WOMAN'S STRANGE TASTE IN LIQUOR.

A strange case in liquor has been revealed by the death of Miss Ingham, who for 20 years drank a pint and a half of wine a day.

Dr. D. A. Urquhart, who conducted her case in the British Medical Journal, gives in his opinion that "she was an exactly pure white pickled alive."

He did not see her until she was 40 years of age. He told her that she was pickled alive.

"Beside her usual, a quart bottle of wine three pints every day had become during the last few years a quart of brandy."

"I learned from her relatives that she was drunk by usual daily drinking without washing it down with a liberal supply of the 'pickled' brandy."

At one time she had weighed 112 lbs. but when the doctor was called in her weight was only 88 lbs. For five weeks she had not had a solid food, but had continued her daily alcohol of brandy.

After her death an expert was called, and the verdict was returned that she died of chronic intoxication—the intoxicant being concentrated brandy.

LARGEST SOUTH AFRICAN GRANT.

THE MOTOR CYCLIST.

How to Make Riding a Pleasure.

DOES AND DOSTS.

A novice at motor cycling will make mistakes; he would be a most unassuming type of novice if he did not.

Therefore, let the novice take heed, and be not ashamed at the look back and laugh at himself and wonder how he could possibly have made such unbecomable mistakes. Experience will come quickly to some than to others, of course, and, perhaps, to a very, very few, not at all. But those few are the strange ones who lack that widespread gift, common sense.

Common sense will show the way to everything; thus the way out of every difficulty; overcome every obstacle. Therefore, overcome such use of your common sense. Just as you know you "do," everyone "do's" and "do's" in every one of them dictated by common sense.

Don't forget to use your gear box. It is there to help you on hills, at corners, and in traffic.

Don't forget to free the clutch momentarily when changing gear. This is done slightly over changing up, but to leave the clutch the open when changing down.

Don't be afraid to take a hand from the bars; modern machines almost steer themselves, but don't steer! Your hands must be ready.

If the engine knocks on a hill which is not severe enough to call for a change down, retard the ignition slightly; the try retarding down the air supply.

When starting, if the engine won't down the air if the engine is cold retard the ignition if the engine is hot and "kick back."

A spluttering stop often means a carburettor trouble; a misfiring or sudden and complete stop often points to ignition trouble.

The commonest carburettor troubles are choked fuel pipes or jets; the commonest ignition troubles are choked plug, leading wires, or a stuck rotor arm.

Treat a new engine kindly; gently does it for the first few hundred miles.

Convey your intentions to other road-users and to post-day police by means of the recognised hand-signals.

Don't sit in between approaching vehicles; it is annoying to the drivers concerned, and may be dangerous to you.

Don't blind over cross-roads. Don't cut corners.

Treat pedestrians with respect. Don't rev your engine or make unnecessary noise, especially at night or in the vicinity of hospitals.

Slow down if you see another motorist in trouble; that you see no hand as repairs—be only one word to someone as a motorist.

If you fall foul of the law, remember that policemen pay. If you have accident lighting, push out the light before filling up with petrol.

Watch your tyre pressure. Too soft, tyre wears rapidly at the sides; too hard, they transmit road shocks.

Don't run out of petrol—that is humiliating; if out of petrol, you may be expensive.

Don't take a pillow passenger until you have gained confidence; and when you do, see that he or she is properly held, with a firm cushion or proper seat, and will not fall.

When you first try to drive a vehicle, softly, don't try to balance it. It has only to be moved, using the handlebars like a tiller.

When approaching a left-hand corner with a sideler, slow down slightly, and then accelerate gradually as you round the corner, so that the machine "runs round" the sideler; approach a right-hand corner faster, and throttle down or "brake as you round it," thus allowing the sideler to "run round" the machine.

If your sideler "comes up," don't get frightened. Steer to the right, or quickly over the shoulder, and it will return to earth. It is a good plan to practice, on a deserted road, deliberately putting the sideler into the air; it will give you much greater confidence in the handling of your outfit. (The Motor Cycle)

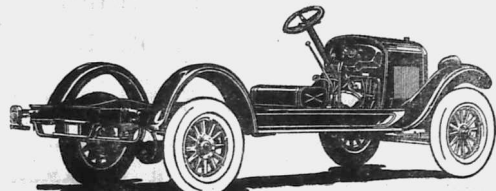

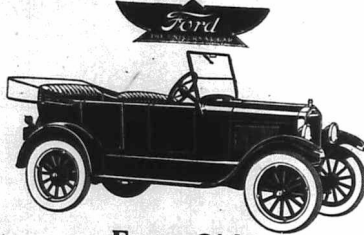

The Age of Consent.

The Kenya Government has published for criticism the draft of a Bill to amend the Criminal Law of the Colony in respect of assault on or of criminal force with intent to outrage the modesty of a woman. By the amendment, they propose providing protection to young persons up to the age of twelve years by fixing that period as what is generally described as the "age of consent." It will perhaps be recalled that a few months ago a serious defect in the Criminal Law amendment was committed upon a very young Galla child and so an attempt was made to amend the law in that respect because the child suggested in the evidence that she had not raised objections to the offence. This had similar cases of indecent assault upon children caused Government to give the subject close attention. It is having, however, become apparent that the law is in a state at the moment does not provide adequate and safeguard. Committee's Report to Mombasa Chamber of Commerce.

