INCLUSION OF SUBURBS.

Reasons for Proposed Alteration in Representation.

Part of the report of the Local Government Commission which commenced its sittings at Nairobi on the 25th inst., deals with the future municipal area and control of the future city. The report recommends an extension of the municipality to include the outlying residential suburbs.

The composition of the New Council as proposed by the Commission is as follows:—1 elected European, 5 elected Indians, 1 nominated Indian, 1 Government representative, 1 Railway representative, 1 representative of the district council. It is suggested that he sit up for the rural area at Nairobi.

Economy & Efficiency.

One of the first parts of the Commission's report which deals with the inclusion of the suburbs into the municipal area, is the recommendation that the population of Nairobi should be increased to 100,000. It is possible and Judges contribute very definitely to the knowledge of the agricultural industry if they will discharge their duties conscientiously. They are all practical men with wide local knowledge and it is only right that their knowledge should be made available to the Territories. There is one other point in past Shows judging has suffered somewhat from the fact that exhibitors manifesting the various exhibits have some idea of some of the things which the Judges before judging was completed. That is against the spirit of the show as the exhibitors will be both Judges and exhibitors will be glad to see removed any unworthy cause of suspicion by maintaining observance by stewards of the instructions in this connection. Given these two desirable conditions—early reports upon judging experience and careful elimination of the show to identify of exhibitors—the result should be most valuable to the Territories. Transfer of Goods between Kenya Uganda and Tanganyika Territory.

In accordance with the Agreement reached between the Governments of Kenya, Uganda and Tanganyika Territory under Section 203 of the Customs Management Ordinance 1920 governing the Customs control of goods transferred between the territories, the following procedure in application of Regulation 118 published in Supplement II of the Gazette of Kenya of 11.6.1920 is adopted as from 1st August, 1920—

(a) Goods in Transit. A written copy of the relative Customs Entry and Receipts issued by the respective authorities at the time of engagement, the goods being produced in the proper office of Customs at the place of final exportation from Kenya and Uganda.

(b) Goods Under Bond. A certified copy of the Customs Removal Entry made by the respective authorities at the time of engagement, the relative Way Bill being endorsed by the Customs Officer in Charge at the place of arrival as authority for delivery of the goods. In the case of bonded goods removed by sea no alteration in existing procedure will be made.

(c) Imported Goods Duty Paid and Free. Subject to the provisions of the Customs Tariff Ordinance 1927 goods imported and duty paid in Kenya, Uganda or Tanganyika Territory and subsequently exported to another of these territories will be admitted into the consuming territory without additional payment of duty provided that the following conditions are complied with—

(i) By Rail. Forms "A" and "B" must be fully completed by the former being handed to the respective authorities at the time of engagement and the latter forwarded to the consignee for presentation to the Railway authorities at the place of arrival of the goods. The forms should be endorsed with the number of the relevant Railway Consignment Note.

(ii) By Sea. Form A in Triplicate and Advice B to be produced at the Customs Office at the place of export entries hitherto received. Advice B certificate to be submitted to the Customs Department at the Port of destination in duplicate for the consignee as the warrant for the free admission of goods into the consuming territory.

(iii) By Post. Form E to be completed and handed to the Postal authorities at the time of posting.

(iv) By Road. Form A to be completed by the consignee and sent direct to the Commissioner of Customs, Mombasa. Advice B to accompany the goods good production when required and subsequent despatch to the Principal Officer of Customs at the receiving territory.

(v) In regard to transfers of goods between Kenya or Uganda and Tanganyika Territory forms A, C and E must be submitted in duplicate to the Principal Officer. The above regulations are framed with the following objects in view—

(a) the avoidance of double payment of duty on imported goods passing between the territories;

(b) the proper allocation of Customs Revenue to the consuming territory; and

(c) the compilation of adequate statistics of the trans-territory trade of the territories.

Attention is therefore directed to the necessity for accurate declaration and the penalty which may be incurred in the event of non-compliance with the Regulations.
Copies of forms A, B, C and D will be made available at the Railway dispatching Stations and copies of Form E at all Post Offices. Supplies of forms can be obtained on application at any Customs Office.
