously. Remove from fire as soon as mixed, cool, and mix in unbeaten egg, one at a time; add baking powder 1/2 cup well and drop by small spoonfuls 1/2 teacup apart on greased tin; shape into circular form with wet spoon. Bake about 25 minutes in hot oven. Cut with sharp knife near base to admit filling.
