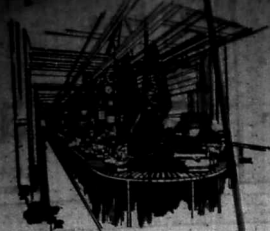

CRITICAL STAGE OF ANGLo-EGYPTIAN NEGOTIATIONS.

Britain Reserving the Necessary Safeguards.

MORE RUMOURS IN CAIRO.

Official Statement Expected in Parliament within a Week.

Further rumours are published in Cairo regarding the conversations proceeding in connexion with an anticipated Anglo-Egyptian Treaty regarding the future of Egypt and the Sudan.

Forecasts, which are regarded as having some accuracy, suggest that British occupation will remain unchanged for a period of ten years after which the Treaty will come into force, giving Egypt independence.

An official statement is expected to be made to the House of Commons within a week.

TEN YEARS IN TERM PERIOD.

Cairo, February 29. Frustrated efforts to bring frequent conferences amongst the British leaders and also a Conference between the Premier, Herbert Asquith, and Lord Lloyd, the British High Commissioner, indicate that the Anglo-Egyptian negotiations are being protracted.

At the close of ten years the question will be submitted to the League of Nations if an agreement is not previously reached. Other claims modify the present British aspirations in internal affairs and the Sudanese.

In the event of the declaration of war against Britain, Egypt will be left in Egyptian territory. Britain will support Egypt, but will not be bound to assist her immediately. The situation is significant.

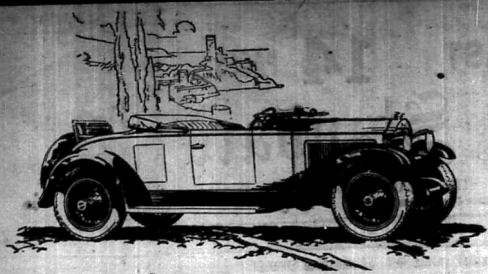

Miss Dehnen very kindly took the work as Hon. Librarian. Miss M. W. Evans in March 1933 as the latter was leaving Nairobi, and in December Mrs. Tucker kindly took over from Miss Dehnen. They have been assisted in their work by a sub-committee consisting of various ladies of Mrs. Hadow, Mrs. Paul, Miss Heath, Mrs. Baber, Mrs. Durham, Mrs. Jones and Mrs. Wilby. The League would like to express their gratitude to Mr. Galton-Rhodes for so kindly allowing the library to be housed in the I.R.A.A. Rest Room and also to Miss (Dobson) for her able help and interest in the library work.

The takings of the library from January 1st, 1933, to January, 1934, total £16, 20/6. You will notice that this amount (£16, 20/6) is less than the amount shown in the "Balance" Sheet. This is accounted for by a cheque for £10.

Mrs. Dehnen very kindly offered to choose books for the library while in France last year and was given the quarterly cheque of £10, from the League funds, the cheque being the January 1933 March 1933 allowance, although actually appearing in the balance sheet for this purpose. There are about 60 French books, novels and works by well known authors. It is decided to have a Rest Room in which the library can be housed and a room to be built adjoining the Memorial Hall which will be leased to the League for this purpose.

THE CHILDREN'S CHURCH.

The annual general meeting of the congregation of All Saints Church was held on the 24th Feb. at 8.15, on Wednesday evening, the Bishop of Mombasa presiding.

Canon Wright read the address report for the year—

I have the honor to present the 17th Annual Report of the Parish Church of Nairobi.

During half of the year I was absent on leave. I left England before the floods, and returned in time to escape the earthquake. In spite of the upheaval Nairobi was unshaken, and I found everything going on smoothly and well.

My first duty, therefore, is to thank the Bishop and his Chaplain, the Rev. A. L. P. P. P., for their care of the Parish in the interim.

I can assure the Bishop that we do appreciate his generous labour for the European community. The Bishop is willing to fill any gap, and he that is chief among us in the service of it all. While we appreciate this, you will all agree that these standards are too great, and I am very glad that a strong representative committee appointed by the Bishop is going into the matter of providing services which Chaplains are on leave, and making suggestions for the future.

The Children's Church.

At the last annual meeting we appealed for help to build a children's church at Kabete Road, and this was completed before I left and has since been finished and opened. I congratulate the Committee that there is only a small debt of £50 on it. I should be personally sure not to have had a share in furnishing the Church as well as in building it. There will be others who will feel the same, and this item is not likely to re-appear in the next Budget unless others, for help and gifts in recognition with the equipment of the little church. Above all I should like to see how things are getting on. To the Comptroller for the Service that he has taken, and to the children's Church without Mr. Williams on the side and Mr. Carson on that many of the

It should also be to thank Mrs. Walker and Mrs. East for the work in the Sunday School.

The Women's and Girl's groups, as you know, have been making progress, and the year has been successful and cheerful in so much that has been done for the service of the Church.

Loyalty.

