In Salts Performance.

ALL PREVIOUS STROKE CAR RECORDS BROKEN.

On June 20 a La Salle car, the new eight cylinder product of the Cadillac Motor Company, was put through one of the most severe tests to which any stock car has ever been subjected. The test took place on the new high speed track at the Usambani proving ground. An ordinary stock La Salle car was used, the only thing being done to prepare it for its test was to remove the mudguards. Starting at the usual speed, the car was run for an hour, the speed being gradually increased to 100 m.p.h. in the morning. The car was run for a total of 100 miles per hour, throughout the entire day, the car was kept on the course—the only stops made were to take on fuel and replace the tires, the trials of which achieved considerably from the average speed and fuel economy. At the close of the day the test was concluded, the car having covered 921 miles at an average speed of 56.2 miles per hour.

This performance has never been achieved by any other standard car before. It stands as evidence of correct design, quality of material and durable, a standard which is to be compared with the famous Indianapolis Race. The Indianapolis race, which is run over a distance of 200 miles was during the past year at an average speed of 62 miles per hour. The cars competing in the Indianapolis race are equipped with supercharged racing gas, built and designed primarily for speed. The La Salle car, which was a standard model in every way, ran 75 miles double the distance of the Indianapolis race at a higher rate of speed.

E. F. Byron.



THE SPARKING PLUG

Tracing the Causes of Poor Performance.

THE REMEDY.

Ignition of the mixture of petrol vapour and air inside each cylinder of a petrol engine is caused in the correct manner by an electric spark. The magnet supplies the high pressure current through the plug and so it is to be expected that the electric current through the metal walls of the cylinder and which the current can jump.

A sparking plug acts as a wire in an enclosure, namely the cylinder. The plug must in addition seal up the hole in the engine into which it screws so that some of the highly compressed gas inside the cylinder can pass through the plug.

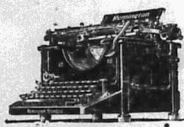

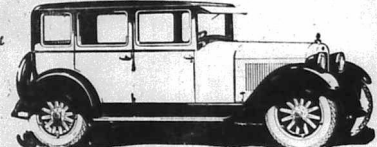
