

HOUSE OF COMMONS REJECTS THE NEW PRAYER BOOK.

The House of Commons on Thursday rejected the Prayer Book measure and thus reiterated its objection to the principal stumbling-block, the retention of the clause providing the Reservation of the Sacrament.

The debate lasted for two days and was notable for the eloquent advocacy of Ministers and private members who forgot party distinctions in dealing with the future of the national Church.

The Chancellor of the Exchequer who voted for the measure declared that his rejection would mean a period of chaos and eventual disestablishment.

The votes recorded against the measure were thirteen more than those which determined the defeat of the original proposal.

THE STUMBLING BLOCK.

The Galleries of the House of Commons were crowded today when Sir Boyd Herring, the Solicitor General introduced the Revised Prayer Book Measure.

The Archbishop of Canterbury and York and several bishops were in the Pews Gallery.

ELIMINATING WORK BY SCIENCE.

Professor Anticipates
"Heaven on Earth."

LEISURE PROBLEM

Science is going to put into two weeks the possibility of heaven on earth," said Professor Burnell, of Birmingham Engineering Institute, in a lecture before the National Union of Students at Oxford.

"It is the reason for all the remarkable mechanical developments," he went on. "The human frame is quite incapable of any serious labour. This is at the bottom of the idea of the Robot or mechanical worker."

The human is not really a working being but a directing mechanism, essentially being and doing house of labour. I am looking forward to seeing a comparatively simple form of dwelling, in which only one or two men in a few minutes to remove the dirt and other substances we bring in during the day.

After stating that hours of work would eventually be much reduced, Professor Burnell added that we should then be faced with the problem of properly arranging our leisure.

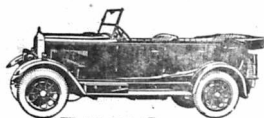

POULTRY NOTES.

Poultry Rations.

Feeds of exactly the same kind will give very different results in different birds. Even if the birds are in the hands of experienced breeders it does not follow that the best results will be obtained; one man may get much better results than another.

In fact the "good feeder" is born, not made, but the "careful feeder" can run him very close in results. One breeder will be most particular in allowing details to control "ration," another will allow details to rule, but will also take many other things into consideration, such as the character of his birds; whether they have a tendency to become over-fat, or under-mottled; whether they are large or small fowls; special extra requirements which increased requirements; whether more or less feeding is required; whether a large or small supply of natural fat is obtained; and whether the food that secured maximum fat is a change in the feeding itself.

Scientific Feeding.

The Committee therefore requests the Government to reconsider the introduction of the Bill and such like as all the communities affected can associate themselves with this proposal.

It was suggested that the time should be limited to two years only. The alternative suggestion that the plots should be sold at auction for the benefit of the Government was also considered.

Valuation of Plots.

In the amendment to Clause 1 provision was made for a valuation of the plots to be fixed by a Board consisting of a member of the Public Works Department, a member of the Municipal Council, Nairobi, and in the case of plots of other parts, a surveyor General or his representative and two representatives of the local body or bodies. There was also provision for a Board of officials who selected were between 1927 and 1929.

THE KENYA BRAND OF CIVILISATION.
A Criticism from Nyasaland.
"WILL O' THE WISP."

The Anti-Slavery Reporter and Abolitionist's Friend has given prominence to the trenchant criticism by the "Nyasaland Times" of the proposals of the Kenya Convention of Association on the question of Federation, and in that newspaper's columns of Lord Delamere for his use of the word "civilisation" in a particular sense.

"The civilisation referred to by Lord Delamere" the "Nyasaland Times" says, "is the South African brand, which, in the judgment of the world, is one of the most retrograde in recent times. Up to recent years, South Africa followed to some extent the policy exemplified by Rhodes, of equal rights for all civilised men irrespective of race, creed or colour. In late years, however, there has been an entire reversal of this policy and a new conception of World Policy and a new Federation, founded on the greatest Nationalism, based on the South African brand, has taken its place. Lord Delamere and his Party seem to be enamoured of the South African civilisation, which he assumes, and probably correctly, will also dominate Southern and what we will call North-Western Rhodesia as the lines from North Eastern Rhodesia. It is this brand which he is endeavouring to impose on Kenya, and into Kenya he hopes to spread it over Uganda and Tanganyika. Hence this is a serious matter which he hopes that it will

be strong enough to dominate Nyasaland and North Eastern Rhodesia and to join up with Rhodes and the Union of South Africa."
Only One Way.
The writer holds that Lord Delamere and his friends will never succeed in imposing their retrograde kind of civilisation on Nyasaland, and that the attempt would lead to bitter racial friction.
"There is only one way to avoid race friction and that is for the European race to be subject to the same laws and to be treated as citizens and not as the indigenous peoples to be ruled."
In Northern and Western Africa, and in addition, Tanganyika and Uganda, the article goes on to say that all nations have followed a policy of civilising the natives, and not of founding white colonies.
Lord Delamere's policy, it decries, cannot succeed. The Government of Tanganyika has expressed its opinion on the subject of the Kenya policy, and delegates from North Eastern Rhodesia have unanimously agreed, as we have mentioned elsewhere, to be in favour of the article, and to have shown much light on the subject, except to emphasise the position of Kenya to dominate the rest of Eastern and Central Africa.
"This domination will and must be resisted by the other territories, because, by following a 'Will of the Way' and the Kenya brand of civilisation is simply calling for trouble."
They must be true to the traditions of the British Empire, which mean "Freedom for all, no colour."
An Urgent Question.
In another issue the "Nyasaland Times" writes that the question of Federation is urgent, and it would

be satisfied whether Nyasaland should orientate to the North-East or to the South; in the latter case they would "ack their identity with the rest of the continent and adopt the policy of South Africa—a policy quite different from their own. A policy of franchise was not followed by Nyasaland."
