ROOSEVELTIANS THREATEN A BOLT.

(Reuter's Special to "E. A. Standard.")

Chicago, June 29. The closeness of the voting between Taft and Roosevelt and the surprise demonstration of the Convention towards Hadley, Governor of Missouri, caused a leading orator on the reform movement to favour the conjecture that a dark horse may be sprung on the Convention.

The editorial committee proposed by Mr. Watson has elected a Taftite Chairman. Upon this the Rooseveltians declared that if the committee retains the editorial privileges they will hold a Convention of their own inside the Coliseum and that will make two Republican candidates. Immediately they reassembled the Convention adjourned until tomorrow to enable the leaders to discuss the situation.

Roosevelt's Statement.

Appeals to HONEST CITIZENS.

Chicago, June 29. Roosevelt conferred with his partisans this afternoon and read a statement to them. He said that if he was honestly elected and the majority of the Convention nominated him he would accept it. Failing this, however, if a movement was inaugurated to nominate him as a Progressive he would accept. He would fight the campaign through to win or lose appealing to all honest citizens. Any man who supported him would do so without hope of gain and at the risk of his own personal life and discomfit.

It is regarded as doubtful if Roosevelt will secure much support from his followers if he bolts. As an instance the Illinois delegation decided by 50 to 2 votes not to participate in a bolt if there is one.

It is always a complex question in land settlement to adjust the rights of the Crown and the claims of the people.

Another point is that a hard working, uneducated man can put all the necessary improvements on a farm by his own personal labor and a deserving of consideration when he has been a tenant of the Colony for many years as a farmer's assistant or manager.

Whatever mistakes are made in the allotment of land there is one mistake I sincerely hope will not be made and that is to grant land to Dick, Tom and Harry simply because they can put up a certain amount of money irrespective of their qualifications.

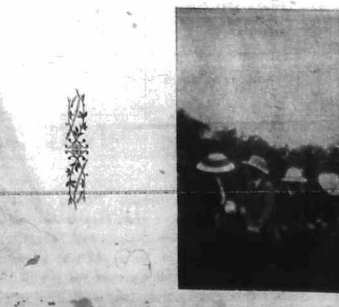

PAWN ENDINGS.

A knowledge of pawn endings is likely to be of greater use to the average player than any of those we have taken already. In fact it is probably the most useful thing to know in chess, because it often enables one to win on a single pawn. Players are apt to underestimate the value of their pawns; when they realize what great things pawns can do greater care will be taken, and so chance of winning a pawn missed, or will they be lightly thrown away unless of course such sacrifice is well justified.

As to the value of a pawn compared with other pieces it is usual to suppose a Knight equal to a Bishop or three pawns, a Rook to 6 pawns, or a Queen to 11. This is however only near the truth at the beginning of the game. The pawns increase in value every time they move, until at the 7th rank a Rook equals a Rook quite often, because a Rook has frequently to be sacrificed for it to prevent it being "queened." Pawns therefore, like Rooks and Bishops, are more valuable towards the end of the game. Knights are usually less valuable because they can be more effectively used in a crowded position. Freese valuation of the pawns is impossible, much depends on the particular player's ability to make better use of the King than the R, or vice versa. In this way, pawns are more valuable than we are accustomed to think, and especially in the end game as we shall soon see.

In the vast majority of well composed games a single pawn decides the winner. The result depending on the Opposition, or final confrontation of the opposing Kings.

In one class of position Kings occurring in every-day actual play, the player who queen independently, the adverse King being unable to attack and capture it on its march to the 7th rank. In the other class of position, even more frequently occurring, the Pawn must be captured, or covered, by its own King in order to escape the enemy and pass on to the 7th rank successfully.

In the first case, which we will now discuss, the question whether or not the Pawn can be queen in one of simple calculation. Place the Kings, White on Q5, Black on Q6, and the White Pawn on E4. Now the question of White's being able to queen depends entirely on whose turn it is to move.

With White to play, the P can go straight on to the 7th rank and Black cannot prevent it. If it takes 4 moves to reach E7 when the P will be at E7, moving on to E8 at the 5th move becoming a Q and Black is helpless.

But if Black moves first he will be at E8 when the P arrives at E7, and being Black's turn moves E-K10 and takes the P next move whether it queen or not. A simple rule for this kind of position is to draw an imaginary square just including the P in question and the 6th rank. If the adverse K is already within this square, or can get into it next move, then the P will be taken. Otherwise it will succeed in getting through safely.

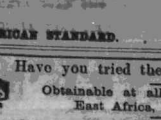

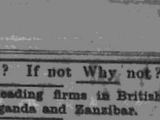
