With the two at present in charge of the Colonial Office—namely, Mr. Amery, Mr. Ormsby-Gore, and Sir Samuel Wilson—candidates of this type are those who will receive justice and fair play, and under present conditions I would have no hesitation in advising any university graduate to enter the Colonial Service, where the work is most interesting, the prospects of promotion good, remuneration liberal, and at the same time, so long as the system of promotion exists there is always the danger of some future of constancy and an expansion. It is manifestly impossible to bind any of the applicants to any agreement which is not enforceable by law, and no lack of ambition, remain outside the scope but the fact is hoped that the Government of (any) may be sufficient. However, it is probable to enter the Colonial Service and Italy to subscribe to it as a logical outcome of the Washington Treaty. 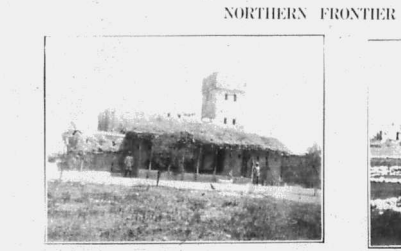

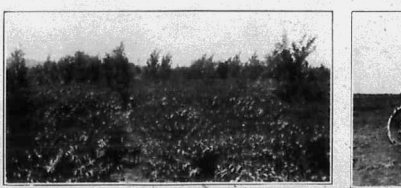
