TANGANYIKA TERRITORY CROP REPORTS.

Ample Rainfall in Most Districts.

OFFICIAL REVIEW.

Following are crop reports up to the end of February issued by the Tanganyika Department of Agriculture.

Coastal Area, North.
BAHAMOYA: Main season plantings are not yet begun and rain is wanted. Rice is well forward and healthy.
PANGANI: No rain yet during the month in the coastal area. The vicinity of Pangani, but Malindi and Mtwara sections during the last week enabling planting to commence. Cotton seed is being distributed.

TANGA: Some rain fell during the last two days and natives are utilizing in preparation for the rice crop.
Coastal Area, South.
RUFILI: Heavy rains fell in eastern Rufiji but not so good in the west. Earliest harvest of short-season maize has been reaped and the market is still glutted with rice and maize of last season. Rice prospects are good in eastern Rufiji, but doubtful in the western. Planting of food crops in general.

LINDI: Rain has been very scarce but for general, although suffered through shortage in the first half of the month. The food crop situation is generally good but some shortage is reported in southern Masasi. Much wheat promises a large crop, some delay of sowings are indicated. Beans are being harvested. Some rice suffered severely from insect attack and later sowings are promising. The cotton season is very good, especially in Nwaha, and indications point to a large increase in the area planted.

Central Line Area.
DARE-SALAAM: Fair to good rains have fallen in the past week and the crop prospects, cotton planting has been commencing in all areas except the South East.
MOROGORO: Good planting this month and cotton planting is now general.
KILWA: Rain, seedlings and crop prospects are extremely good.
DODOMA: Rainfall during the month was nearly 2 inches, and

there is a great improvement in all crops.
SENDA: Much rain has fallen recently and crops are growing well. Rubrub millet is heading.
SABO: There is increased planting of maize and millet and the situation is satisfactory.
ZEZEA: Over one inch of rain fell from the 26th to the 29th. Crops are backward and plantings are still incomplete.
SITUYANGA: Excellent rains have fallen during the past fortnight and all food crops are in a good condition. Cotton planting in the new areas.
KIDOGWA: A shortage of rain in the vicinity of the Taveta, Tanganyika and Uzi areas, and plantings are being delayed. The rice crop in rain is needed.
KASHELI: Rain has been more plentiful during the last few days and the present sowing season has benefited. More rain is wanted for coffee, maize, rice and beans.

Lake Victoria Area.
Mwanza: February rainfall is nearly 2 inches. There is a little improvement in food crop prospects, but all crops are suffering from a shortage of rain. Cotton planting is in progress.
BUROBA: Rainfall has been rather heavier than normal on the lake shore and the planting of Arabica coffee has started, and the picking of sisalata is expected to begin in May.

Northern Area.
USAMBARA: Light daily showers have fallen and progress for planting is proceeding in the plain. Harvesting of the maize crop is not yet completed in the hills.
HANDONI: Good showers of rain fell during the last week and planting is now general.
MOSHI: The weather is showery and cotton sowings are being started. Coffee thrives after mulling and the trees are flowering. The native coffee crop is estimated to be double last season's.

ARUSHA: Good rainfall.
Southern Area.
IRINDI: Ample rainfall fell during the month and crops are growing well throughout the district.
MBEYA: Prospects all crops fairly good except in Irindwa, where first plantings have failed owing to lack of rain. Rain is generally not set up to average.
MAKONGE: Rainfall during the month was about 1 inch. Good rains were general during the latter end of the month, but millet and maize crops have suffered owing to the previous dry period. All reports received are satisfactory.
SONGEA: All crops are doing well with the exception of maize. The latter suffered from excessive rain which washed out many plants. Replanting is now taking place. If inches of rain fell in six hours on the 29th instant.

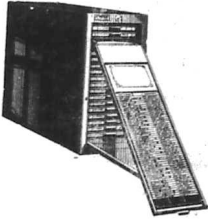

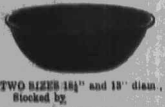

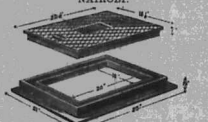
