ZANZIBAR MEETS ITS FINANCIAL DIFFICULTIES.

Customs Import Duties Raised from 10 per cent. to 15 per cent.

HELP FOR CLOVE GROWERS.

Further Taxation in the Form of Stamp Duties Revenue.

An unusually important address was delivered to the Legislative Council of Zanzibar a week ago by the British Resident in opening the second session.

To meet the difficult financial position broaden the duty producer, it has been decided to increase the import duties of Zanzibar from 10 per cent. to 15 per cent.

Another measure of taxation has been introduced in the form of Stamp duties.

The 1926 Budget shows a deficit of £110,000 which will be met by drawing on the surplus balances to that amount, leaving £300,000 in hand.

The accounts of the Protectorate will now be calculated at 1/8d. to the Rupee instead of 1/10d.

The 1927 Budget is said to be sacrificed and the other major recommendations of the Retrenchment Committee have been rejected by the British Railway.

BUBUBU RAILWAY REVERIED.

In the course of his address at the opening of the Council Session the British Resident, Sir Claude Hignett, announced important steps, including the revision of the Customs duties, to meet the present financial situation.

MOTURING TOPICS

BRAKING EFFICIENCY.

Of Vital Importance When Driving.

HOW TO MAINTAIN IT.

The vital importance of efficient braking will be appreciated by all who drive with "safety first" in mind. It will be unfortunate, therefore, to consider how the brakes of a car can be maintained in proper working order, says *Light Car and Cycle*.

The friction material of nearly all modern car brakes consists of woven asbestos fabric, which is practically unaffected by heat and which possesses extremely good wearing properties. The material is riveted to the brake shoe which in many cases is made of cast-iron to ensure rapid dissipation of the heat generated in braking, and as a rule, the shoes are riveted to the frame or levers connected to the hand or foot mechanism.

To obtain a smooth braking action it is necessary that the surface of the drums on which the friction material rests shall be perfectly smooth and uncorroded. Roughness in the drums gives rise to judder, whilst, if the drums become distorted from a faulty circlip shape, the braking action will be irregular—in fact there may be a tendency for the wheels to lock during part of their revolution.

Correct Fitting of the Fabric.

There are a number of important considerations with regard to the correct fitting of the fabric on the shoes. As a rule, if a drum is counter-sunk brake, and it is to be fitted with the fabric, the rivets below the surface should not extend very much further than the steel of the drum frame and therefore form some groove in the steel. The rivets must give rise to a "good" rivet, not give rise to brake squeak.

Fabric fitting is not very easy

described to work unless proper methods are adopted. A fine-toothed hand saw should be used to cut the material and the rivet holes can be drilled with an ordinary twist drill. Considerable care should be taken when fitting a surplus's brake, but special consideration here they are driven directly through the plate hole by means of a steel drift or punch.

If however, the hole is near the edge of the fabric, consideration is advisable as, otherwise, the material may be twisted or even split. It is a good plan to wear the fabric before driving, so that there comes more plastic and conform readily to the curvature of the shoe.

Oil Deposit.

The rivets must be checked regularly, and it is advisable to level the leading and trailing ends of the fabric. If the only one left which has a tendency to become loose is the one in the rear, there is a possibility also that they will wear against the drums when the brakes are in the "off" position.

Brake Adjustment.

In the course of time the friction material will wear and it will be necessary to adjust the leading. Unless there is the compensation master adjusting lock, adjustment should be made by adjusting the front and each of the trailing ends separately. Commencing first with the hand brake, which probably will act on the back shafts only, the adjusters should be screwed up until the brake shoes begin to effect when the lever is about one-third of the way across the drum.

In this position each wheel is then should be rotated by hand and there should be an equal amount of resistance in both. If not, the adjuster of the wheel which is easiest to rotate should be given another turn and a fresh trial made. If the leading is fitted with compensated control, the resistance of such should be equal but care must be taken to the position of such should be adjusted to the two links.

Having checked the hand brake, then be undertaken. To do this, the front wheels should be pointed straight ahead and the hand crank should be worked down until the brakes just begin to take effect. Working the pedal down much more effective than taking in excess to adjust the brake, because by eliminating the human element there is no risk of variation in the pedal pressure, whilst the adjustments made.

