WORKERS OF THE SKIES.

Plan for All-steel Airplane. SECRET DESIGNS.

Royal Air Force authorities are again actively contemplating the use of all-steel wood and fabric air services. The design of the wings of the Skopie aeroplane is all-steel in make-over.

War will then involve a real terror, with striking machines flying through, beyond being shot down by machine guns.

It is easy to visualize the features of these all-steel machines. In fact, all-steel machines are being made and the specially treated aluminium containing an alloy of magnesium, aluminium, and other elements, making the alloys in present.

Mass Production. Recent experiments have been conducted for many years. Most of them are already in use by certain companies of the U.S.A. For example, certain commercial firms make a service with an all-steel aeroplane.

The British firm is laying down a plan for the mass production of all-steel fighting airplanes. No more of the kind of machinery of the type of the Skopie, or the design of the machine to be built are to be discussed here.

No attempt will be made to equip all-steel airplanes with armour plate on account of weight. A greater protection naturally comes from the present wood and fabric construction. The chief reason for this is that:

### Outing the Pastorist.

The Melbourne *Age*, in a recent issue, commented the folly of the American Labor Party's advocacy of the compulsory separation of the industrial and the large estates on which alone the unions could be grown. The 20th of meeting the pastorist from the areas in which material was given in order to subsidize the comparatively desultory business of wheat or fruit growing or dairy farming is obtained by a glance at statistics of production, "remains the parcel."

## POULTRY NOTES.

### The World's Poultry Congress at Ottawa.

The World's Poultry Congress was held at Ottawa from July 27 to August 4.

Very few details of this Congress are to hand at present. It is the Prince of Wales' second visit to the British Empire on August 11, also the Prime Minister, Mr. Mackenzie King, and spoke at one of the meetings.

### STICKING FEARS.

Having replied to a letter from a correspondent dealing with the sticking feet, I was looking up my information. I had on the subject. I came across an article by Mr. A. Hesse. This article must be a good few years old as it is in an old book of "cuttings" on Poultry matters. He heads it: "A New Poultry Feet." "Found in West Australia, not yet known in the East." "It was first seen in England."  
 He states that during his short stay in Western Australia he came in contact with a new pest—the Sticking Feet—*Pin-Headphaga*

(pellucida). He describes it as a small flat-sided, hard-bodied, almost black insect, very similar to the small ticks which affect English chickens, which they are from a week to ten days of age.

In view the Sticking Feet was about the size of the common household flea, or those which often infest the hair of man. (Mr. Hesse says that a mite might be compared with the sticking feet).

An illustration is given of a mite (the head) which with these feet and they appear to be exactly similar to our variety. Mr. Hesse states that the flea attaches itself to those parts of the feet which are devoid of feathers, and says he has seen birds in which the comb, toe lobes, and wattle were literally covered, the birds being like the stars for multitudes, and uncomfortable and half blinded in the skin of the bird. He continues by saying that small though the sticking feet is, it is in fact the power of killing any bird it attacks. Its head is provided with strong pincers, points which enable it to cut the skin and burrow the head underneath, and suck the very life blood of its victim. The body affected goes blind and die of weakness, due to the flea sucking the blood, and also to the fact that birds when badly affected cannot find their food and die of starvation.

He states that during his short stay in Western Australia he came in contact with a new pest—the Sticking Feet—*Pin-Headphaga*

which gives immediate attention and constant treatment from the moment when the pest is discovered, as they become excessive, have thick and gradually sink away, whilst laying their produce few eggs, and these few very irritable.

Mr. Hesse says that a preliminary test is that the flea found on birds are all females, the males are found in and about the houses, whilst the larvae or maggot stage of the insect, another which may be about in the vicinity.

In the Perth Zoological Gardens the pest had spread with alarming rapidity notwithstanding all that had been done to exterminate it. It had affected not only the birds but the animals as well and some of the kangaroos and wallabies had died.

The Director of the Zoological Gardens found that fleas did not bite water or earth, and that the sprinkling and syringing of houses and pens with a solution of common salt in the proportion of 1 lb. of salt to a gallon of water had resulted in the eradication of the flea, whereas as it prevented the development of the larvae. This is a most effective and efficient part was the most effective treatment.

There was much speculation as to the origin of the pest, but the generally accepted conclusion was that it had come from the Black It is a great public nuisance.

poultry breeders as it had been found to be carried by rats, mice and other vermin, and that birds picked it up from the ground over which they walked or birds had trampled.

Mr. Hesse goes on to warn English breeders against importing birds from infected areas.



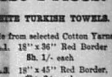

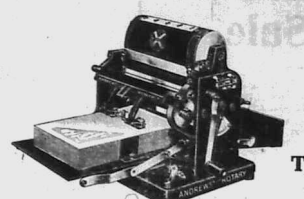
