### Officers Resentful of Humiliation to the Vessel.

The veil has been lifted from the Royal Oak affair by the evidence given at the Court Martial on Commander Daniel as Gibraltar on Saturday.

It is disclosed that the Rear Admiral returning from a visit to the shore in somewhat rough weather became furious because the only accommodation indicated for him was the stormy side of the ship.

It is alleged that this caused the Rear Admiral to speak roughly to the vessel's captain, and as a result of which, it was contended, laid a serious effect on discipline.

It is further ascertained that the Rear Admiral was severely critical of the ship's band. He was alleged to have said that he had been told that they were "not good" and gave an appropriate description of the band members. In similar terms he declared he could never get on with the band.

Finally it would seem the ship's band was dismissed and a jazz band summoned despite the captain's protest and the Commander's permission to resign from the service.

Important changes in the death penalty for soldiers are provided in the Army and Air Force Annual Orders which are being issued. Provision is made for the abolition of the death penalty in no fewer than eight different circumstances. The only military offence which will remain punishable by death is the murder, reckless, cowardly, desertion and leaving guard with intent to desert. Other offences which carry a lesser penalty than death are now being regularly inflicted.

In parliamentary circles the execution of the proposals has caused some surprise. It is understood they have been framed in sympathy with the general opinion of the Army members in which decisions were made for modification of the imposition of the death penalty—British Official Wireless Service.

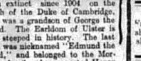

**Indian Husband's Brutal Treatment.**

**MAGISTRATE CENSURED.**

Severe criticisms against a magistrate were made by Justice Sir Charles Fawcett and Mr. Justice Mirza in the Bombay High Court in disposing of an appeal by the Government against the acquittal of Mahadu Dnyo, of Anagang, on charges of gross cruelty, which charges were preferred by his wife against him. The magistrate was censured by Mr. G. B. Kato, a second class Magistrate of Anagang.

The prosecution alleged that accused, who did not wait his wife to visit her parents, brought her back, locked her up, severely upbraided her and then hung her by her legs to a beam in the roof.

**Bole and Gwas.**

Having the girl's soles and gross accused a tender and another was left released but after she had been hanging in agonising pain practically half a day.

Accused denied the whole story, alleging that it was concocted by the girl and her relatives.

The Magistrate acquitted the accused on the grounds that there was no evidence of gross cruelty and no circumstantial evidence to prove the guilt.

Against this order the Bombay Government appealed to the High Court, contending that the Magistrate erred in disbelieving the girl's evidence in a statement given within one hour of the occurrence.

**Rope Marks.**

Their Lordships, giving judgment observed that the Magistrate, apparently under the impression that the girl's evidence must be corroborated by eye-witnesses or strong circumstantial evidence to establish accused's guilt, ignored the fact that the girl's evidence was corroborated by her seven injuries which indicated that she had been beaten and hung up by the legs. When there were rope-marks upon her legs from which the girl hung and a stick with which she had been beaten.

**Ignored Evidence.**

Their Lordships thought that nothing to support the view that the case was concocted had been adduced by accused and they regretted to state that the manner in which the magistrate had ignored the evidence raised serious

**Mixed Marriages.**

**AN INTERESTING DECISION IN CALCUTTA.**

An interesting case in which the validity of a Hindu marriage was questioned was decided by Mr. Dalrymple, Chief Presidency Magistrate, Calcutta.

In this case, Goutpi Singh charged one Shree Bhowee with enticing away his lawfully married wife, Sansoo, a Madrasi woman. To prove his contention that the woman was his lawful wife, the complainant cited as his witness a priest, who stated that he married the parties according to Hindu rites, but that he had no conversation, however, he admitted that he did not know what caste either of them belonged to.

It was argued by Mr. N. G. Das that the complainant was an ascetic, Shree and the so-called wife a Madras woman of unknown caste. Therefore, granting that they were married by a priest, the woman could not be regarded as the wife of the complainant, since Hindu society did not recognise the validity of mixed marriages. He maintained that in the circumstances, his client had not committed any offence under the law.

The magistrate acquitted the accused.

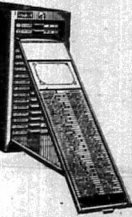

With five per cent fewer employees last year American factories turned out seven per cent more products than the previous year, and nobody seems to know where this increase of "technical" unemployment may end.

The machine seems to run the process ahead of man with the result that as one writer says: "We are obtaining more and better industrial equipment only at the price of a heavy investment in unemployment and human misery."