Leaving-in.

It is a good plan in this connection to tap each drum freely with

a hammer and listen to the ring. If this is not like that of a steel drum, but like that of the shoes over close of the drum, but only a steel drum, it is an almost certain indication that the shoes are too tight.

When the adjustment has been completed, it is found that the opening lever on the brake shoe springs will force of vertical position, there is a chance that the friction brake has been taken, so that the car has to be driven two shoes very wide before they can take effect. In this case, if it is discovered that the friction material, it is possible as a rule to fit plates to the cam faces of the shoes.

This will allow the cam to occupy a normal position and will bring the lever back to its normal effective operating position. It will be understood that in the case of front-wheel brakes, the lever in its proper operating position should be forward or vertical.

Accurate adjustment of the brakes is necessary, not only for pulling up the car quickly, but also for the avoidance of skidding. One wheel locked whilst the others are free to revolve, may possibly retarding effect the result of skidding, as well as a minimum.

In the ordinary way braking efficiency is not very high, and it is important, not only to see that all four wheels are under the same pressure, but also to see that the pressure is working on the other, possibly by applying the brakes and that it is possible to load—may prevent the skidding effect of the "off" position returning to the "off" position when the pedal or lever is released.

The stranded wire cables used to operate the brakes on motor cars require rather special attention at intervals, if necessary to prevent the formation of rust on the wires. Pushing them with boiled kerosene time to time will be found very effective in this connection.

It is a proved fact, however, that wire brakes are not so generally reliable (because of the quality of the steel of which they are made) but also to the same extent in their production.

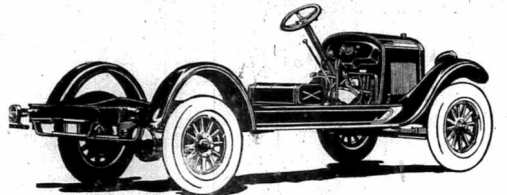

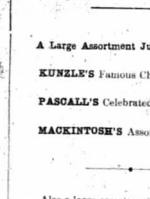

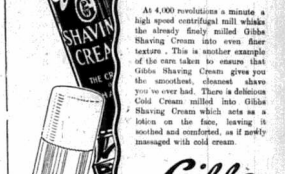

Books of short stories are especially good for the spare room, since they do not impose upon the guest the necessity for leaving a novel half finished. Only the very strongest volumes will voluntarily encourage the borrowing of her volumes, so all the libraries should be as short as possible. And if you want a cheerful guest let the literature be well represented!

SOOTH SHORTERD.

Everyone likes Scotch Shortbread and yet few are able to make a success of the home-made variety. I had similar trouble until one day I had the good fortune to obtain the perfect recipe. If stored in an airtight tin, the shortbread will keep for a considerable time and never lose its crispness and freshness.

Beat 4 ozs. of butter and 2 ozs. of sugar to a cream and add 4 ozs. of flour a handful at a time. Mix carefully and slowly together and when all the flour is added and almost mixed in, turn on to a hard upper mill together with your hands, which should be perfectly dry.

Now make the mixture into a round about 3" in diameter, and cut into rounds about 3/8" thick. Place the rounds on a baking tin and bake in a slow oven for 15 minutes taking care that they do not burn.

A "PARTY" SWEET.

Strawberry Cup.

Make up a pint of strawberry jelly according to the directions on the packet. Allow to set overnight in a quart basin. Mix half a pint of custard and allow that also to set overnight. The following day, beat the jelly well with your silver fork. Add a quarter of a pint of thick whipped cream, and keep on beating well in it all frantically.

Now you can begin to fill the custard-cups, one for each person. First put in a layer of strawberry jelly and whipped cream; then a layer of custard, and next a layer of banana, scraped to a pulp with a silver knife and free of those little black seeds at the core. Now more strawberry jelly with whip cream—or strawberry cream, as it has become through the beating—more custard, and again banana, with the custard-cups full of the alternate layers. The whipped cream on top, and a sprinkle of chopped pistachio nuts in the centre. Strawberry cup is a sweet that is always remembered!

