In reply to a series of questions, the Nairobi Municipal Engineer has thrown some light on the water supply of the Capital.

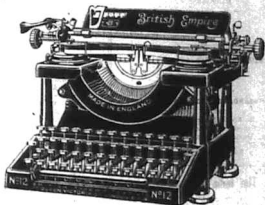

THE NEED FOR POWER

The motor is the typical one of today and the future cannot be predicted by every-
one's dream, nor is it a
chance and keeps a steadily
where it stands. Its interior design is
