A Curious Point of Law.
FINDING IN INSURANCE CLAIM.

Judgment for £1,837 and costs was given in the King's Bench Division against an insurance company in favour of a motorist, who had been deprived of his car after a fatal accident, says a correspondent to a South African paper. The company had declined to indemnify plaintiff because, after all, he was drunk at the time of the accident. Mr. Justice Roche held that plaintiff's drunkenness was the result of folly, not exhilaration. He said that the fact that plaintiff was unable to pay £1,000 damages awarded against him unless the insurance company indemnified him, was not a negligible consideration. He was granted in view of an appeal.

Douglas Factory Fire.
DAMAGE ESTIMATED AT £20,000.

Ten large sawmilling and finishing shops at the Douglas Motor Works, at Kingswood, Bristol, have been transformed into a ruin of charred walls and twisted girders by fire, estimated to have caused £20,000 damage, wires. Referred to the South African papers on March 26. Four thousand completed machines in the underground department were destroyed. Over a thousand employees were at work when the alarm was given. During the ensuing two hours more machines and much machinery were rushed out of the workshops and littered the roads and fields. The roaring of the flames was varied by explosion, signalling the blowing up of the remaining stores. Three casualties were caused by the falling debris. Many hundreds have been temporarily thrown out of employment.

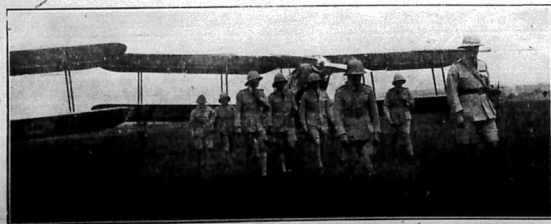

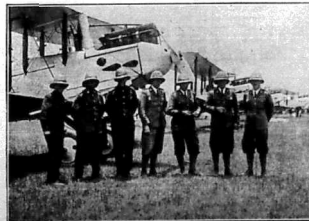

NATIVE PATHS THROUGH EUROPEAN FARMS.

In the Supreme Court on Monday a decision was given in an appeal by the natives of the East African Colonies for the acquisition of rights of way. The appeal was brought by Mr. H. Schwatzen, half-brother of Captain H. Walker. It arose out of a proclamation at Tanka when the appellants were granted a right of way through his farm which was used by natives. The point in the case was whether the road or path that was used was a right of way. The Magistrate held that it was, but the Government would not support the Magistrate's opinion.

Mr. Schwatzen said that he used the two paths, first that by the Crown Lands Ordinance 1913, and second that by the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance 1913. The right of way can be established against the Crown. The land was alienated by the Crown 1900, and under the Installment Act an agreement could not be acquired before the land had been used for a period of twenty years. That time had not yet expired. 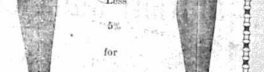

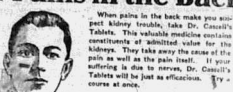