PORT MANAGERS' DEFENCE

Section That Merchants Themselves Are Largely to Blame.

The Report of the sub-committee appointed by the Chamber of Commerce to meet the Traffic Superintendent of the Lines and the Port Manager with a view to investigating recent delays in the forwarding of cargo from the Port to up-country destinations, was published in the 'Standard' last week.



FIVE CHILDREN PERISH IN BOARDING SCHOOL FIRE.

Dormitory Collapses into a Raging Furnace.

WOMEN'S HEROISM.

Principal and Staff Carry out Some Gallant Rescue Work.

Five children, whose parents live in the Tropics, died in a fire which completely destroyed the convent school in England at which they were pupils.

With wonderful heroism the women teachers went in and again through heat and smoke to rescue their pupils, and in length mounted the burning staircase to the third floor which collapsed carrying the five children with it as the women, assisted by two farmers, were out to enter.

A STRUGGLE AGAINST THE FLAMES.

THOMAS BURTEN AGENCY.

London, March 19.—A fire in a dormitory at a boarding school in England, which was completely destroyed, killed five children, whose parents live in the Tropics, and injured several others.

The fire broke out at about 10 o'clock on the night of the 17th inst. in the dormitory of the boarding school at which the five children were pupils. The fire was caused by a gas stove which had become overheated.

The fire spread rapidly and the flames reached the ceiling of the dormitory. The children were rescued by the women teachers and two farmers who entered the building through the burning staircase.

NEW PRAYER BOOK MEASURE.

Gallant but Hopeless Attempt.

THOMAS BURTEN AGENCY.

London, March 19.—The House of Commons today rejected the Government's proposal to introduce a new prayer book measure.

Dangerous Driving.

NATIVE LOUIS DRIVER FINED £5.

(BY WIRELESS.)

A native employee of the British Franchise Company was yesterday charged before Mr. Justice with dangerous driving. The driver, who was fined £5, was driving a motor car in charge of a party of tourists.

The driver was charged with driving at an excessive speed and with driving in a dangerous manner. The court found the driver guilty and imposed the fine.

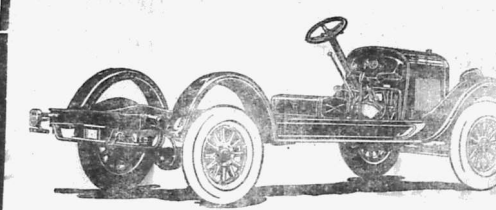

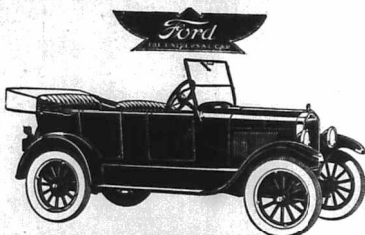

The next session of the Legislative Council will be a postponed from March 27 to May 5. The last meeting of Council closed at the end of November. They will therefore have a six months interval between two sessions. "Foolishly many" of the members of the Council are disappointed to see the Government postponing to under the present system of annual public session to attend public session for any session would be limited to some extent as far as possible without detriment to the business of the country. But members of Council have never indicated any willingness to make the heavy sacrifices entailed in the representation of the interests of the

public on Legislative Council and it is apparently the case that on this occasion this convenience is to be a major reason for the delay. We may say that we consider a break of six months to be a much too long interval between sessions of the Legislature of the Colony and it is regrettable in our view that the decision has been taken at the present time to create a procedure in the conduct of public business substituted to increase rather than decrease the difficulties already apparent of overrunning the agreed volume of work which has in the past constituted the business of the Legislature and has led to protracted sessions. It is understood that the chief reason for the delay is the unpopularity of the Government programme. There are numerous other measures of importance awaiting the attention of Council which are expected to take into consideration the Federation Council Report and Native Land Trust Bill, the District Revenue Bill and the Port and Harbour Bill. It is regretted that the attention of the Colonial Office is directed to these questions in the House of Commons that the Kenya Government is expected to take into consideration the possibility of propounding the recommendations of the Clegg Committee on the subject of representation of originially by the introduction of bills which have their origin in the Legislative Commission. It is also apparent that the Government is regarding the native reserves as a particularly difficult problem and it is to be expected that the Kenya Government will be called upon to examine the question. While further delay is regrettable, it does not seem to us to be a justifiable one, and we are inclined to hope that the Government will be able to bring forward its proposals for the public interest within a few weeks among which were included

a measure for greater control over the administration of lands, the agreement of a Bill, an important amendment to the Game Laws, the Trust Protection Ordinance and other matters of a minor character. In themselves they present details in the smooth working of the affairs of the Colony of some urgency and a sufficient programme to occupy the attention of the Council for several days with results beneficial to the country. The result of the Government decision is that those who are in favour of a highly constructive and efficient and from an economic point of view which will make heavy calls upon the Council. It is to be hoped that it will be an opportunity to give fully and completely satisfied with the Government's programme to take into consideration under the influence and presence of the truth which they will now be associated.

The monthly interest in the conduct of public business is the accumulation of extensive arrears of business which have not been attended to have been avoided and unnecessary delay in the introduction of new legislation of departmental importance, thereby clearing the way for the consideration of problems likely to be of full interest. 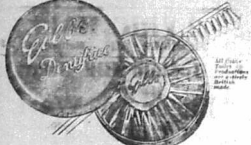
