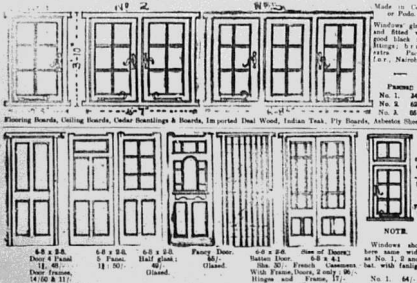

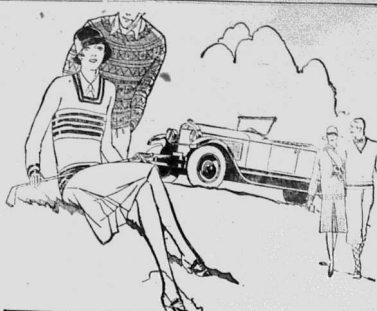

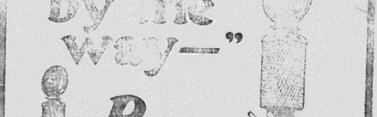

THE FOREST WEALTH OF KENYA.

Probably the Lowest Percentage of Any Timber Countries.

THE LIMIT OF SAFETY REACHED.

The 1926 Report of the Kenya Forest Department shows record progress in exploitation, afforestation and re-afforestation and in many respects the year is regarded as the most satisfactory in the history of the Colony.

The general lack of rain emphasized with the exception of the Central Province and the application of the Government's water conservation scheme.

The Annual Report of the Forest Department for Kenya for 1926 has been received, and opens by stating that "The year has been a notable one, and in every respect the most successful in the history of the Department."

For the first time in its normal history the revenue account of the Department had only one debit item, and that was for the purchase of land in 1910 and 1919 when through neglect in afforestation the water expenditure on re-afforestation was very protection, etc. was greatly exceeded, though it was counteracted by military expenditures.

At the close of the year the percentage above allotted to be cut was not only exceeded but exceeded by 45 per cent. Value of Systematic and Trained Research.

Very naturally, the Council of the Empire Cotton Growing Corporation refer in the report submitted to the annual meeting to the fall in the price of the commodity and the probable results of the fall on the market season's supply and output. 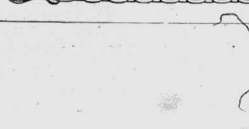

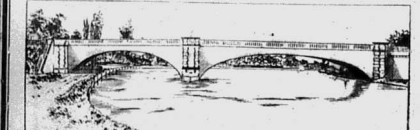

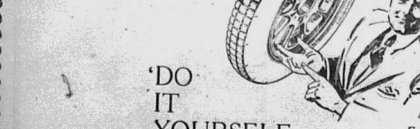
