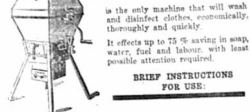

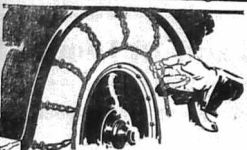

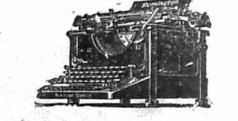

A BRITISH CORRESPONDENT.
London, May 11.—It was considered by a speaker at the conference on New Careers for Women in London on Friday, that good looks were sometimes a disadvantage to a woman seeking employment in the engineering profession.

Miss Hackett, organizer of the Women's Engineering Society and the Women's Technical Association, said: "We put forward a woman for a drawing office appointment, and her qualifications were excellent, but the director said quite frankly that she was too good looking for the job, and would probably upset the men in their work."

This opinion was not indented by a number of business authorities to whose notice the statement was brought. By Woodman Hastings, chairman and managing director of Harolds said: "Generally speaking a good-looking girl who has something about the same in her admirability the girl with charm has a great advantage. As to the matter of the man, I think men and women orientate themselves to their job."

Mr. Gordon Stridger, joint manager of the Great Eastern Railway, said: "We find that good looks do anything but detract from a woman's value as a subaltern."

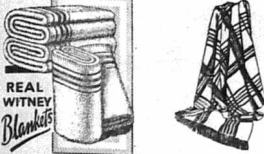

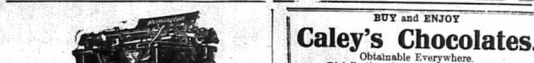

Members of the Council and the country generally have had a reasonable opportunity of making their views known with the former Government of the draft Bill and of con-

sidering the comprehensive nature of the programme which it is proposed to give to the Bill which is the subject of the present session.

It is a matter of course that the Bill will be introduced in the Legislative Council, and it is to be expected that the Bill will be taken up for consideration at an early date.