**Tropical Agriculture.**

**PRELIMINARY REPORTS ON RESEARCH WORK.**

Reports on tropical agricultural research, agricultural economics and population surveying by committees under the general auspices of the Empire Marketing Board have been made available to the public. The books are of particular interest to the Colonies and Dominions as they are in the nature of preliminary surveys of the ground to be covered in the several spheres of Empire development. The report on tropical agricultural research, by Dr. C. A. Barber, of the School of Agriculture, Cambridge, contains special references to maize, sugar cane, cotton and palm, and Mr. Oswald's contribution, in a paper, points out that in some cases it is a record of successful achievement in the past, but more it points to directions in which research might profitably be developed in the future.

## ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT.

**British and American Manufacture.**

### A COMPARISON.

Just a word in the ear of those well-meaning British motorists who wish to work out, write to the motor Press to complain about the insufficiency of British electrical equipment and please the American manufacturer. Quite a lot of people are under the impression that the finest electrical lighting and starting equipment built from the United States, and they will point to undesirable incidents to prove their contention. One will tell you that he has got a Yale Six which has never failed to start from cold at the frosty froth of the United States, and they will mention batteries. Another will mention that he has got a 10 h.p. British accumulator after eight months' use, that he bought a new accumulator of a different make and has never had any trouble since, and that was 18 months ago—end so on. Their arguments are convincing because there is a host of electrical facts, besides these, which we witness, establish things, even sometimes to be a lie and a half.

When one comes to think of it, with their methods of production, articles which we turn out tens of thousands, it is extremely unlikely that the American car produce that line as similar articles manufactured here, see that the case. Actually an American dynamo, for instance, which no doubt being good enough, is not such a fine piece of workmanship as a British dynamo, nor need it be so.

### The Fault of the Engine?

It is common practice in this country to hold one that one must wait before one says that one must wait. Engines are made with

very light bearings, which, if made fully rigid during the initial stages, will acquire a glass-like finish and will continue for very long periods without showing signs of wear. They are provided for very long periods without showing signs of wear. An engine with light bearings fits a tremendous strain upon the starter motor and battery. Engines are rarely made with a clearance in the bearings of less than two thousandths of an inch and run on a cushion of oil which is pumped under high pressure at a speed of 2,000 miles per hour.

Some little time ago when a new model was produced the first British starter was quite unequal to the task of turning over the engine from cold. One of the first was using an American car, the motor of which would turn over that bit of cylinder engine at a very good speed, and suggested that the American equipment should be put on this new British car. This was done, and the American starter was quite unequal to the task.

Being an enterprising concern, the manufacturer saw at once that it was not the electrical equipment which was at fault, but his own engine, and they remedied matters straight away.

### Why Batteries Break Down.

Perhaps the few remarks will help to explain a British lead battery—its only make, which is that motor-cumulative kind down during the first nine months and then, when the winter comes, it gives no further trouble. if an accumulator is frequently short-circuited the plates will become very soft and its life will be of a very short one. It starting a "soft" engine can be practically short-circuiting the battery at a very low discharge rate, which must of necessity, raise its temperature considerably, and cannot be avoided. By thus short-circuiting the plates again by hand if it still would give the battery a chance, for the life will be doubled or trebled by so doing.

There is another kind worth bearing in mind to save the starter battery. When using the standard starter always put on the clutch. By thus disconnecting the engine from the gearbox the action will be relieved from having to strain up the gear of which, when cold is so liable to thicken and thus will actually reduce the turning effort required. Should the little wheel getting the starter to start the engine and having to do it by hand.

Now for another subject, coil ignition, which is coming into use primarily in many European cars. It is a very doubtful if a more reliable piece of mechanism has ever been produced than the ordinary standard magneto. Magneto breakdown are extremely rare. Can we say the same for the various units of coil ignition?

### Vegetation of Ignition.

Put it another way. Suppose you were going to buy from London to Paris and had the choice of two—the other with coil ignition, which would you choose? It is doubtful if coil ignition is fitted to any aeroplane, and even in aircraft, the units of coil ignition, especially are fitted with magneto.

A year or two ago a cheap type of magneto, turned out for a purpose, made a car, named for British motorists, because breakdowns were unusually large, owing to the number of cars being manufactured, and even if the proportion was

really quite small. That, however, is sufficient history, and new magneto units are being made, and almost without in spite of many years of experience.