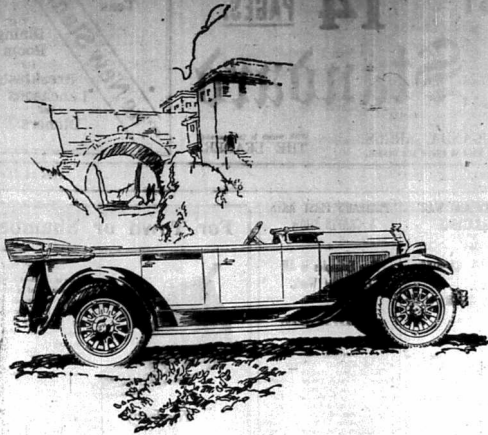

MOTURING TOPICS

ROADS REPAIR

Occasional Trouble and Remedies.

"FIRST AID" WORK

In a country where touring involves the motorist in travelling of considerable distances from large and service stations, it is desirable that the driver should have a reasonable knowledge of "first-aid" repair work. That motorist who is so equipped, and who is not afraid to use his knowledge, is not only a credit to himself, but also a credit to his country. Believable as the modern car is, however, occasional troubles do arise, and these few suggestions may therefore be of use, particularly to those motorists who, like the writer, are faced to see their cars well after the first bloom of youth.

Self-Starters Failing.

A trouble which is still fairly prevalent, even in the latest models, is the sudden apparent failure of the self-starter. When this fault is placed on the starter pedal, nothing but a slight click is heard. Subsequent attempts, windings with the starting handle indicate that the engine is apparently stopped into one solid mass.

This is nothing more serious than a jammed starter piston. Usually this can be freed by the simple process of engaging top gear, releasing the hand-brake, and turning the car backwards and forwards until the piston frees itself.

Car should be taken that the engine switch is not accidentally left in the "on" position during this process, otherwise the car may possibly decide to go further than was intended! Should this expedient not be sufficient to free the piston, it may be necessary to use more drastic steps.

Any convenient road, such as a main road, should be used for the purpose of the repair. The road should be closed to traffic for a short time, and the motorist should be warned of the danger. Lacked Road Works

Another type of job at the "motorist" which is even more surprising to think in which the rear wheels become locked dead, and the whole car immobilized. This, it is only fair to say, is not a very frequent occurrence, and as a rule only happens to cars in which the question is considerably more. It is caused by worn steering knuckles and a loose or worn ball joint on the rear lever. The result of this is that two gears act partly into mesh together.

The motorist is a fairly tough-built component, and it is rare that this motor-failure causes any serious damage. To clear the jam, however, it is necessary to remove the front-ends and also the top of the gearbox, complete with the gear lever. The axle rods will now be exposed, and by inserting the end of a tyre lever (inserted by a very useful tool in more ways than one) into the notch on the axle rod in which the end of the gear lever usually fits, a shove from the tyre lever will move the rod to the mid-gear position. The neutral position is usually that where these notches are in line, or in the centre of their particular path of travel.

Lighting Failures.

Trouble with the lighting system, whether severe, which may break the motorist, though all things considered, modern safety lamps are usually of a type which is not likely to cause any serious trouble. A sudden complete failure of all lights is usually due to a short in one of the leads from the battery, or possibly one of the connections to the battery may have come loose.

Failure of the head or side light assembly is either due to a blown fuse, or a short in the smaller leads. In such cases, the motorist should know the old tip of using "silver paper" as a line in the event of an orthodox spare not being available. A short in some of the thin wires used in the head or side light assembly is usually difficult to locate, but when discovered can be dealt with temporarily with a heavy binding insulation tape.

The Oiling System.

Oil failures are apt to be somewhat terrifying as the motorist immediately requires up visions of a seized piston, scored cylinder, and consequent repair bills. A sudden failure never always indicates a break in a pipe or valve, or possibly in the case of oil pump, a defective spring, a break in the latter. Clicked fillers, defective gauges, or shortage of oil usually show themselves by erratic pressure on the indicator.

