KENYA GOVERNMENT'S CLOSER SETTLEMENT PROPOSALS.

Selected Land in Kitale and Thomson's Falls Areas.

THREE SCHEMES.

The Conditions under Which Farms May be Taken up.

A summary of the Government's closer settlement proposals was laid on the table at the recent session of the Legislative Council.

There are three schemes—(a) providing for 45 small holdings on the outskirts of Kitale to be allotted alternately to selected local applicants and to selected applicants with little or no capital; (b) for 30 farms in the Transi Njira and 45 in the Ndaragwa and Thomson's Falls area intended for settlers with limited capital; and (c) residential and small holding allotments intended primarily for retired Civil Servants.

Plans for receiving selected applicants and arranging for their settlement are set out in the memorandum the main points in which are given below.

SELECTING THE APPLICANTS.

Considerable areas of Crown land available for settlements and suitable in most cases for mixed horticultural and intensive use, together with financial assistance provided by the Imperial Overseas Settlements Department and that to be provided by the proposed Land and Agricultural Bank constitute the resources available for the encouragement of closer settlements. These proposals aim at laying down a policy and establishing a process of settlement, and contain recommendations for a comparatively small initial step in respect of some of the Crown Lands available at present.

In respect of settlers from Great Britain the contribution expected from the Overseas Settlements Department may be summarised as follows—

- (a) Half of an initial long term loan of £200 to each allottee and in certain cases half of a further £200.
- (b) The grant of a contribution towards passage money such as well with an equivalent grant from the Kenya Government, and a 15 per cent. rebate granted by the Overseas Shipping Lines, reduce the cost of that

class passage for new settlers and their families to £10 per head.

(c) The grant of a maintenance allowance to each settler in Great Britain for the first 6 months of his residence in Kenya.

(d) The grant of half the cost of training each settler, if required, whether in Kenya or in Great Britain; in this connection it is considered that selected applicants from overseas should be required to obtain local practical experience for periods at the discretion of the Secretary Board before taking up their allotments.

(e) The guarantee to the extent of 50 per cent. of loan debts to the Land Bank in respect of Overseas settlers except in the case of interest loans.

The consent of the Overseas Settlements Department to make the contributions of £2,000, subject to the submission of final selection for their inspection.

Selection Boards.

The administration of the scheme should be in the hands of a central Land and Selection Board, which

would arrange for the consideration of applications both in Kenya and in England. It is recommended that the Board should be composed mainly of members having practical experience in settlement and farming, and it is suggested that the total membership should be five with a power of co-opting for specific purposes. The proposals fall into three parts as follows—

- Scheme A. Small holding scheme.
- Scheme B. Mixed farming scheme.
- Scheme C. Settlement for pensioners, ex-military and other persons of limited means.

A restriction is placed on the allotment of Kitale Township of 45 small holdings, approximately 2 to 3 acres each, which should be allotted alternately to selected local applicants and to selected applicants from Great Britain.

An average of 200 acres is considered sufficient in this area to enable the allottees to be self-supporting, while any wages earned from outside employment would assist towards a more intensive form of farming. It is estimated that not less than 100 acres of the land in any holding is suitable and that the ratio of production in this locality is such as to make this proportion of small-holdings settlement for the purposes of the scheme.

Alternative allotments are recommended so as to ensure that the Overseas settler shall benefit as far as possible from the experience of the local allottee.

In this respect importance is attached to the proposal that a series of demonstration farms to serve particularly but not exclusively these holdings should be established. Continued contact and instruction would thus be made available from the start both by the example of a model holding and by the direct advice and supervision of an experienced officer. Later it might be found possible to sell up the farms and transfer the staff and activities to another nearer settlement area.

The costs of this form are estimated as follows—

Provision for 1928 expenditure under this head has been made in the 1928 Estimates. It is hoped that half the cost of this establishment, capital and recurrent, will be met by the Overseas Settlement Department, as a direct grant. It is expected that the Government would be responsible for the other half.

It is recommended that the cost and extension of the Kitale water supply to these holdings should be recovered and distributed in the land account of the holding. It is suggested that the value of the farms should include the capital cost and the value against the income should be proportionately increased. Delivery of water should be paid for direct by the allottee at the rate proposed for Kitale Township, at which rate it is estimated that an acre supply could be obtained at a reasonable cost.

Valuation of Land.

The land allotted should be valued at 1/20 of the rate of £3 per acre. This figure includes provision for group financing and the erection of a shed prior to occupation but excludes provision for the water scheme.

Financial assistance to settlers desiring farming operations should be made available in the following manner—

- (a) No immediate payment for the land should be demanded, but an agreement to purchase should be entered into by the allottee.

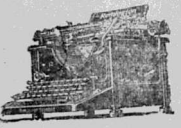

TROUT FISHING IN THE SUBUKIA RIVER.

Other Streams also Being Stocked.

RAIN AND SOAK

(FROM A CORRESPONDENT.)
 We in Subukia will shortly be able to get to the bottom of the matter. I had our breakfast in the town of some trout. The Subukia river was stocked about twelve months ago and I understand that the first fish has already been taken out but they will need to be allowed to grow a bit yet. I am now informed that another stream has been stocked by Mr. W. A. C. Miles and that fish is shortly to be stocked by Ted Lane.

I do not know what rain has fallen in Lower Subukia but in the upper parts we have had all the water and some people have had too much. Some nice hot sunny days are what we need now. The planting of maize and other wheat is nearly finished and the coffee people are planting what has planted out and is already starting to grow.

I am informed that a small batch of experimental fish planted in Upper Subukia is doing well and that several of the fish are already in the hands of the public. Certainly the fish is not in the higher part of the river. The same run one seems to get in this district. In some parts it must reach an average of about 100 fish.