The development of coil ignition can be traced to American inventors first on the Continent and now in this country. It appears to the car manufacturers because it seems to offer a substantial saving in the cost of manufacture, but when everything is taken into consideration there can be little advantage seen, if any.

For instance, when one is the pendant upon the battery for ignition it is kept in good condition, for all probability it will be found that a larger battery is desirable, and of course, a dynamo with a larger output, which again increases the expense. Seasonal coil ignition is used because, it is found that the magnetos driven by the engine will be more reliable.

### Which is the More Reliable?

Coil ignition units are made now, and they are made in this country as well as abroad—and very different from those we used to know in the old days, but it would be difficult to prove that their reliability was as certain as that of the best British magneto. The coil offers but one advantage over the magneto and that is in providing as good a spark at very low speeds as when the engine is turning over at its peak, but at the same time is not difficult to make a magnet to give a sufficiently hot spark at equivalent low speeds.

Another point in favor of the magneto is that as new made it will run untroubled for many thousands of miles without giving trouble, while the "coil" points should not need attention for at least 10,000 miles and frequently will last 20,000 miles. It can be broken down at a well and long before it is broken down. It may be a wrong stand to take, but in view of the circumstances, it does seem that in making the magneto we are getting with a tried and tested friend. The Motor.

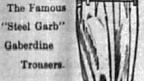

### TO REMOVE MARKING INK

A Safe and Sure Method.

The following method of removing marking ink from face cream may be used upon any safe and sure, and perfectly unobtrusive to the most delicate skin.

First wash the article in clean, warm water. Remove all superfluous moisture, and spread the fabric over a clean cloth. Now allow a few drops only of liquefied ammonia to drop on the

Add a few drops of water, which are allowed to be rubbed in. A few rinses with water completes the process.

LUBRICATION PROBLEMS.

Explanation of How Wear is Prevented.

DOES OIL WEAR OUT?

Every machinery contains a certain amount of bearings in which moving rubbing parts are engaged, and the same substance must necessarily wear the surfaces of these bearings, but the amount of wear depends on the nature of the bearings. This is very clearly seen in the case of a motor-car where, for example, the highly loaded camshaft receives very rapid abrasion, and the piston and crank pins are subjected to the same kind of wear.

On the other hand, the bearings of the shafts which rotate at low speeds are not subjected to so much wear. This is because, in a motor-car, the crankshaft rotates at about 1,200 revolutions per minute, while the pistons revolve at about 300 revolutions per minute.

MOMBASA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE CRITICISES THE WORKING OF KILINDINI.

Comprehensive Memorandum by Sub-Committee Placed before the Port Advisory Board.

RESULTS OF NEGLECT TO REPAIR MRAKAI PIERS.

Port Manager Points Out Chronic Effects on Staff, Long Working Hours, Handicap of Lengthy Free Storage and Burden of Simultaneous Working and Development.

The Mombasa Chamber of Commerce has discussed at length difficulties in connection with the Port. The difficulties are set out in an important memorandum which has been placed before the Port Advisory Board by the Chamber. The Memorandum appears below as follows by a report of the discussion on the general course of Port working between the Chamber and the Port Manager.

The main points made by Members of Chamber of Commerce are—

That the so-called peak period is not abnormal but is an annual occurrence; and that the authorities have no excuse in being unprepared.

That there has been neglect of the importance of Mbaraki by failure to repair that pier—a failure which is felt by the Port authorities encouraged by traffic that Port revenues might not be lost by diverting traffic to Mbaraki;

That however good an advertisement may have been provided by berthing the tourist ship, "Laocina" at the deep water pier, it was unfair to the commercial community to cause further congestion by doing so;

That steaming operations at the Port must be improved;

That difficulty in finding cargo is the cause of great delay;

That private firms wishing to erect their own godowns should be encouraged by proper rail facilities;

That the fact that 13 engines out of 30 available for Mombasa Island traffic were under repair at the present time points to an extraordinary lack of organization on the part of the Railway;

That the distribution of trucks and the handling of cargo with the same mark should be improved;

That in the future an assistant Port Manager should be appointed and increased staff engaged in proportion to the growing work;

That Mbaraki should be repaired immediately and other obvious steps taken if the peak period of 1925-26 is not to be a repetition of what has happened this year.

The High Commissioner for Transport has notified the Chamber of its inability to direct the introduction of more motor trucks which accordingly came into force on Sunday.

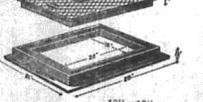
