THE CHEESE-PARING POLICY OF THE UNIMAGINATIVE.

Naturally, the efficient discharge of the functions of a Publicity Office depends not only on the staff and the policy which is being followed but upon the financial equipment of the undertaking.

As has already been pointed out no financial statement accompanies any of the published reports of the East African Office in London.

It should be pointed out that the apparent decrease in the Tanganyika and Nyasaland contributions in 1922 is merely due to the fact that as for its financial year 1922 the Tanganyika and Nyasaland contributions for the month of September are not yet available.

Income. The East African Standard is, however, able to provide an

approximate figure of the expenditures on this important Department. They have been obtained with some accuracy by Mr. R. F. May in London and by the Standard in Kenya.

There is no doubt indeed, that the cost of the office is borne by its contributors in the following proportions:

This makes approximately £10,000 which shows that this year the Office is careful to reduce the cost of its work and out of the sum only £1,900 was allotted to advertising and exhibitions while the office furniture had another £290, the D.O.T. rate £2,000, and the salaries and travelling expenses go up.

Making Money.

But the curious thing is that the system of running a Publicity Office is a money making one.

The Office carried over about £8,000 the first year, and it is estimated that the second year and a little more interest the third year and there was no adding to its "reserves" until it was a nice sum.

Why? It is not an indication of the corruption that the whole office and its methods are wrong? Why should the East African Information Bureau maintain an account of £10,000 when apparently only a small number in the office are actually paid direct pay publicity?

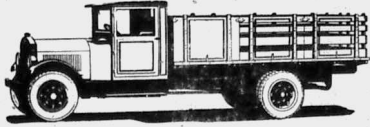

THE CONSTITUTIONAL ISSUE.

To the Editor, "The Standard." Sir—The memorandum by the Executive of the Convention on the subject of Federation is an excellent document and generally does not err on the side of modesty in Kenya demands and it is to be hoped may impress the Hilton Young Commission.

In one paragraph under the heading "A Free Kenya" which strikes me as asking for the impossible. It is where we have the securing of Tanganyika for all time by an integral part of the Empire. To those who differ, I would ask them what would have been our attitude had the result of the war been different and our Colonies handed over to Germany under mandate? Would we have seen our men return in overwhelming numbers to Kenya and have we not had to obtain control? I am sure we should not. I am sure we can't expect a victor race such as the Germans can expect, mostly developing their farms with no ulterior object, as they are very well fed by America to say the least.

For all that I am sure we should not be so confident, we must be prepared, and consider any movement which may be made to temper with the native races of the country. Letters addressed to the newspaper East African from Tanganyika point that way.

If we are to federate on the lines proposed then Kenya at least should be adequate for the purposes, and those concerned should be prepared to make any sacrifice within our power.

KAVIRONDO ASSOCIATION MEMO. FOR THE COMMISSION.

Chain of Councils Suggested to Organize Native Opinion.

CENTRAL CONSULTATIVE AFRICAN COUNCIL.

The following draft memorandum has been prepared by a sub-committee of the Kavirondo Payers Welfare Association for presentation to the Hilton Young Commission. It has also been approved by the general committee of the Association.

In venturing to address you in connection with the political affairs of the natives on the matter now before the Commission, it may be thought that we are venturing to trespass on your province, which also can give our representations any weight. We do not say that you will think this, but that many will who see we have no doubt.

We are intensely grateful to the British Government for sending out such a Commission, and for the emphasis which it has placed on the Doctrine of Trusteeship, but the Report of the Trust Africa Commission, published in 1922 while concluding much which is above criticism, does also contain that which is a blot on the name of Africa in every man's tongue, and particularly on the name of Kavirondo, and we deem it but only fitting, with the approval of the natives, to speak out on this subject.

We would crave your indulgence to comment on the passage which is such a blot on our name. On page 16 of the Report, section (G) Labour, lines 14 from beginning of section "The danger is, of course, not to be confined, but to go on from land in the Reserve or for wages outside of the Reserve." It is lamentable that the economic progress of the whole country and with the advance in civilization of the natives of Africa that this should be allowed to stagnate in a native reserve leaving the white man to remain, "the man doing nothing."

Effect on Policy.
