S.S. "RUSINGA" DESTROYED BY FIRE AT MUSOMA.

Graphic Story by Eye-witness of Wharf Side Catastrophe.

56,000 PACKAGE OF DIAMONDS LOST.

Sudden Burst of Flame Fed by 40 Tons of Fuel Oil.

The S.S. "Rusinga" one of the largest passenger and cargo boats on Lake Victoria is practically a total wreck as a result of a disastrous fire which broke out in the engine room of the vessel on Friday afternoon.

The blaze started with dramatic suddenness and in an incredible short space of time the whole vessel was involved to such an extent that any hope of its salvage was seen to be out of the question.

All that remains now of a well appointed ship is a melancholy looking mass of charred wood and twisted iron protruding level with the waters of the Lake in which it is anchored at a short distance from the shore. The whole of the cargo and the mails, which included a package of diamonds valued at South Africa, have been swallowed up in the inferno, together with much of the personal luggage belonging to passengers.

Graphic accounts of the catastrophe were related to the "Standard" by eye-witnesses, one of whom left by car and travelled for a day and two nights without resting in order to convey the news to the headquarters of the Railway Administration at Nairobi and to acquaint the Marine Service Officials at Kisumu by telegraph.

Thrilling Himalayan Record Was Albert Meade.

Rugby, October 1. The story of a British Officer's heroism on the icy slopes of the Himalayas is recounted in the Official London Gazette.

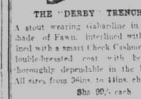

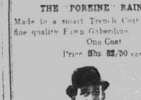

MOTOR TOPICS

BODY DESIGNING.

Tendency for Outside Appearance.

INTERNAL COMFORT MORE IMPORTANT.

The average modern designer, or, to be more correct, body-builder's obligation, generally starts by laying out a pleasing external outline for the car and some points like wheel outward effect before giving thought to the actual position of drivers and passengers. He knows the latter at best he may in the beautiful shell which he has constructed.

Is not this rather putting the cart before the horse?

We Do Not See Outside.

If only we, as we are passing along a road, a motorist never sees lined at the wheel. Why, then, should we wish to travel in a vehicle possessing a great amount of line and colour which he himself scarcely ever beholds? Why should not comfortable surroundings of driver and passenger be the least and easiest of body design?

One of two examples of outside work have made their appearance on the Continent which have shaken our conventional British inside. We have strictly refused to ride in automobiles which resemble the locomotive or an underground railway, and all because we are used to the conventional type of motorwork, which, when all is said and done, is merely developed from the obsolete horse-drawn carriage.

But if we had, in the first instance, been left blindfold to the car and the landscape only returned from our eyes after we had settled ourselves within, we should probably have been revolted against the revolutionary external appearance of the vehicle.

Seeing the great thing is to sit comfortably in a way to feel snug and stable and steady, with high back and padding over our feet and legs and a cushioned seat without any dangerous kind of spring.

It might be found very desirable to construct a truly comfortable

interior layout with the clean contours so much in vogue, but the details from the point of view of these inside the car would be well worth it.

Chassisless Rear Seats.

Are not our cars designed inside out? They must be, or we would not find those uncomfortable road seats in which the occupants lie, as if the shoulder straps with seat-rope for their limbs and their feet almost, on the same level as the seat. If we were rational people we would require a completely rearranged and so surroundings, and we would try to incorporate this without modification in the design of the automobile.

Men have been making arrangements for comfort, and they consequently, they know something about it. The experienced body-builder would take a man's ability to sit for long periods and would build a body around him without his any way disturbing him. Then he could be quite certain that from the point of view of comfort, the coachwork could not be improved, although admittedly he might suffer something of a shock when he came to inspect the outside appearance of his masterpiece.

Why Outside—Rummy Seats.

Why are some of those ugly, square-backed Georgian houses in an old London square we may see last night impressed with the architectural ability of our ancestors, but when we pass through the massive portico we realize how charmingly rooms and spaces are the rooms inside.

We find that post-war motor cars, fifty, sixty and well in. We realize that the same car might be perfectly designed—i.e. they were constructed on a principle of fit and not to look at from the outside.

An eminent engineer of the writer's acquaintance once held a lecture on equipment with his subject on the subject of windows. The architect was for getting in antique leaded windows or panes with pieces of coloured lead-glass here and there.

Admittedly, the appearance from the outside would have been charming, but the engineer said: "I recall all, what I depend on now is the house that inside it. I want to know what I am doing. I want plenty of daylight. Give me plain glass."

So, great always for a coach-builder to adopt would be: "We design our bodies from the inside."

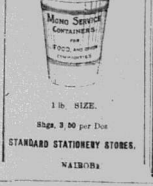

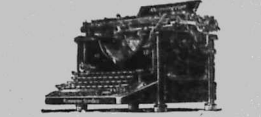

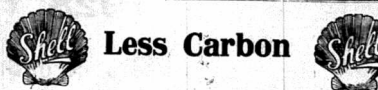

Watson, what principle should govern the attitude of British people towards the Anglo-Indian community. To answer that he must first give something to the way of statistics.

The British community in India was very much smaller than the European community in South Africa. The total number of Europeans in India was only 120,000, and the Anglo-Indian population was nothing like so numerous as the coloured people in South Africa. Anglo-Indians, however, was the term given to people of mixed descent though it had to be borne in mind that they were not only of mixed English and Indian descent, but that many of them also had Portuguese and Dutch blood.

Accept Responsibility.

In answer to the question, "Accept responsibility for their actions," the Anglo-Indian population must first recognize in the policy of the East India Company which encouraged soldiers to save India, to give their own people a provision of aid for every child born.

Thus, the British were responsible for the existence of the Anglo-Indian community in that while the Dutch always took the attitude that intermarriage was perfectly legitimate and desirable.

And if they were responsible for the Anglo-Indians having come into the continent under which they lived, then it is the responsibility of the Anglo-Indians to take the initiative in the present.