Dual Roads.

Now that the 1928-29 road vote is questioned we are expecting better roads but I feel that the P.W.D. have a hopeless task and we have had much thought over the country. The motor roads will cost very little to keep up now the cars have a road of their own.

The average life of a rubber on our roads with no wages given ever there seems to be only a few months. I often wonder why in a well timbered district like the logs of mahogany or some equally hard wood are not used to lay down over the surface. If this were done before filling in with earth the surface would last forever. As it is they must cost the country a lot of money and even Kenya cannot afford to throw down money away

Sir Donald Cameron's Declaration.

A PERMANENT POLICY

Speaking at Tabora last week Sir Donald Cameron, who was asked for his views on the Tanganyika, Sir Donald Cameron said that three years ago at the first group meeting he was much struck by the two principal roads through the native Chiefdoms, the Indian and the Arab, and he felt that he had been able to supply their wants to a certain extent.

The country was not only inhabited by natives, who naturally were European (Greece, Indiana and Arab, who had a certain standard of civilization. Results were not going to be obtained at once and as it had taken the attention to reach their present standard some hundreds and thousands of years would be necessary to turn the natives into a civilized and properly educated people. It was the Government's aim to raise them to a higher level and a higher standard of civilization, enabling them to enjoy in the status of the country an equal rank with the other communities under the rule of the British Government. His policy of education would be permanent and continuous, and carried out thoroughly in the same spirit.

There are some mischievous and troublesome people who come round and tell you that this policy is going to be only temporary, continued Sir Donald Cameron. "You must not believe them," continued Sir Donald Cameron. "This policy is going to remain permanently and it will be definitely embodied in the framework of the British Empire and would never pass to another power."

A Good Case?

Probably speaking if the premises are correct, the Indians have put a distinct case for most of the points put forward. The District Committee's somewhat inadequate reply is that lighting the streets will not prevent crime, and that it would cost just double what it costs now, which is £1200, to keep the electric light on all night.

True, one can say that something-but extra-ordinarily will prevent crime. But on the other hand, it would be much easier for a thief to patrol streets which were lit up, and not in black darkness. The one simple fact is that the burglar would be quite annoyed if having to look into a house in a lighted street, when any moment a patrol might pop round the corner.

 Explanation of its Working.

which carries the primary circuit, and the magnetism generated by the current, thus putting the engine out of action. Another cause of firing in the engine attributable to ignition failure is sometimes caused by the fact that the spark plug is not removed by the wire-remover and thus, to try to start the engine.

Maintainance Work.
 Various obscure faults may occur in a magneto, such as a break-down somewhere in the armature circuit, or a defective lead, and so on, but these it is impossible for the owner-driver to find. There are, however, certain matters which he should be acquainted in connection with the maintenance of the magneto, so that a little further explanation of the mechanism seems necessary.

The contact breaker, for example, is really quite simple to understand. If you remember that its purpose is to break the primary circuit twice in each revolution. Turning with the armature is a well-known fact, and an arm, each of which carries a platinum-plated screw. The opposite end of the ball-bearing lever is fitted with a steel rod in contact with the outer surface of a cam ring by means of a spring.

If you obtain the assistance of a friend to crank the engine, showing it when you watch the action of the contact breaker, having, of course, removed the cover, you will notice that twice in every revolution the lead is increased by a ruled portion of the cam ring, the "off" contact, the platinum points to part. It is at these intervals that current is supplied to the sparking plug, from the secondary coil.

Obviously, anything which may interfere with the action of the contact breaker from functioning will cause "sparking failure." For example, the small spring on the ball-bearing lever may become loose, or the lever may catch on its fulcrum pin, so that it cannot move freely, or the contact may be pitted.

When examining the contact breaker you will notice that the cam ring can be removed through a certain angle by means of a rule and lever connected to the ignition lever on the steering column. This gives the driver a control over the points below and uneven contact points, however, is a very delicate operation, which the amateur should not undertake, but it is advisable when the car is put in for an overhaul after, say, 10,000 miles, to have the points set in order by an expert. One of Carbon Brushes.
 It will be remembered that the current is picked up from the armature by a spring-controlled carbon pencil known as a brush, which rubs against a slip ring and, this, conveys the current to a distributor driven by gearing from the crankshaft shaft. In course of time this slip ring may become misshapen, with carbon particles, or the brush may not be making good contact.

The distribution of current is affected in some magnets by a revolving carbon brush of a similar kind, but in others a metal blade revolves, the current being then required to jump across to the metal segments of the distributor, whereas in the former type the brush rubs over these segments. When a brush is employed, the segments should be cleaned occasionally.

Labeling the Magneto.
 There is usually an oil hole on the magneto into which a few drops of this machine oil can be placed at intervals of 1,000 miles, but it is not so common. A CONTINUOUS POLICY.

The report of the Overseas Settlement Committee for the year ended December, 1927, was presented to the Legislative Council of the Government on 10th June 1928. The Committee has continued its work since its formation in 1906 to report on the various resources of the Empire and to advise His Majesty's Government on the subject. As a result of the recommendations of the Committee, a scheme was introduced in April 1919, for the settlement of British subjects in the Colonies. This scheme was approved and amended by His Majesty's Government in Great Britain. The scheme was finally closed at the end of 1922, by which date free passages had been granted to some 80,000 souls.

A Permanent Policy.

In 1921, a Conference of Prime Ministers of the Empire took place for the purpose of considering the possibilities of State-aided settlement within the Empire and this Conference recommended co-operation between His Majesty's Government and the Colonies.