A broken or unseated petrol pipe can usually be repaired by means of a piece of soap and our old trusty sandpaper, although the most expeditious repair in this direction that the writer has heard of is the case of the motorist who pinned up the two broken ends of a petrol pipe by boring a small diameter hole through a piston purchased from an adjacent field, and then inserting the ends of the pipe into the piston, which connected the two. And, though the leakage of petrol was considerable, it was claimed that the car was driven a distance of miles with the petrol repair (Sambago).

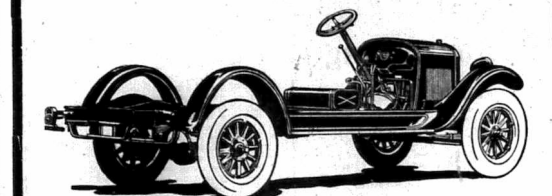

The Smallholder.

The settlement schemes which are under consideration by the Government of Kenya, following upon proposals drawn up by the Kenya Advisory Committee, include provision for the smallholders of whom special provision will be drawn from local and overseas applicants. These smallholders, who will be to cultivate and purposes by persons with little more capital than sufficient to land them on their farms, will be allocated areas of one hundred acres or less. They may also receive, in addition to the lands of Kenya sections, in some type of settlement, the most interesting and important feature in the proposed scheme for increasing the European population of the Colony. The number of smallholders included in the first allocation of land will be very small, and there will be a large number of applicants, of varying types with very diverse interests. The key to the situation lies in the personal element, no far as has been possible, every applicant has been taken to provide for success on paper but, in the case of the smallholder, the Commissioner of Land has pointed out, farming is not an unprofitable business and on this matter, as in every other new Colony, as in fact, every hope and success or failure will be the more immediate. While the scheme as a whole must be considered and administered with the greatest care, success will be the part of the scheme in the personal element. That problem is to be discussed in the solution of the difficulties in the hands of those who will apply locally than among smallholders in British India both because the schemes cannot be handled until general laws are established, the proposals from every point of view. The Colony is attempting a great responsibility in the introduction of the smallholder. If he is to succeed in making a success of his smallholdings, he must be the pioneer type for the first two or three years of his residence in the country. Since the war that type has not come to the Colony. Hence the students and farmers of capital to land them, will over their difficulties and the smallholder will only be considered in the first settlers who possessed Kenya dependent entirely on their own resources and forced by their conditions to acquire land or separate farming as a means of livelihood. But the smallholder will be open to very special temptations in the early life of the country. It is significant that his name in the Colony will not be that of some of his countrymen, but that of some of the hard work and perseverance. It is not a type which will be leading to a productive life. These temptations will continue to surround him, but the smallholder himself is not the only factor in success or failure under conditions so trying to personal worth. They will be, in some ways, more difficult for the wives of those smallholders. We want the women in the Colony because their influence in the making of home will be vital but to them the struggle for success will present many more phases than it does to the man. Yet their influence can be one of the determining factors. The effect of an influx of smallholders on the life of the

Colony is almost too great to be visualized. Their outlook will be different from the present settlement, they will present their own problems in education of children, and they will constantly have to strive to establish a standard of life which is better and which he must not believe that which he maintained in different circumstances at home. The implications will share in that responsibility and those who attempt to reduce the new pioneer from his task of development and home making for the temporary pleasures of a social life beyond his means, will perform a real disservice to the general community. We have no doubt of the ultimate success of the smallholder and it should be recognized now that his success will depend very considerably on the future policy and trend of land settlement, and cultivation, and after the perspective of the Colony. The change is inevitable because close settlement cannot be much longer maintained. The implications of that change should be strived and realized but there should be every effort to create out of the smallholder not a type who is a standard of living is definitely and permanently lower than the general standard of the Colony, but a body of independent young farmers, home-makers of the best type, resident farmers, hard working and practical, whose presence will be a real asset to the Colony. Much of the success or failure of that aim rests with the man himself and with the attitude of selection but the responsibility in that aim rests with the man himself, a small measure shared by the Colony as a whole.

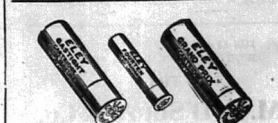