If there is one quality more important than another in the presentation of the Bishop of Mombasa, it is personal loyalty. Looking back over the past year, I can say I am proud and thankful in so much that has been done for the service of the Church.

The Resolution in the speech at the opening of Beyond emphasized the importance of right relations between Church and State. We are fully aware of the need that the Governor and the Government have of our prayers, both public and private. The devoted staff of Government in this Colony are of so high and lofty a character that it is difficult carrying them out. Mr. Edward Grigg can rely on the assistance of every loyal and conscientious member of the Church of England. I venture in this connection to assure that our loyalty is all the more valuable in that it is free and independent. They are on brotherly Chaplains and Ministers' skills, that we may speak boldly as we ought to speak. A free press is as important as a fair press.

In conclusion may I say how sorry we are to lose two members of our Congregation who will for England next week—Mr. and Mrs. P. P. P. They were with them the good wishes of all the different communities, but more especially with the affectionately remembered to the Church which they have served so conscientiously and devotedly for 17 years.

The report was unanimously adopted.

Finance.

In the absence of the Treasurer, Mr. Davis there read the Treasurer's Report for the year and this showed an encouraging state of affairs. A statement of receipts and expenditure had been circulated prior to the meeting, but in view of the Treasurer's absence it was impossible to answer any questions. The report was accepted and a vote of thanks passed to the Treasurer for all his work.

The Obedient all.

The Bishop at 10 minutes from 8.15 expressed his pleasure at presiding at the meeting. He said that he was one or two minutes late to apologise.

THE BUSHBACK PROPOSAL

ORDERS OF THE RAILWAY.

Parents in the Parklands area showed little interest in the meeting called on Wednesday evening to consider, and make recommendations upon, the official question of selecting a suitable site for the proposed Government elementary school to serve this area. Not more than twenty persons (not all parents) were present and the meeting was more productive of pointed observations from a few—principally against another Government proposal with "Enough money to build a school of its own," "unless any constructive criticisms of the proposals," and the final recommendations cannot be regarded as representing the feelings of the parents generally. It is the view of Captain the Hon. H. P. Ward presiding. Reviewing the history leading up to that meeting, he recalled that Mr. Ripper and other parents in the Parklands area approached him some time ago to point out that the educational facilities for children under nine were entirely insufficient in this particular area. When the matter finally came before the Budget Committee, it was decided that three schools for children under ten years of age were required in Nairobi, one at Kilimani, one at Westlands and one at Parklands. When the question of selecting a site for the Parklands School was considered, the Education Department made the suggestion that the school, instead of being in the more remote area of Parklands, should be situated in the more populated area near the railway terminus. Before that point was settled, he (Capt. Ward) asked for time to call a meeting of the parents to give them an opportunity of expressing their own in detail to Mr. Ripper.

The Scheme.
Mr. Biss of the Education Department then proceeded to explain the scheme. It was proposed to build two small schools for the district.

Mr. Biss—"A small school is an inefficient school for it necessitates one teacher having to take small classes of different standards. Moreover, he added, it was more economical in building and expenditure to have one large school. If the provision increased in the northern end of Parklands and Mathamba, he was sure the Government would consider the building of another school there. It is possible to consider the Bushback a great difficulty would be met. On the other hand, there

From Nairobi to Kiambu the roads are really good with the exception of a few miles rough and without any cover. I have been up to Eldoret in four days and a half hours. Needless to add I am in the way connected with the P.W. D. with each year whether there is rain, snow, etc.

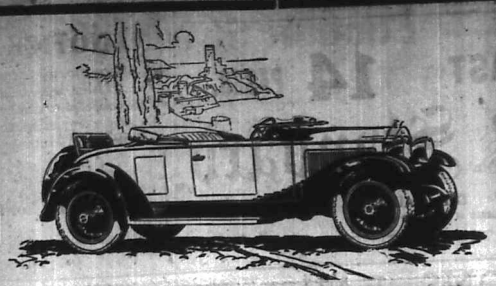

Machines Taking the Place of Men.

ARMoured FIGHTING VEHICLES.

Changes in Overseas Forces Cause Total Reduction of 13,000 in Regular Army.

The British Army is the subject of a gradual but rapid progress of mechanisation in which men are being displaced by mechanical aids to warfare.

Armoured fighting vehicles have been developed, the army is equipped by six-wheeled lorries, cavalry are being transported with armoured cars, artillery is being mechanised and anti-air gun units have been introduced.

ELIMINATION OF THE HORSE.

Imported changes in the Army are announced by the Secretary of State for War in a memorandum accompanying the Army estimates.

In regard to mechanisation, the following points will represent considerable advances that have taken place in the provision of armoured fighting vehicles and more especially in those for use with the anti-aircraft gun.

The regular Army for the coming year will be 136,000 men, a reduction of 18,000.

In view of the losses sustained during last year it has been decided to increase the number and quality of light tanks, as funds permit, to supply approved units in the Home Forces and to provide facilities to provide fighting machines to be equipped by militia units.

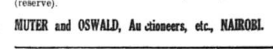
